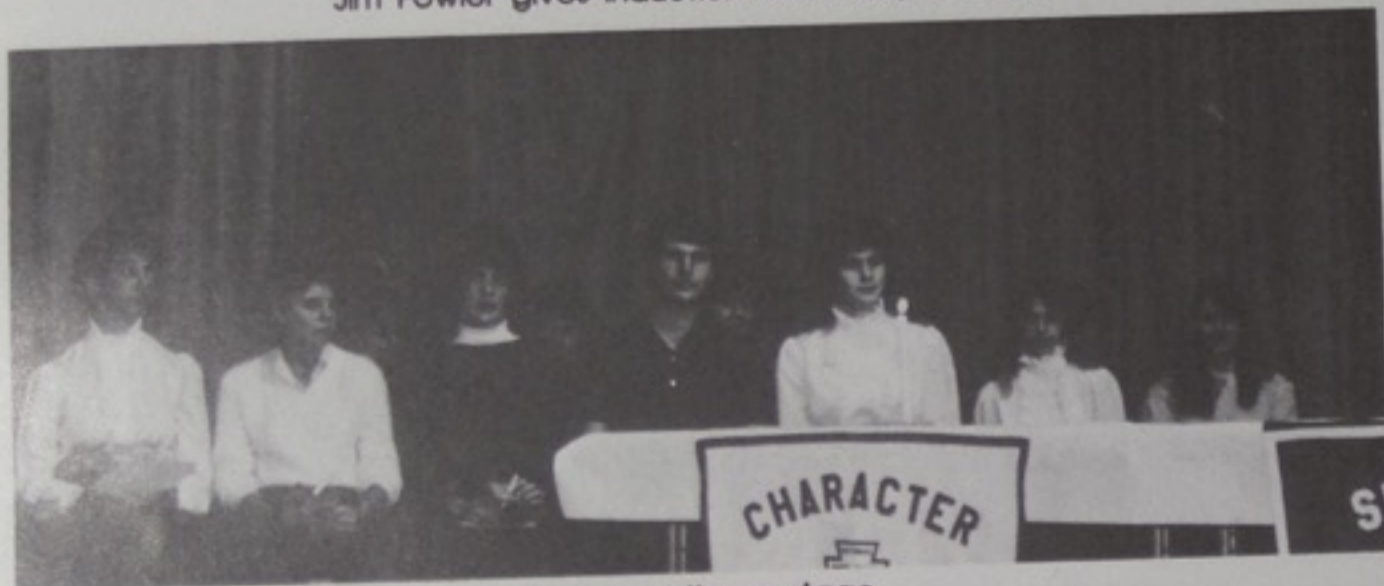
# NATIONAL HONOR SOCIETY

