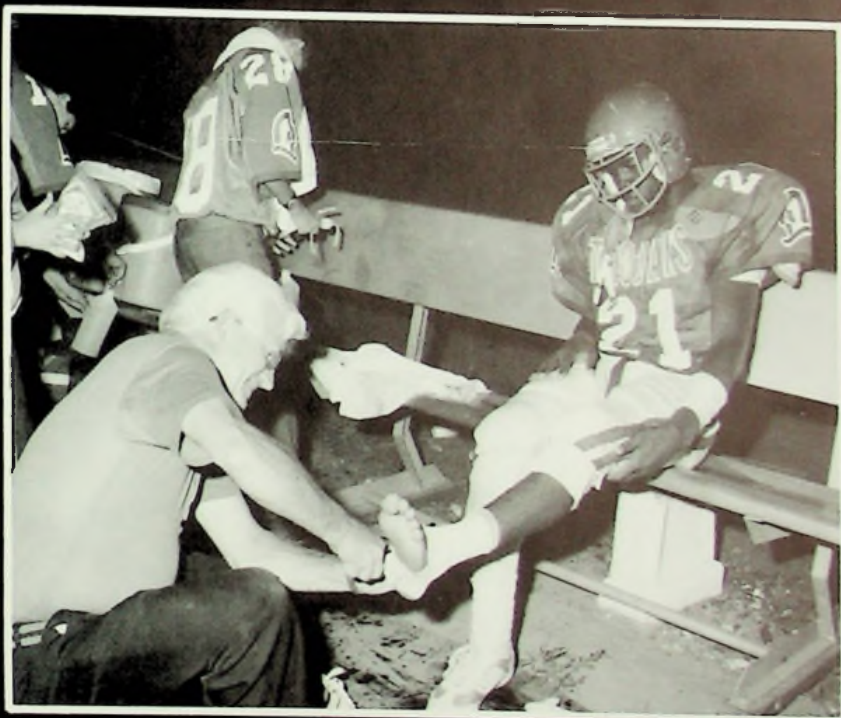




Thanks For The Memories

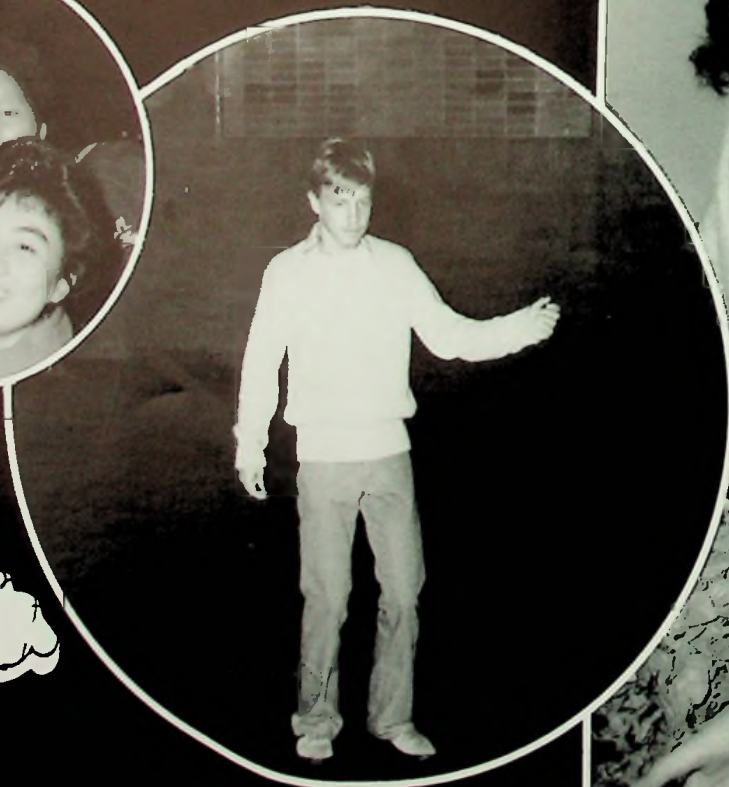






Magical Fall Dances . . .

