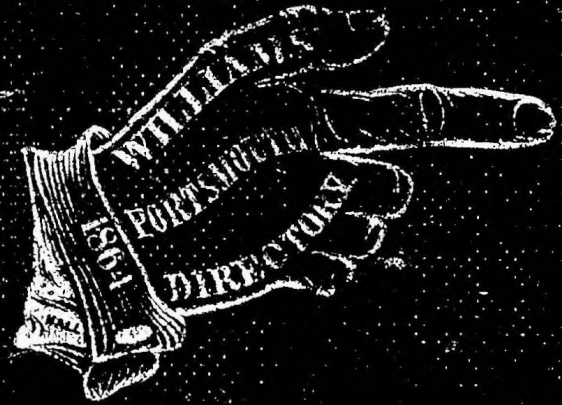

PREFACE.

THE Canvass of the City to obtain the information contained in the second issue of our PORTSMOUTH CITY DIRECTORY, has been a vexatious and laborious one. Many persons fearing that our canvasser was an "assessing officer," striving to obtain their names for the purpose of fixing an onerous tax upon their property, refused to give their names until lengthened explanations were given them; others, believing that we were collecting matter preparatory to the "draft," indignantly denied us the information which we sought. Had not the great body of the community, (whose intelligence enabled them to understand and appreciate our object,) cordially co-operated with us, we should in some instances have failed to obtain the necessary information for our Work. But, notwithstanding these obstacles and difficulties, we are enabled, through the faithful labors of an experienced canvasser, to present our patrons a reliable Directory, and one, which we confidently believe to be as accurate and complete as that of any City in the United States.

The Work embraces a General Directory—embracing a full list of the names and locations of the inhabitants of the City; a complete Business Directory—containing the name and location of each person and firm doing business in PORTSMOUTH; with a City Guide—containing the names of all the Streets, Alleys, Lanes and Avenues, giving their location and termini; also, the names of all Public Institutions, Banks, Churches, Societies, &c., in the City; together with a UNITED STATES POST OFFICE DIRECTORY—containing the name and location of every Post Office in the United States and Territories, arranged alphabetically, and corrected up to date.

The Compilers return their thanks to the Press for the flattering notices given during the canvass, and to the business men and citizens of the City for their patronage and very courteous treatment, and sincerely hope that their DIRECTORY for 1864 will meet with the approval of mercantile, professional and business men of the community, and be a fit representative of the public spirit and commercial importance of the CITY OF PORTSMOUTH.
