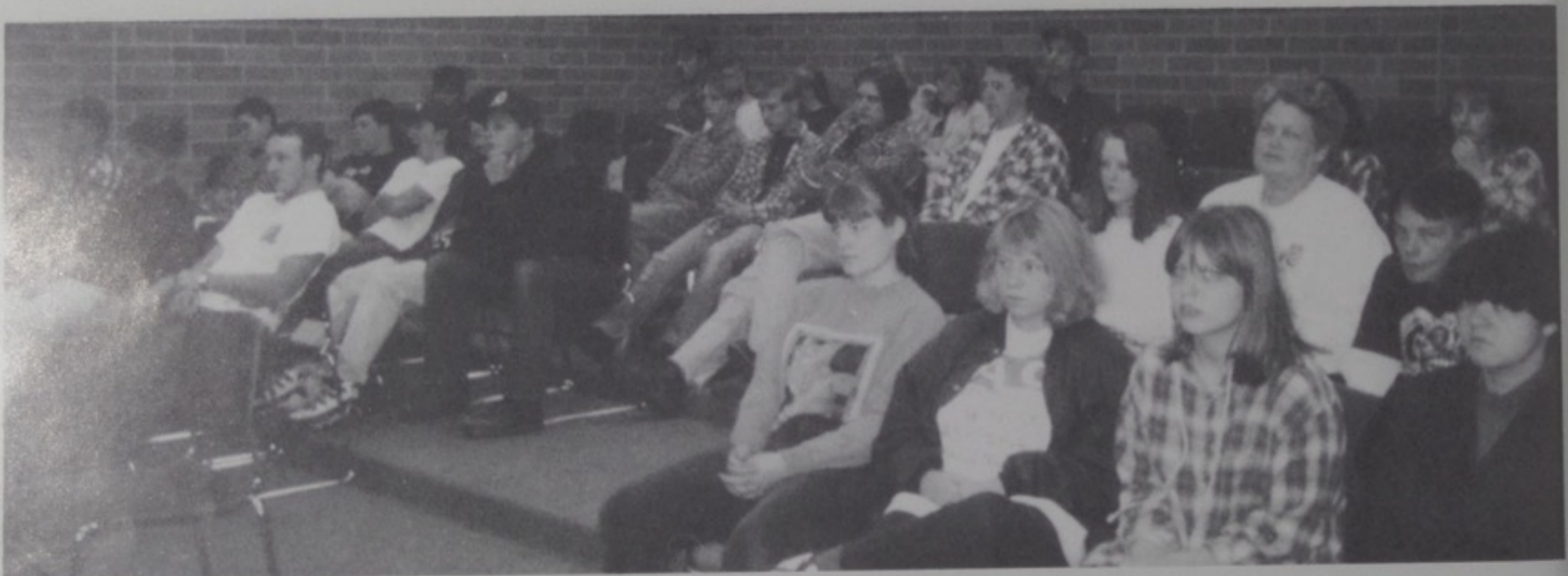
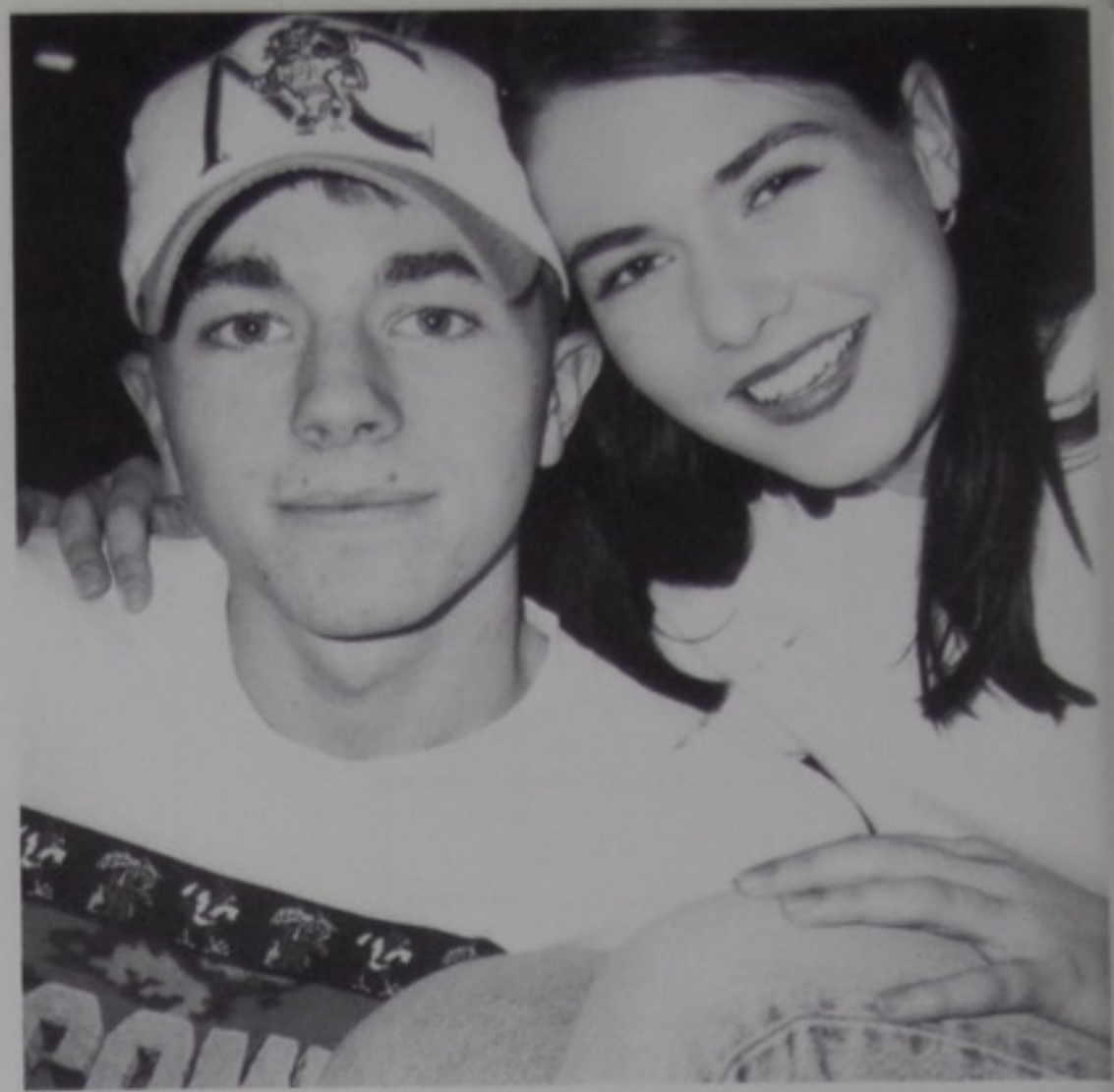