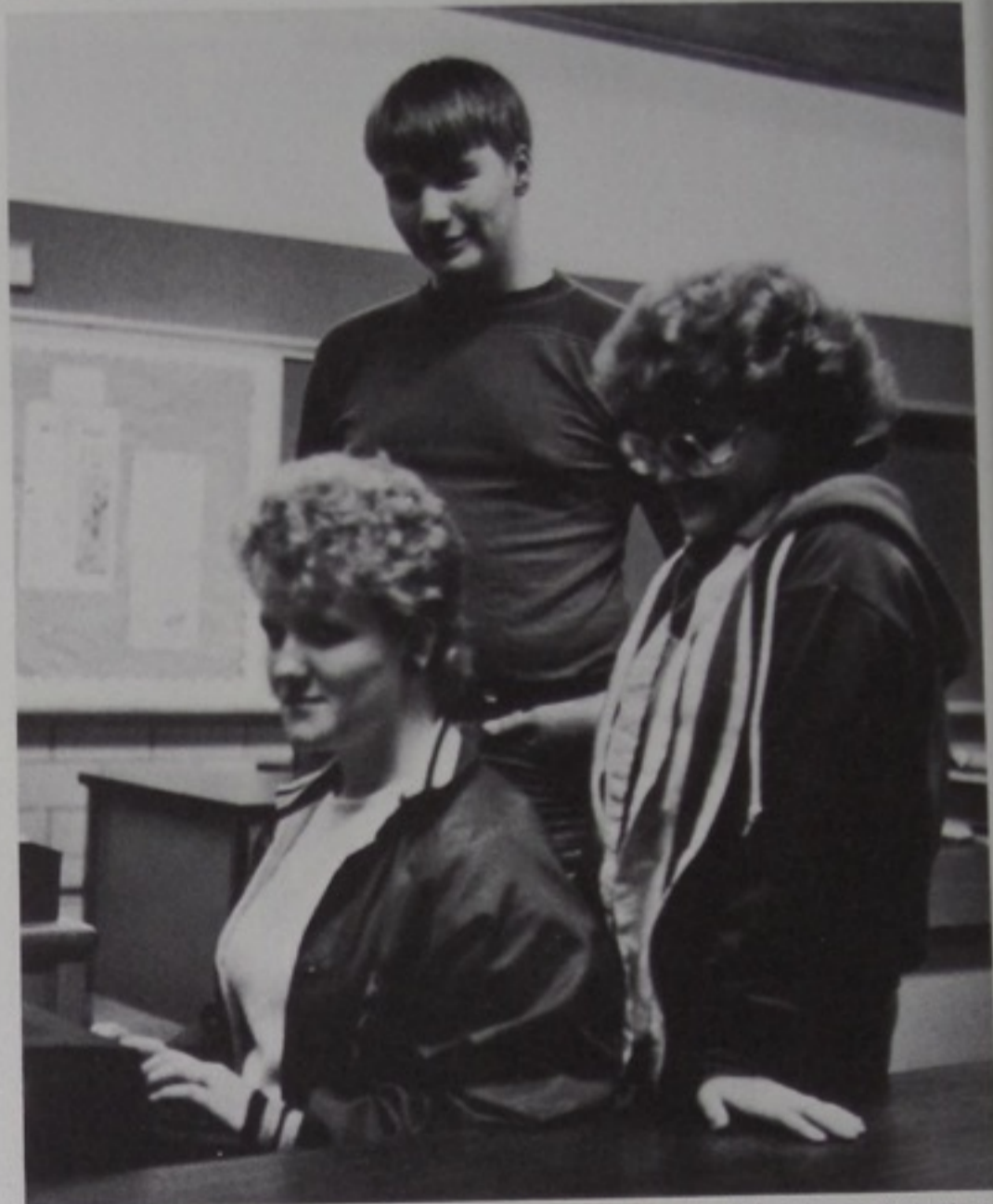

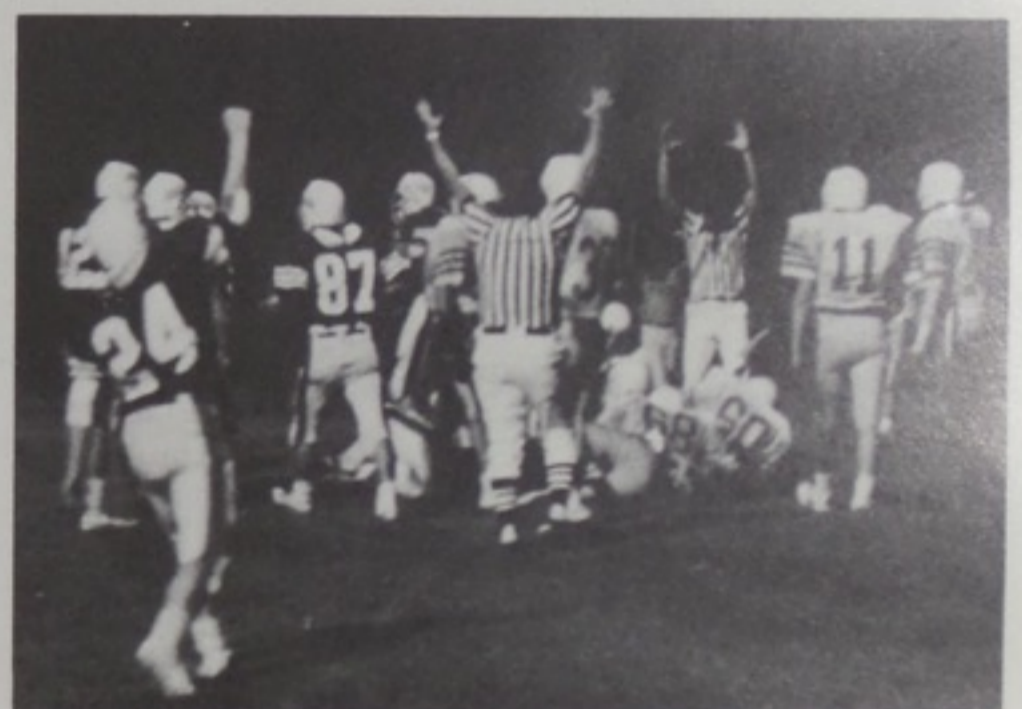

