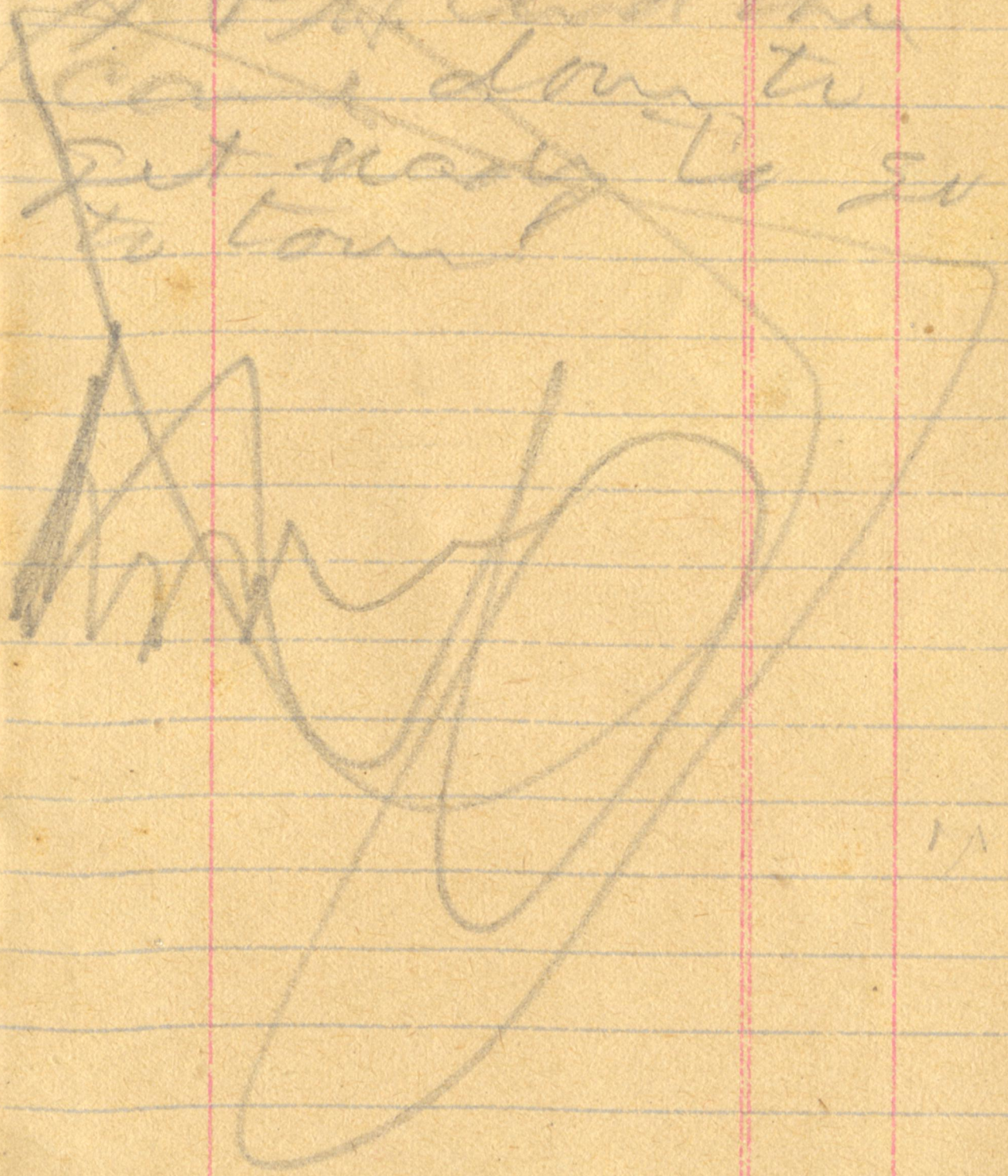


May

lot of tracking  
to do.  
He did not get  
back until eleven  
o'clock. Tired out  
and sleepy.



Fri. May. 24.

A quiet day  
A frost this  
morning.

I worked in  
the orchard all  
day.

Plants in planting  
area.

Sat. May 25.

A quiet day.  
Threatened rain but  
failed.

I worked till noon  
in the orchard.

I spent the rest  
of the day at the  
spring.

some mowers used.
