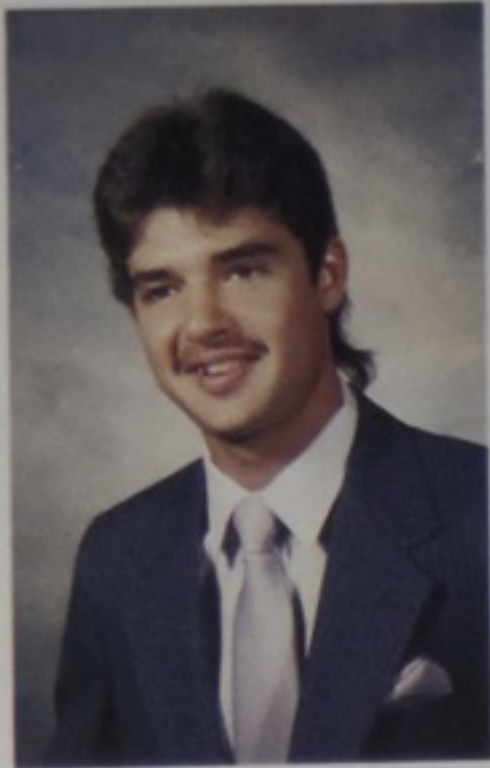

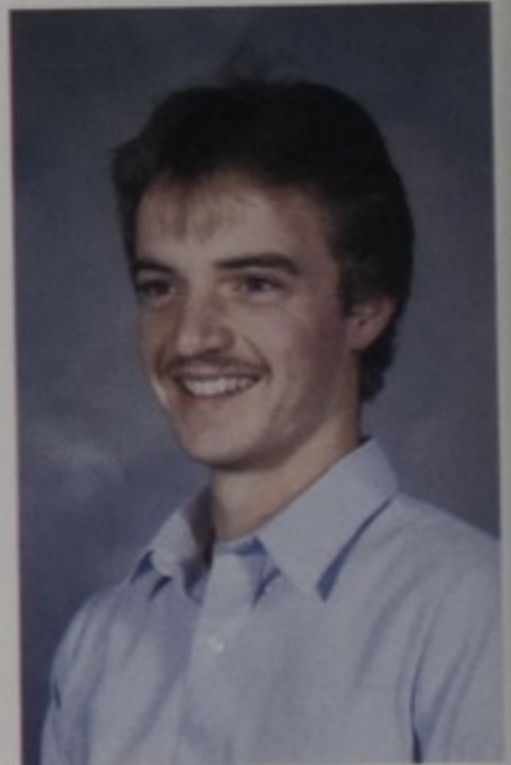

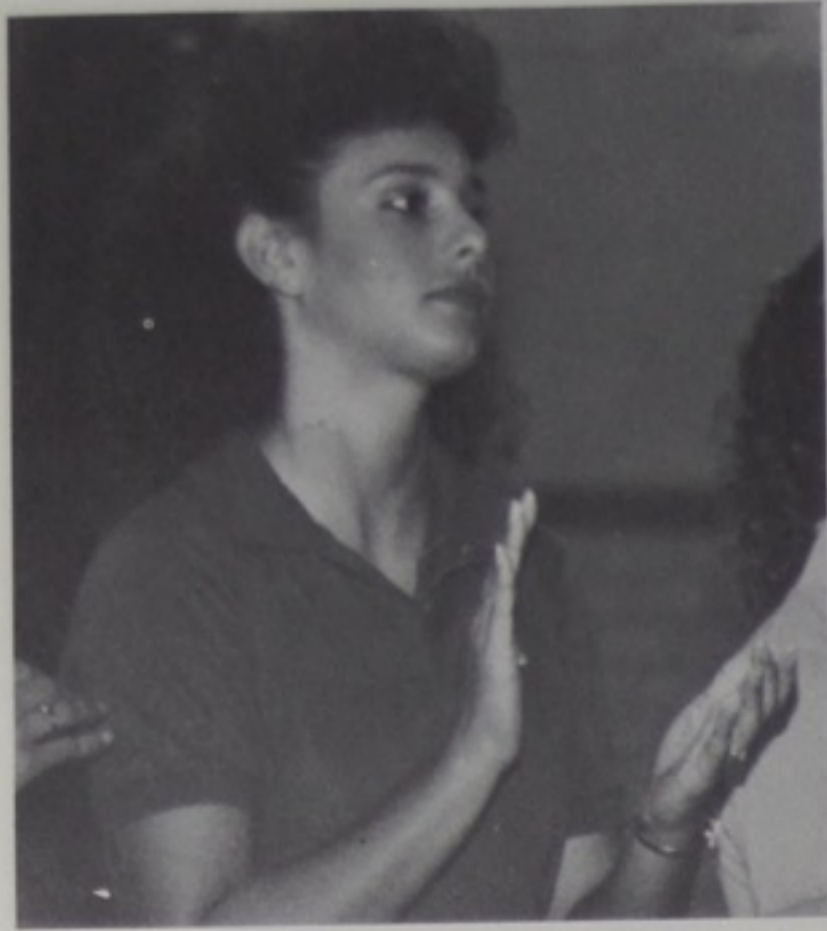
AND WHAT DO WE REMEMBER?

SCIOTO FURNACE ELEMENTARY 1930-1988

The original Scioto Furnace School was built in the 1830's with 99 students attending.

In 1870, a new school house was built to replace it at a cost of \$685.42; and in 1880, this one was made into two rooms with an entrance hall added.

In 1884, a third large room and a bell tower were added for \$669.00. There were 116 students.

With the coming of the brickyard, the number of students increased. In 1923, a one room brick school house was built in addition for \$3,950.

The next school building replaced all the others and is the present one, Marshall School, pictured left, named for Samuel Marshall, one of the first permanent settlers in Scioto County and buried at Scioto Furnace. It was constructed in 1930 for \$26,977. This building accommodates the first six grades of the local students.

As of June 3, 1988, this building is discontinued. The students will be bussed to Bloom Elementary in South Webster.

Both men made major contributions to the progress and improvement of education in Ohio's schools, and the McCowen Scholarship is intended to continue their commitment to education. The Scholarship is awarded annually to a graduating senior at South Webster High School who plans to pursue a teaching career. The first scholarship will be awarded to the class of 1989.
