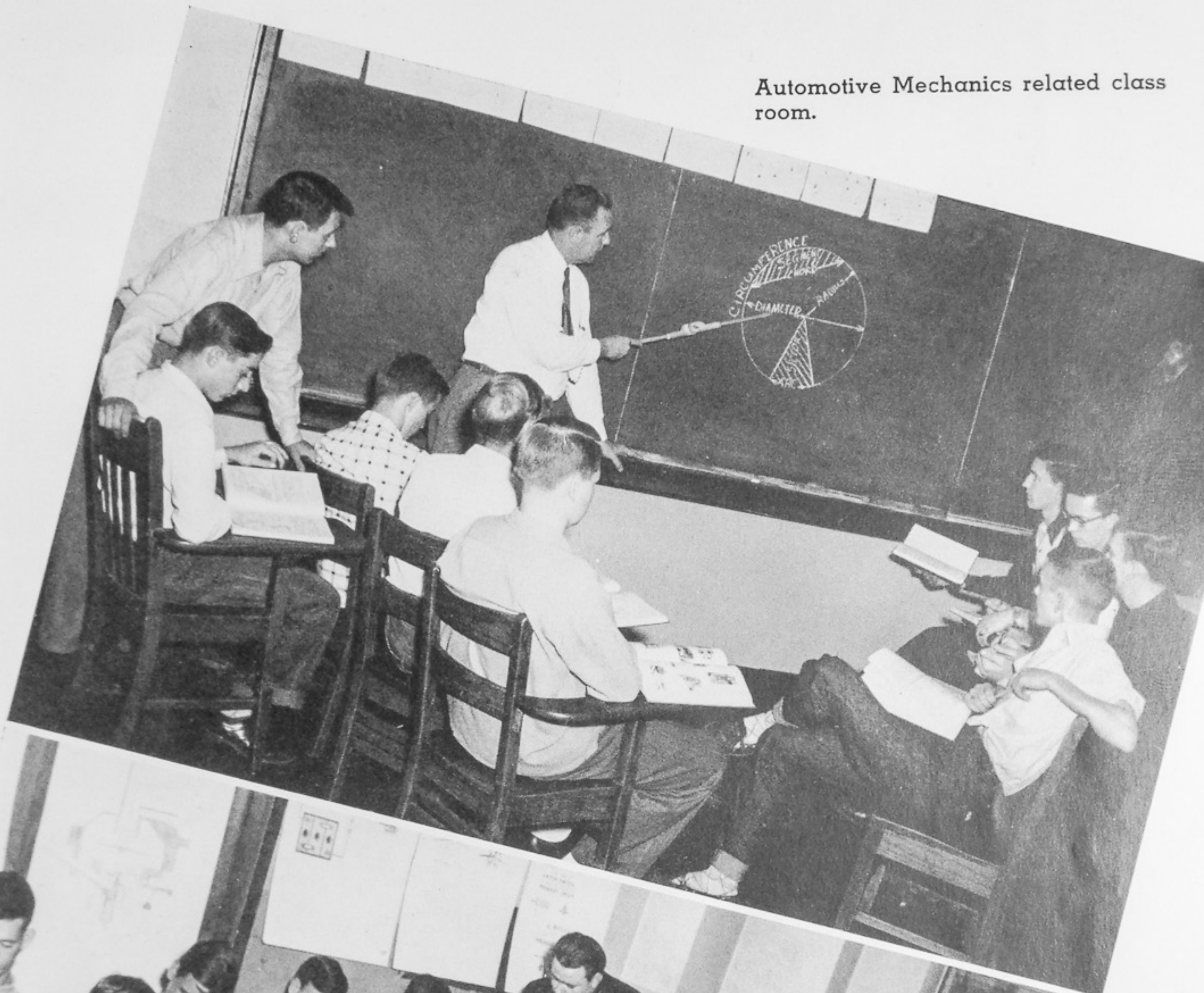

