Tues. Jan 5  
It began to  
snow and hid  
fall for several  
to set in  
but quit snowing  
and began to  
get colder.  
Smith & I came  
over to Vermilion  
balked over to  
be ready to  
begin to  
bail hog.

Tues. Jan 6

A very cold day  
Smith & I  
set up the  
peck and  
began to  
chill her for  
Casson's Ice.  
She got a  
little over 8 tons

Thurs. Jan 7

A cold day  
Passed all day  
Smith took sick  
with the grip  
and had to go  
home.

Fri. Jan 8.

A cool morning  
but a nice

day.  
We baled hay  
and packed  
all day.

Bailed about  
6 tons.

We went to church  
but I came  
back to my  
boarding place  
before church  
was out.

I began to feel  
lousy.

Out here a never  
cold or any  
attack of Lagrip.

Sat. Jan 9

A fine morning  
and a nice day  
I woke up this  
morning with

the grippe.  
Tried to bail  
packed but had  
to give it up

and came home  
I started home  
at one o'clock  
and did not  
get home until  
sundown.

I felt about  
gone when I got  
home.

Sun. Jan 10  
A nice day  
Not able to  
out on the account  
of the grip  
All but  
feel dreadful  
bad with  
the grip  
Binton came  
down for the  
first time for  
3 days  
He has had  
a terrible  
with the grip

Mon. Jan 11  
A changeable day  
blowy, spit snow  
windy, clear, and  
thawed. but got  
cool at night  
I feel better but  
not able to do  
any thing  
Binton just  
able to do the  
peeing  
The rest of us  
better.



Thurs Jan. 12.

A nice day  
A fine time to  
work.  
I feel a little  
better but  
not able to  
be out much  
I cleaned the  
hog pens out  
and chored a  
little

Wed. Jan. 13.

A wintery looking  
time snowed last  
night but is not  
cold. Began to thaw  
I feel a little  
better but not  
strong enough  
to run to the  
barn and back  
without stopping to  
rest.

Gene hauled a  
little fodder  
and I chored  
what I could

Thurs. Jan. 14  
A damp foggy  
day.

I still sit  
around  
just feel dead  
and numb  
and so weak  
that I can  
hardly walk  
around.

Jan. went to  
mill  
Smith came  
home near  
noon.

Going to move  
over there

Fri. Jan. 15-  
Another damp  
foggy day  
Smith is getting  
a receipt ready  
to take to  
mill a little  
better.  
Have cleaned  
out the stable  
and made a  
lot of slop

Sat Jan. 16.

A nice warm  
day.

I feel a little  
better. I had a  
good lot and  
hauled my  
load of fags  
Gene went  
over to little  
Smyth.

Charles Gull  
came over to  
see his girl  
Bes Washuk  
came down  
after church.

A rainy bad

Smith has gone

Mon. Jan 18

A nice day.  
A cool day.  
I fixed around  
all day  
cleaned hog  
pens. Bill  
then mended  
haired paper  
and wood.  
Got ready to  
but they  
Ben Wasmke  
left for  
Shoshone  
Smith stayed  
out for 2 days  
to buy his  
provisions  
to go to house  
keeping over at  
Wormen Tree

Tues. Jan. 19.

A cold morning  
Thawed a little  
They butchered  
4 hogs.  
Smith has  
loaded his  
hug-hold  
belongings  
in to Jinks  
wagon and  
is ready to  
start for  
Wormen  
Cannon

Wed. Jan 20

A cloudy rainy

day  
I fired a saw!  
Sawed meat  
hauled two  
loads of poles  
and cleaned out  
stables.

Gene took load  
of snowshoes  
for Smith

Zeas Chappin  
came over to  
get the per cent  
of hauling  
logs across

which all going  
to build a  
covered barn yard

Thurs. Jan. 21

A nice day  
I turned a little  
log pile around  
all poles off  
the hill

Burton has a  
piece lot of Zeas  
cleared up of Zeas  
Gene took the  
log load of  
Smith

Bellevue  
Dynamite took  
the shacks  
and up  
with him  
Ma is terribly  
uneasy about  
them

Fri. Jan 22  
At skinned and  
muzzed until  
about noon  
and after  
I pushed the car  
up the hill  
and tripped the  
sled after tea  
got a nice lot  
of wood off

Sat. Jan. 23  
A nice day  
A little cloudy  
I got wood but  
last night but  
thawed a little  
I chopped some  
wood and hauled  
some in  
Got ready and  
wrote up to the  
quarry  
Had a good ride  
of it but a good  
time of us were  
there  
The old folks  
all got an  
well as per  
common

Sydney Jan. 24  
A very snowy  
cold day  
Snowed to pin  
point most all  
day  
I did not  
go out  
all day  
Had a nice  
visit  
For cold to my  
home.

Alton Jan. 25  
A very cold morning  
and stayed  
cold all day  
Lauie, Bob & I  
went out hunting  
and caught 3  
rabbits  
Came back by  
noon  
After dinner  
I started for  
home. While I  
arrived at dark  
Had to walk  
the most of  
the way to  
keep warm

Tues Jan. 26  
Another cold  
day  
Ski all day  
& hauled wood  
a half day  
Tried to trim  
stake the  
rest of the  
time

27  
Wed Jan. 27  
Still cold  
Snowed about  
an inch  
Hauled wood  
rough yet  
Ski & hauled  
faded a half  
day.



Thurs. Jan. 28  
A cold raw day  
I hauled wood  
a half day  
Chased the best  
of the time  
Old Beindle  
had two bulls  
calves. last  
night  
A cold time on  
them  
Gene went to  
Chester and  
settled up  
with Trip

Fri. Jan. 25  
A nice day  
but cold.  
I walked down  
to Upper Boston  
Stopped at Mr.  
Basham's and  
paid a note  
of \$7.20 cents  
And then went  
on to Lynn and  
paid the taxes  
\$1.87  
And then came  
back home by  
walking the  
most of the way  
Reached home at  
7 P.M.  
Took my time and  
was not very tired

Sat. Jan 30  
One of the cold  
nights and morning  
I furred as usual  
most all day  
Gene. work as  
legged of the  
up part was  
to the Smith  
He has some  
have eyes a  
little white

Sun. Jan 31  
A nice day  
Cold this morning  
but thawed  
during the day  
I don't know  
over by. Vernon  
after dinner  
Got back by  
sundown  
Smith & Jennie  
seems to be  
well satisfied
