Williams Manufacturing Co. couldn't get along without Carol Bays and Carol Bocook.

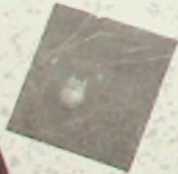
Shirley Bond has reached her goal and is traveling with T.W.A.
