She will be remembered by past and present students for her devotion to the principles and high standards that are a part of Glenwood High School.



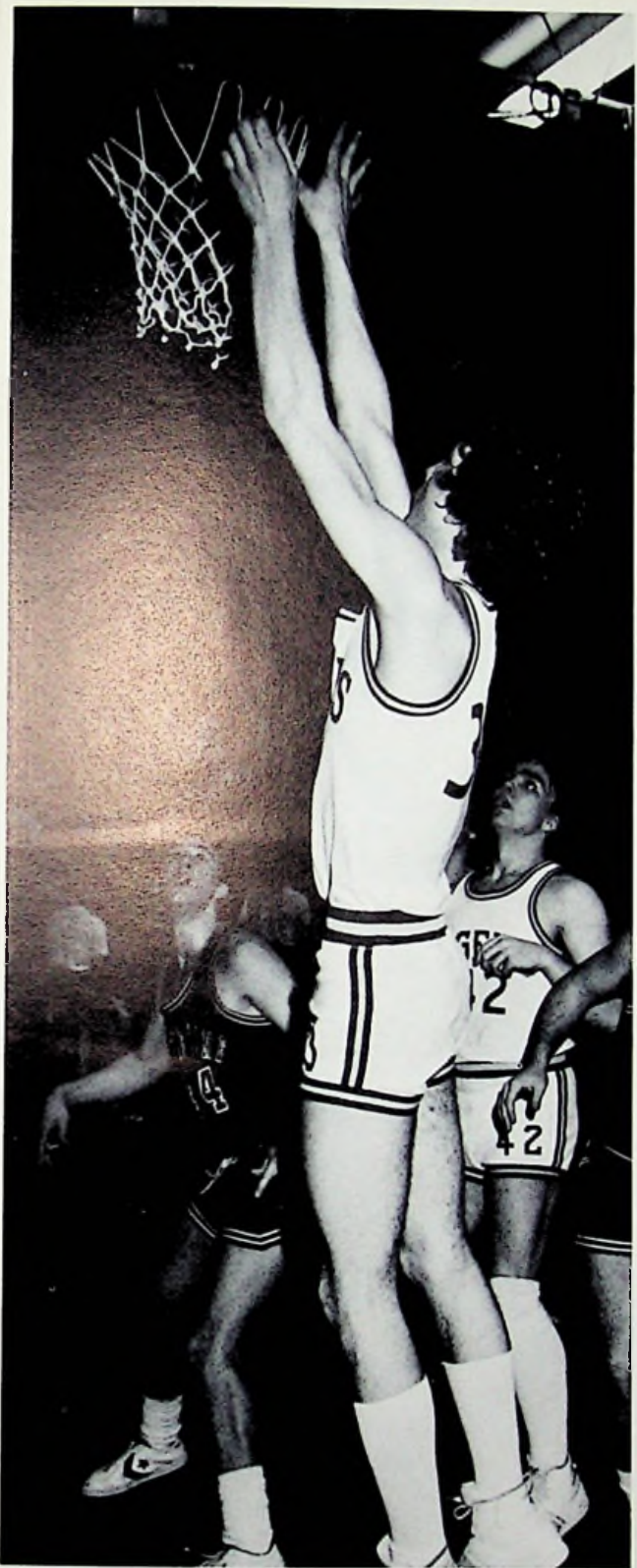

# THE MURDER ROOM



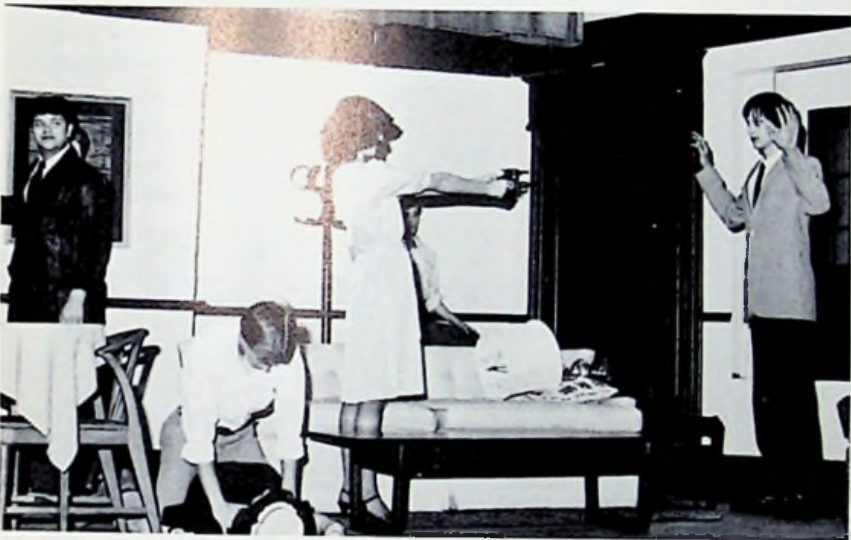
The Murder Room was performed on April 16, 1983 by the Junior class. Mr. Dave Snyder was the director.