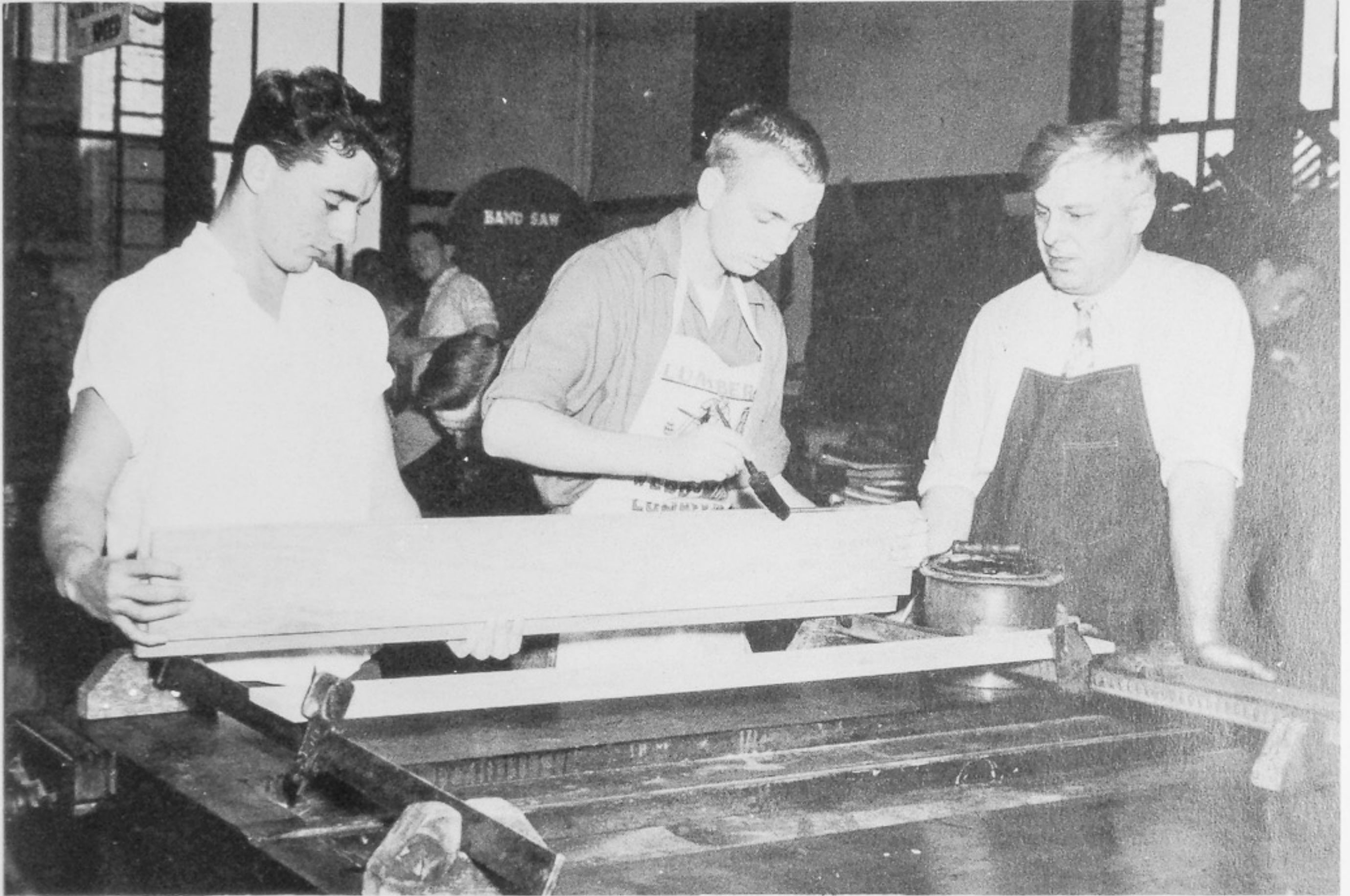

