Fri, Feb. 1.  
A cold night last  
night and a cold  
day to day.  
We hayed pools  
and fixed the  
sheep racks  
and got the  
stalk in good shape.  
Stalk needs close  
attention.

The eggs were laid  
by hibernating  
The cold would  
seem to heat  
them.

Thurs July 4  
Spent day  
alone making  
gun. Keeping  
dry took the  
leaves down  
and headed  
them. Spent  
forenoon  
out set up  
in the angle is  
ready for  
falling a  
tree.

Sat. Feb. 5  
A damp day  
Began to plan  
the morning  
but turned to  
rain and rain  
continued. The  
sun went down  
and rock  
I just ready  
and found  
eggs in my  
fathers gun  
I have been  
away from a  
week. Saw  
a long time  
by above all  
well

Sun Feb 6  
A fine day  
Wrote a lot  
but I have  
done a lot  
today. Also  
Ella & I went  
down to the  
boat yard  
Ella & I  
came from  
the station  
and called  
on Tom's  
his wife  
affectionately  
had a pleasant  
all.

Mon Feb 7  
A fine day  
I have  
done a lot  
The boat  
is still com-  
ing along  
most of the  
time  
and we are  
going to  
make the  
Hudson the  
rest of the

A fine day  
Warmer  
Sunny a little  
Very nice for  
the birds.  
Birds all colors  
and sizes  
seen at Halloway  
and park.

Wed. Feb. 8  
A nice warm  
day. Cloudy  
So far up hill

by birds in  
the sand

about 200  
birds of

120 are

today.  
Ellie is late  
better.

Mon Feb. 14.  
A nice day  
I got up at  
thee o'clock this  
morning and  
soot out to  
Margaret's to  
help Smith  
and bring the  
samples & packages  
home.  
I got thee up  
at eight.  
There was scarcely  
time to go to Badin  
I had a long  
pulling the road  
over. And not get  
home until 2 P.M.  
I got & loaded  
up a bag of hay  
to take home.

Tues Feb. 15.  
A rainy day  
We did not get  
out much. It  
was very  
windy & very  
cold.  
Snowed a little  
Narrow flower  
and hauled no  
manure.  
I went around  
all day today  
by the walk.  
Ellie & I got out  
sample garden  
seeds from  
the Congresswoman  
a few little  
fruits.

Fri. Feb. 14  
A nice day  
Slept hard  
this morning  
Haven't had  
much sun.  
& cleaned the  
garden off in  
the red house  
After dinner  
Very cold loaded  
up a couple  
of loads of  
fertilizer  
and pulled  
them across the  
creek.

Thurs. Feb. 17  
A nice day  
Slept hard this  
morning.  
Slept 40 &  
a lot of goats  
baited here  
to go to  
beginning not  
just their will  
30 mts.  
The first in road  
and placed  
back. 3 days  
ago.  
Had time to  
pack up the  
about 10 o'clock  
The house was  
about plowed out  
Ella sold some  
pegs to Knecht

Fri. Feb. 18

A small rain  
fall last night  
but a very  
cloudy day.  
Wash old  
barrier & then  
the cyclone came  
The ditch  
and the road  
of the Bellies  
came over after  
eggs to set.

Sat. Feb. 19

A very cloudy  
foggy soft day  
Clouds off toward  
Lycoming  
High & cut  
the trees by apple  
trees down  
and named them  
over.

Ella went out  
home with Bert  
this afternoon  
as there came  
over and brought  
4 pugs of water  
to stop the  
some days ago

Syr Feb 20

had rain  
cold day

At home all day  
tending to the  
talk.

Put in most of  
the day.

Concord old  
days.

Mon Feb. 21.

A cold had day  
Snowed several  
sporadic  
but melted  
most all off.  
Haying cleaned  
up the wood  
and rail of  
the field back  
of the barn.

Pegged the  
field to keep  
for the cool part  
in the shade  
and to prevent frost  
Haying up and taking  
to Shepard and  
got his male hog  
Ella is my help  
on her back  
she was thin

Yunnan Feb 22  
A cold snowy day  
Spent a little  
Stayed cold  
Slept & dozed  
over to the bus  
to the station  
At Yunnan  
desert and a  
walked along  
to the village  
and thought  
to my father  
in a lama hall  
I saw the  
monks  
and some  
old people  
all spattered  
with mud  
and my father

Feb 23 19  
A cold morning  
Spent some  
time at the station  
On up the valley  
to the station and  
then took the train  
first east to Chihku  
to get the car back  
back to Yunnan  
Spent a few hours  
fixing the other  
broken parts  
Gave up this  
to get a new  
I got a hot water  
tub bath  
Having washed the  
car after with a  
cold

Fri Feb 24  
A blueting day  
Several short  
squalls came  
up but melted  
away  
A plain old tie  
Hanging & pulling  
wood off the back  
till now placed  
Hanging plumb in  
the rest of the  
shale. Gaff  
comes out &  
looks at the  
crumb.

El jones closed  
off him through  
the hole he cut  
for Sims to work on

Fri Feb 25-  
A nice day.  
Dinner & fixed  
the hole ready  
to raise it  
a front and  
act to get it  
per the J.P.

Sat. Feb. 26.  
A cold quiet day  
I hauled my  
barrel clay  
out of a hole  
earl till now  
& then loaded  
two barrels of  
molars and 3  
barrels of clay  
and brought  
by my father's car.  
At Chico I  
did not get  
the muck  
late.  
All of their long  
walks back to  
the depot  
Ella with the  
Hanna Cull &  
we whipped in.

Sun Feb. 27.  
A nice day  
cold, at midday  
I hauled out  
the sand all day  
with Ella  
She is not feeling  
very well.  
Ella & Ida  
took a walk  
over the hill  
to the winter  
patch.  
Ella & I took a  
roll and cut  
any mangers on the  
stock farm.  
We had a nice time  
I have spent  
the evening singing  
and played the

Mar. 28. 28.  
Up in morning  
and checked  
the wagon and  
took the program  
along to Mr. Shabot  
and then went  
over to town  
with Pa Correll  
The shucks  
were about  
engaging the pas-  
stalke & the  
quin long Bell  
& Parade beans.
