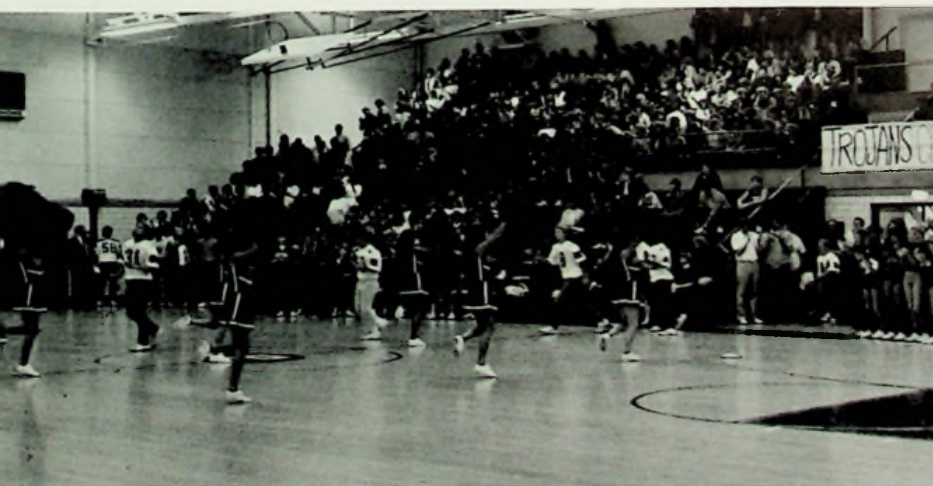

Sheri Turner was junior attendant. Sheri is the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Stephen Turner. She was escorted by John Danner.

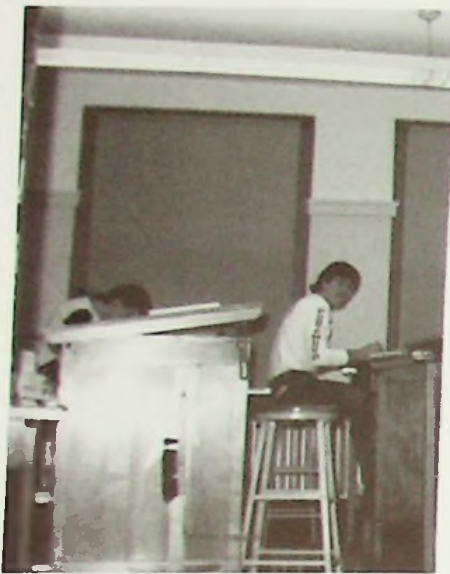
Lisa Howard was the sophomore attendant. Lisa is the daughter of James Howard and Connie Detillion. She was escorted by Jerry McGlone.

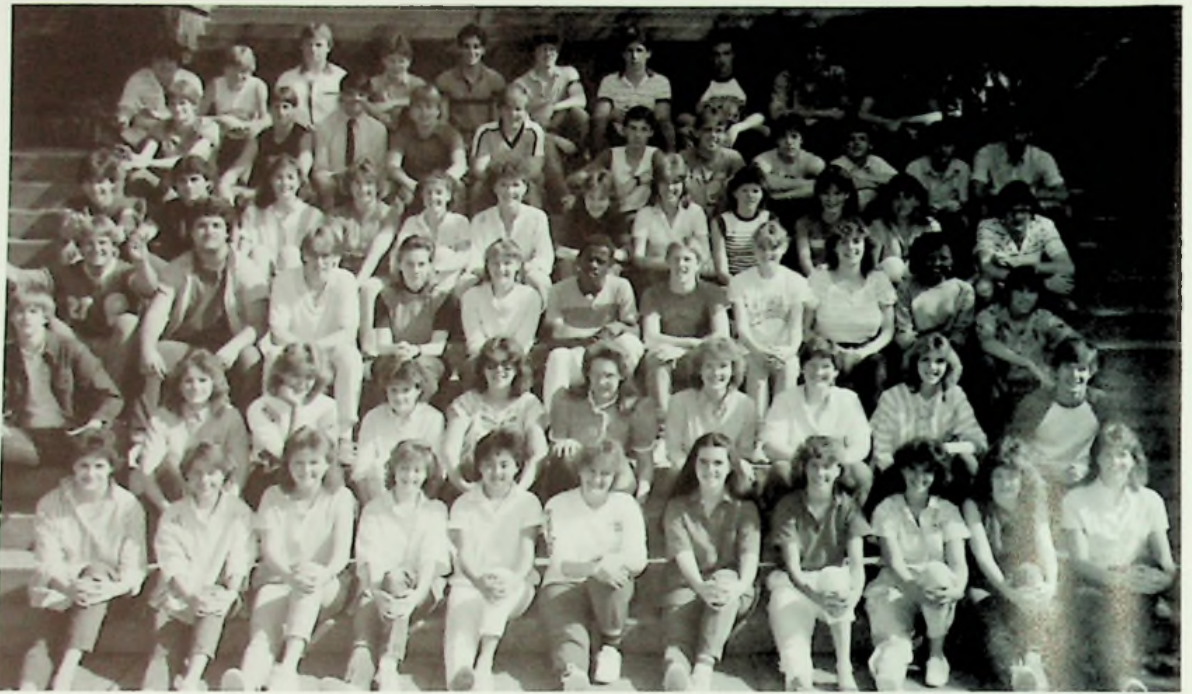

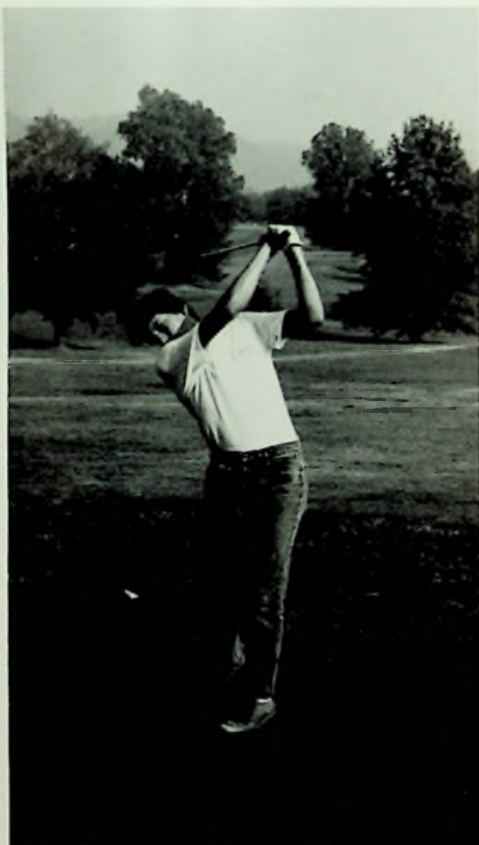

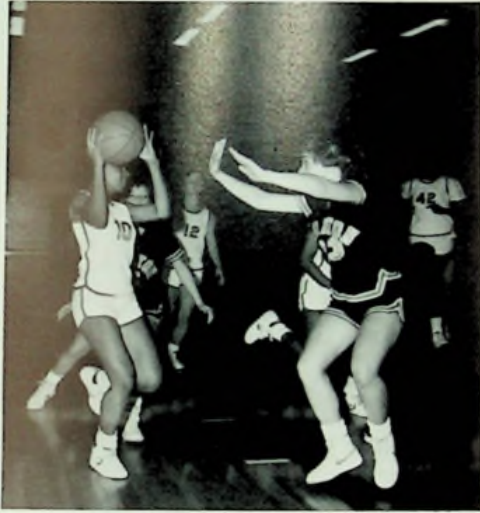