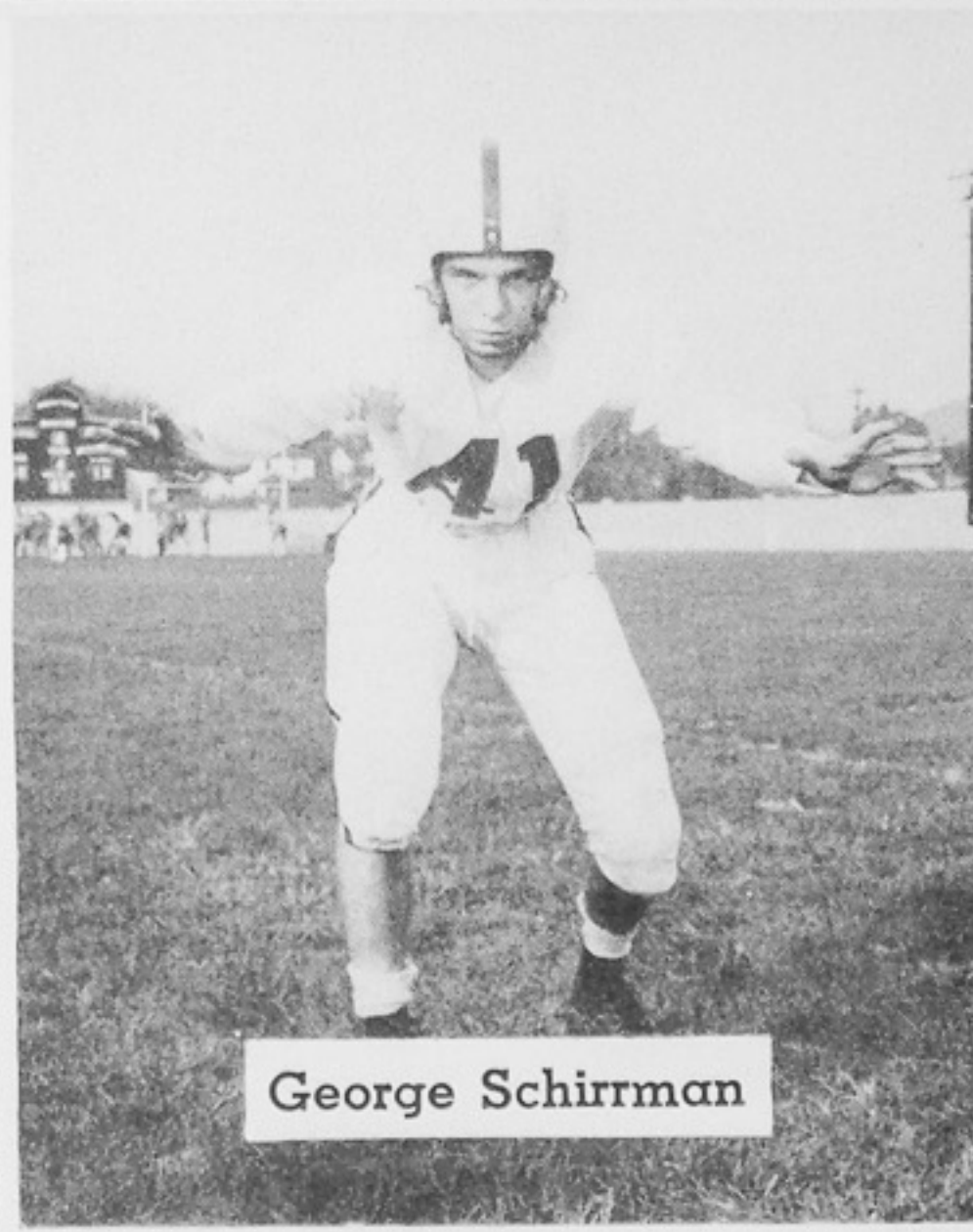
### Portsmouth 7 Ashland 13