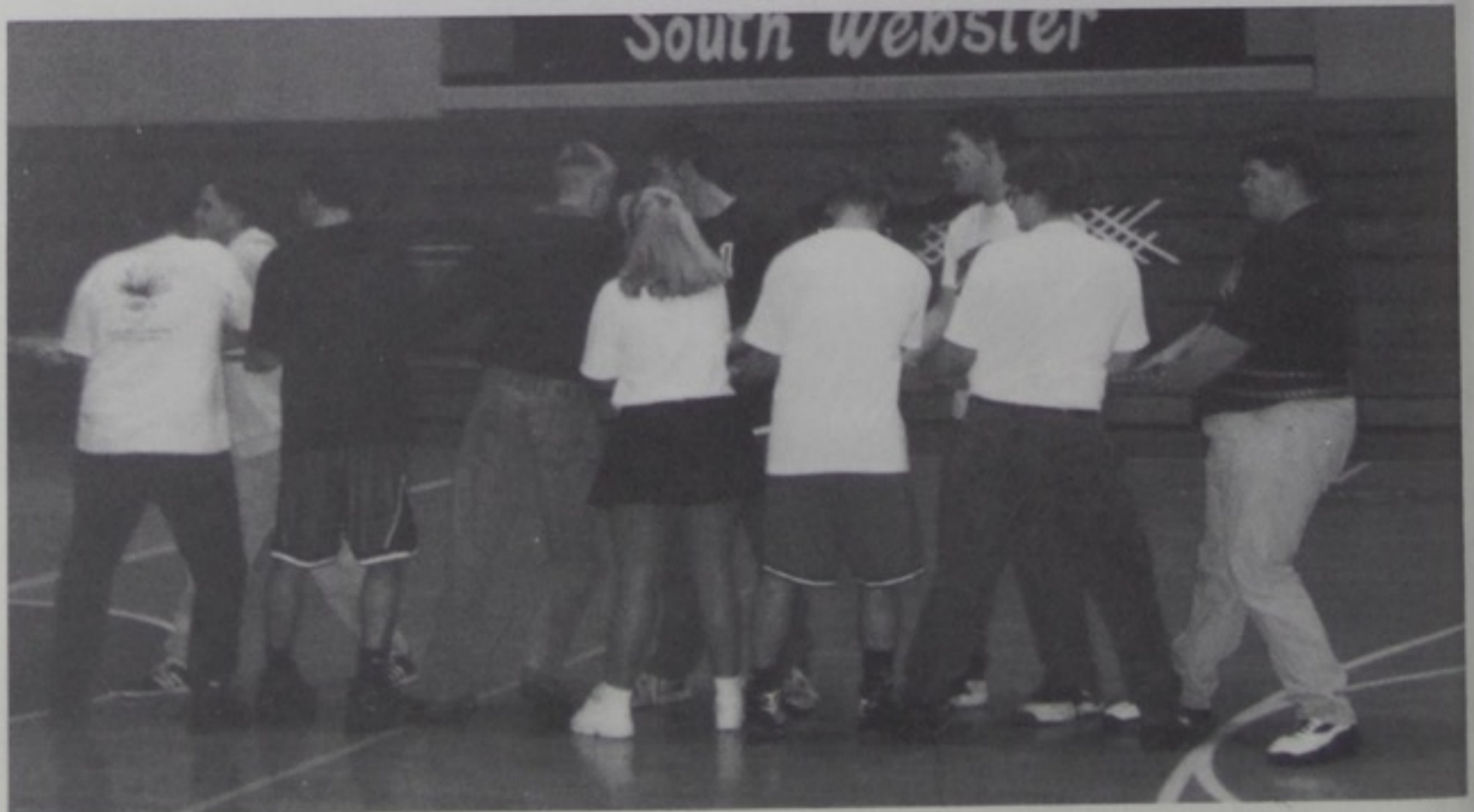


Haley Claxon did