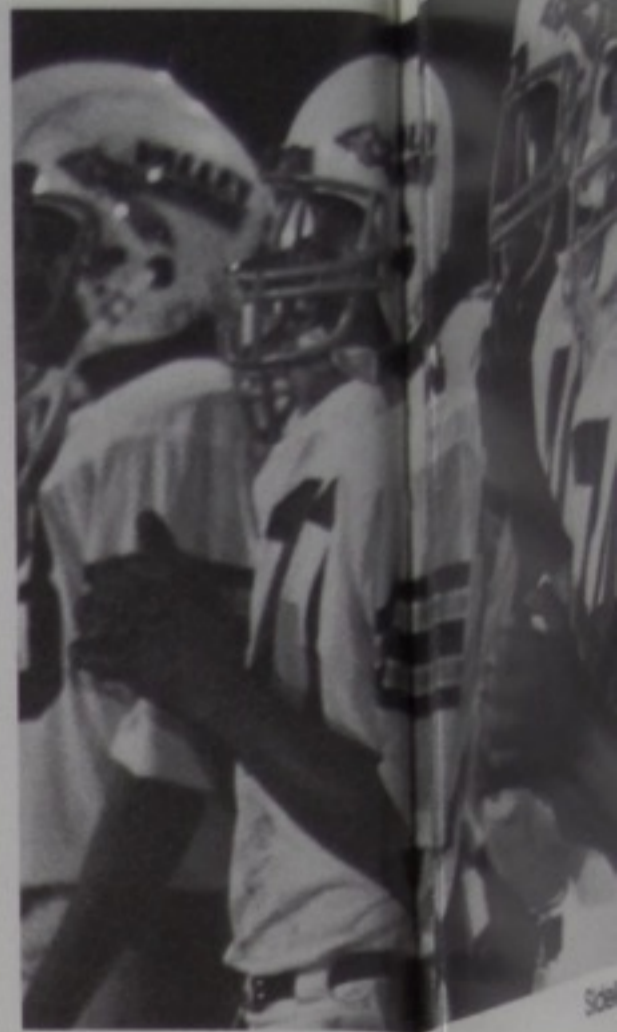

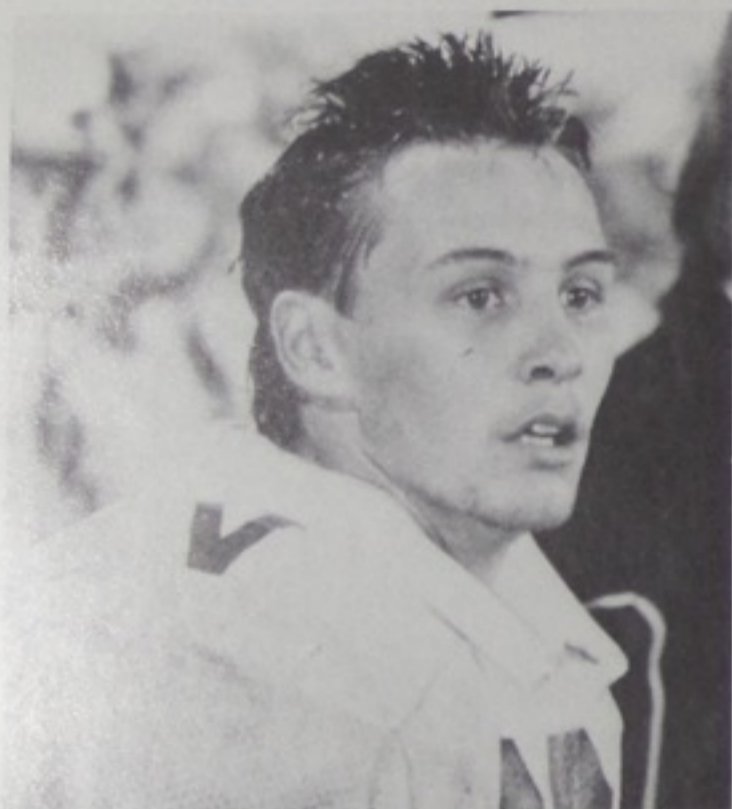

