"If I treasure liberty, I must become involved, for apathy and neglect are probably among the greatest hazards to freedom's existence.

To be truly free, we must work a great deal on our own, not depending upon government to grant all that we feel should be done, for a government that would possess the power to grant all such aspirations, would also be powerful enough to revoke our freedom.

I must be over vigilant to the dispossession of the sacred rights of my countrymen, for nonconcern for the rights of others, weakens my freedom.

I see freedom as involvement, with an option to chose my individual course of action. No one could ask more of me than to do my best in everything I undertake, and to help others to do the same. I must be myself, but ever yet realizing that freedom is not an indulgence in self pleasure, but is an intangible vehicle by which we can construct and maintain a better world for all mankind."