a wonderful job in the 1995 Miss River Days pageant. She was awarded the title of Miss River Days second runner-up.

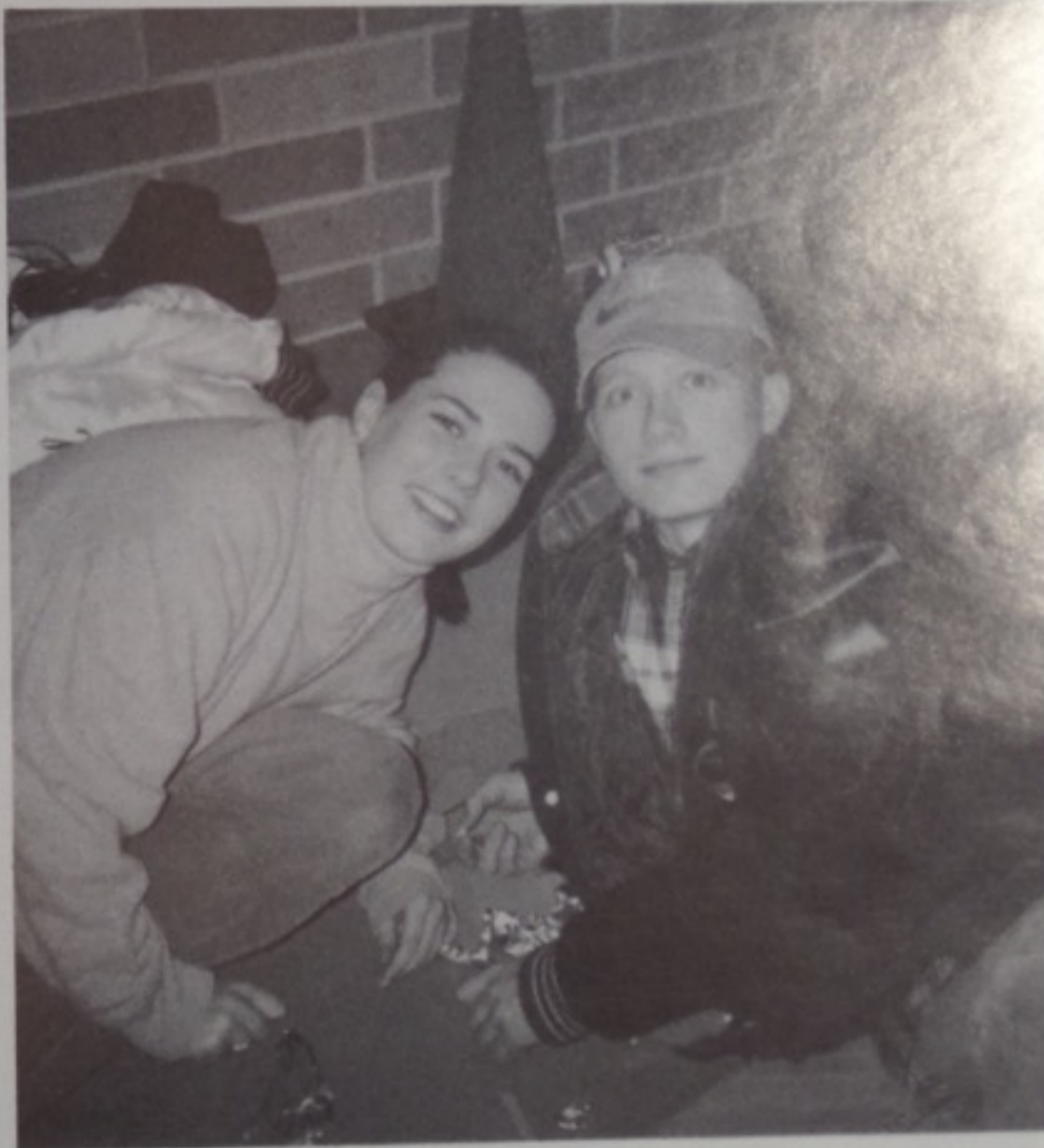