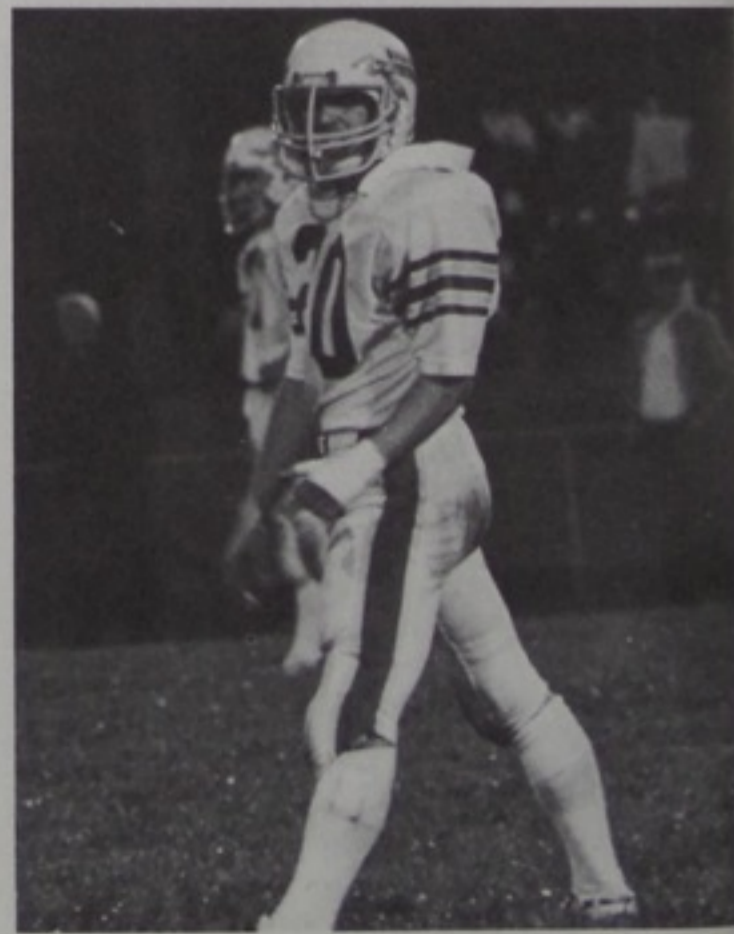