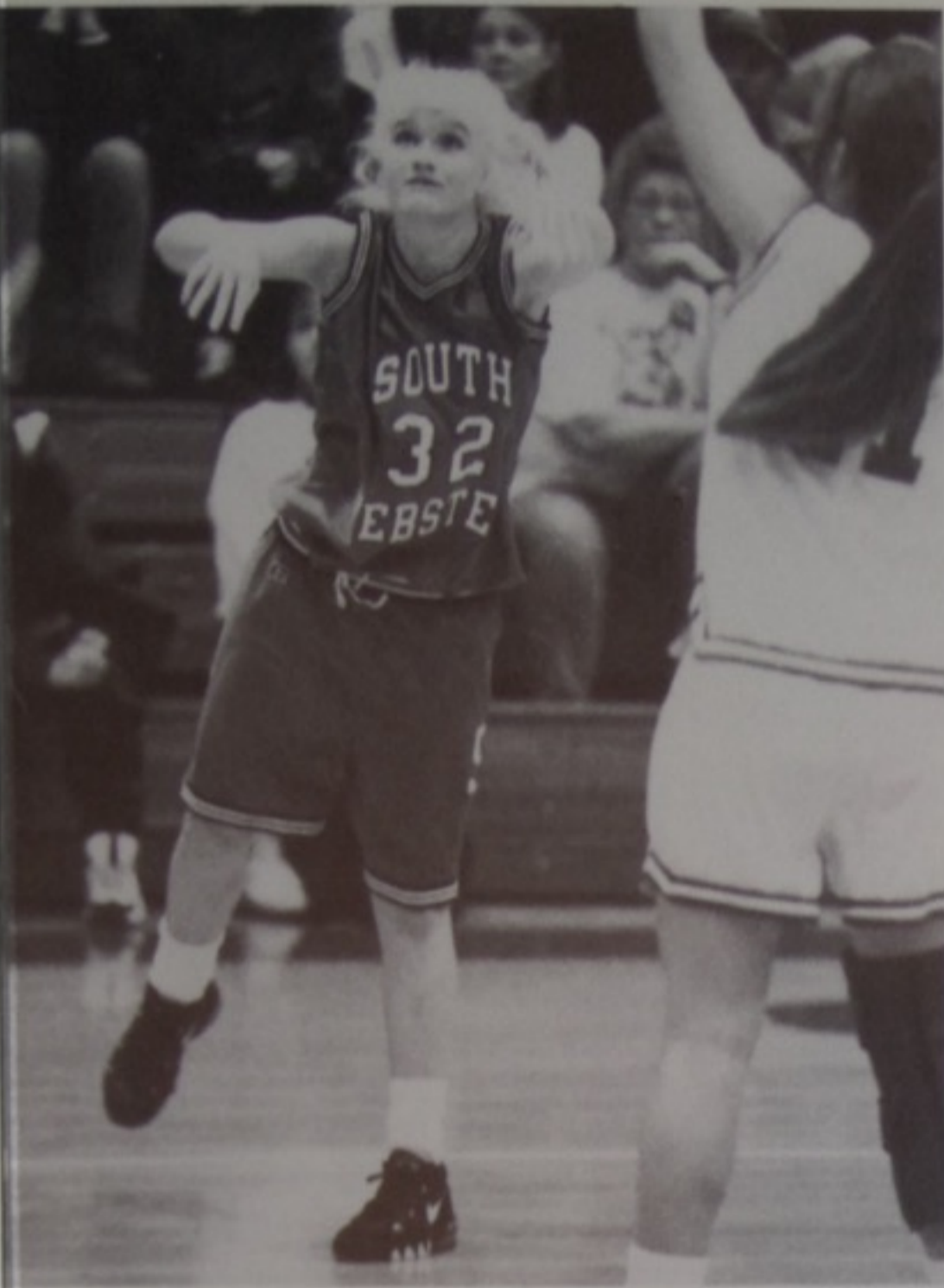

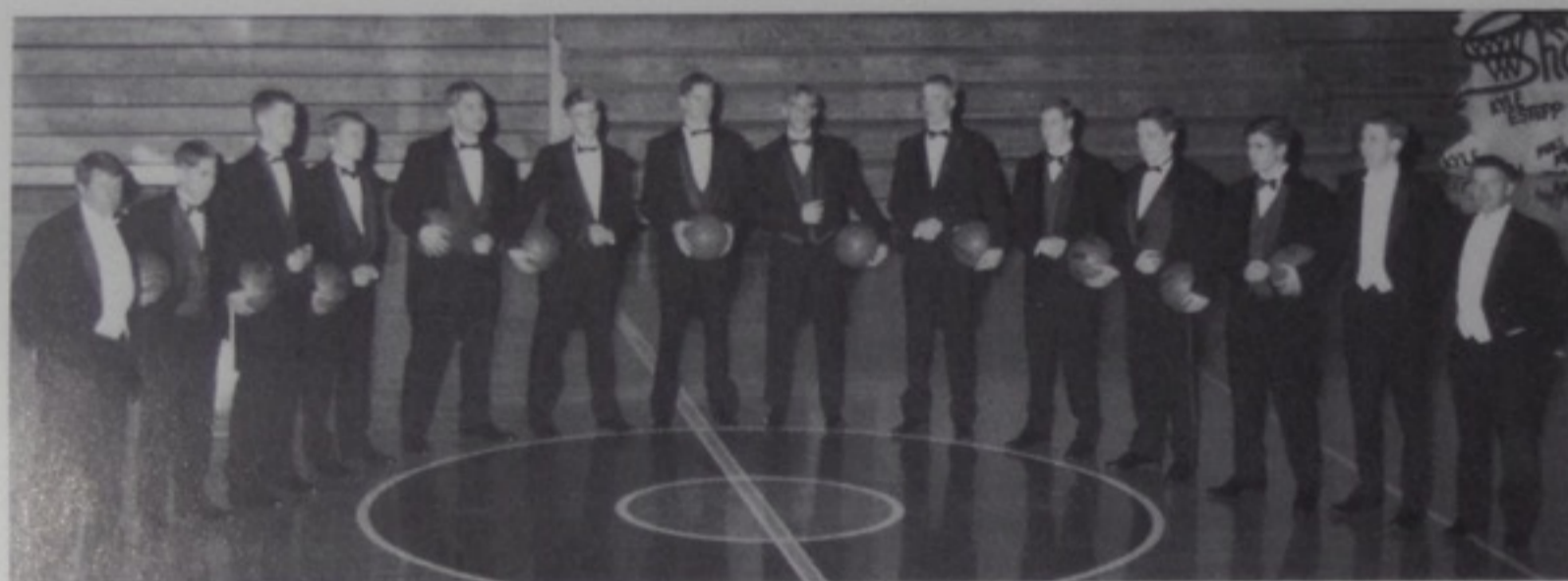

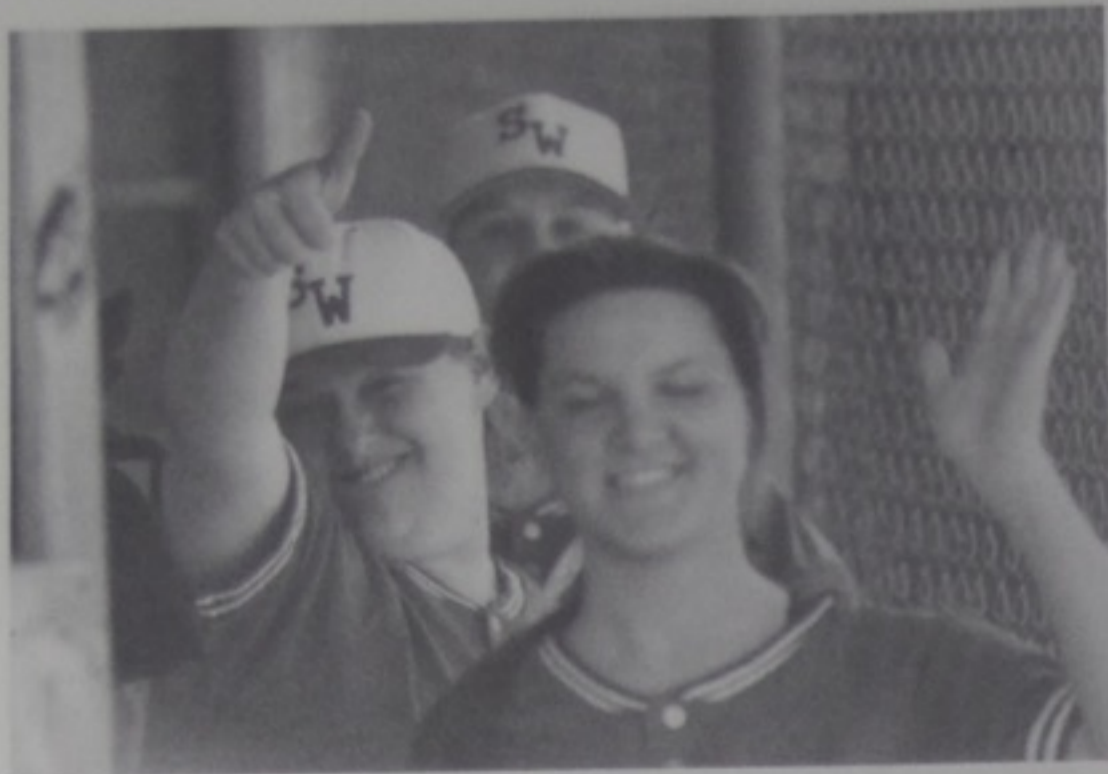