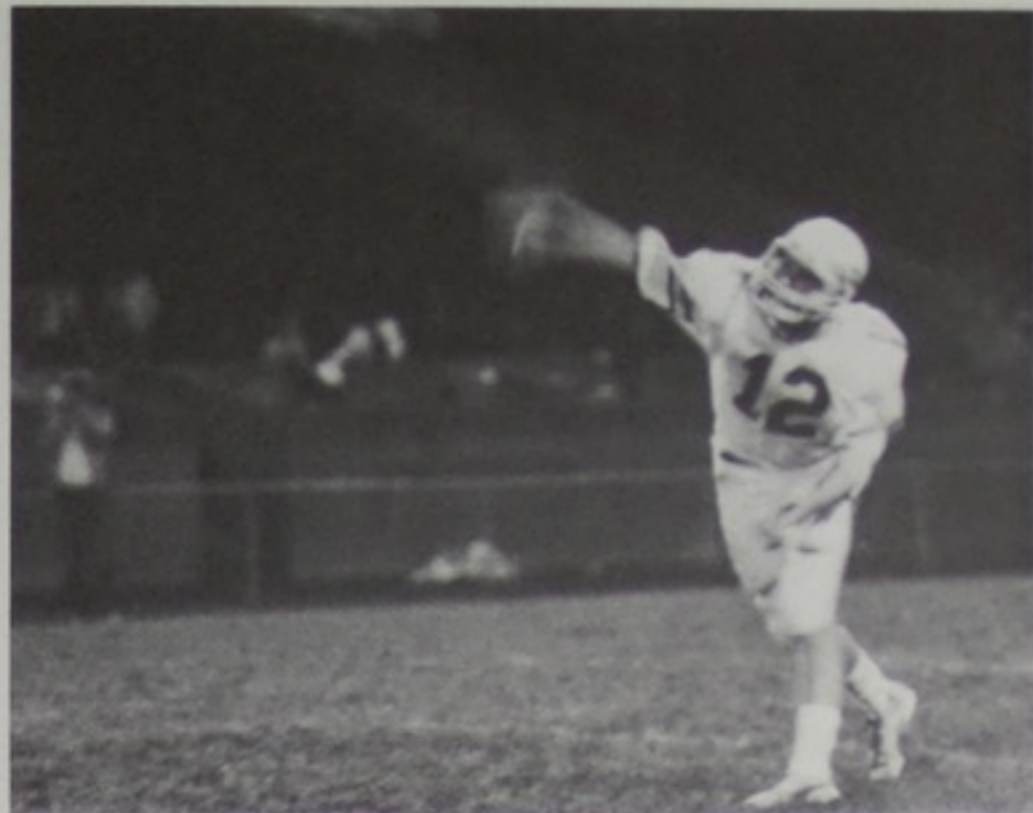

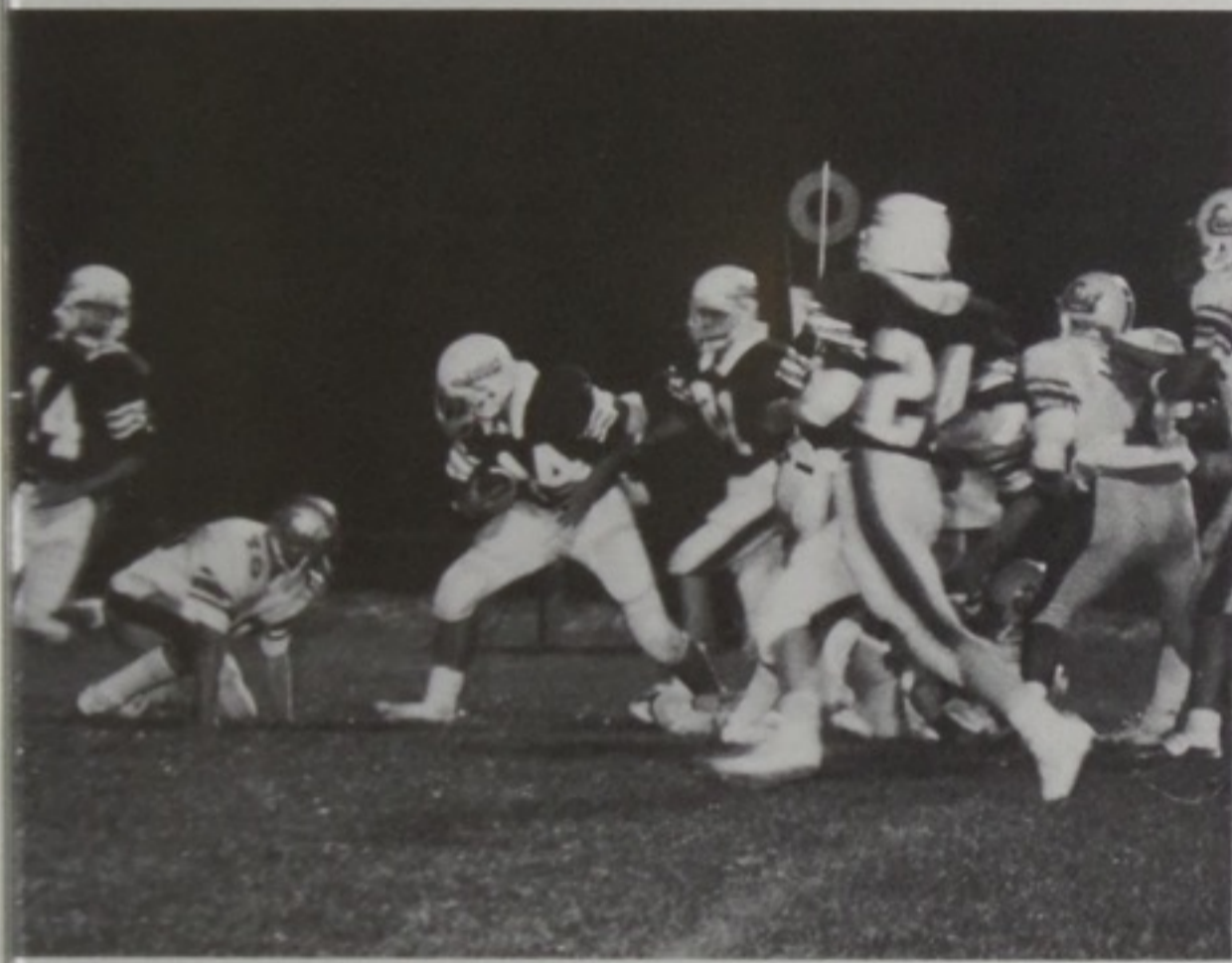