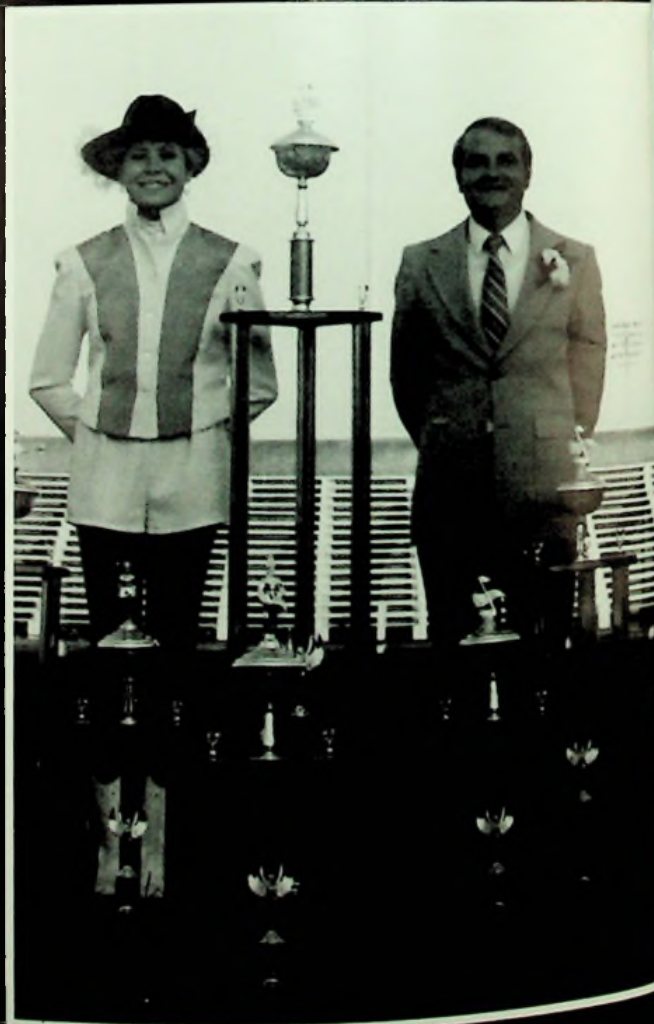
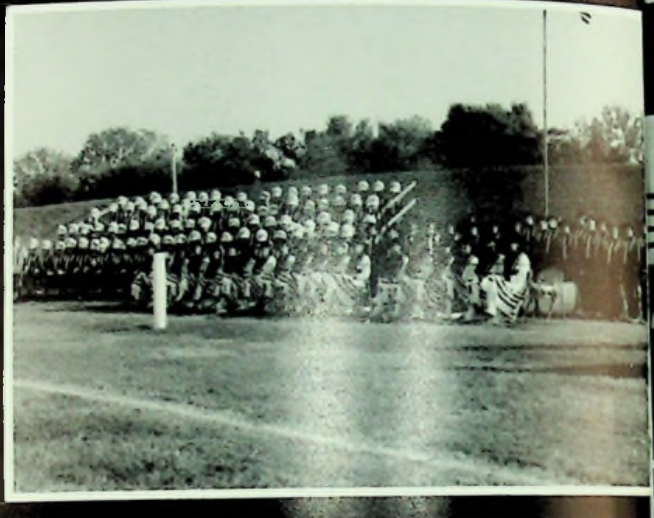


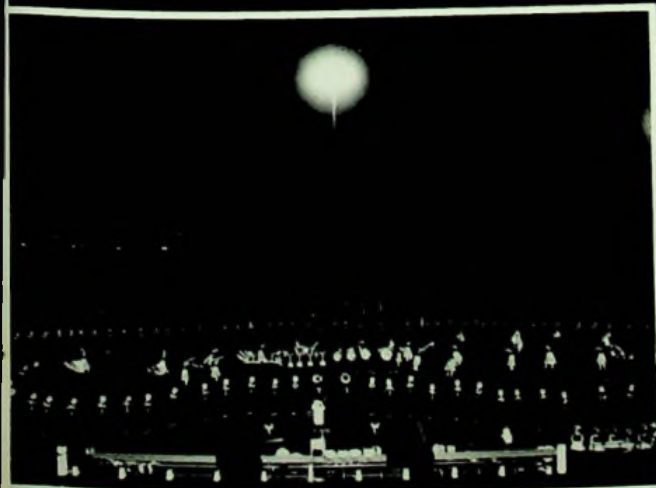
Caves And Kings

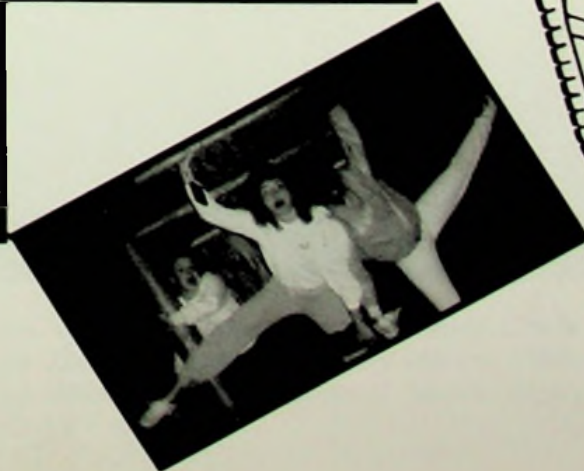

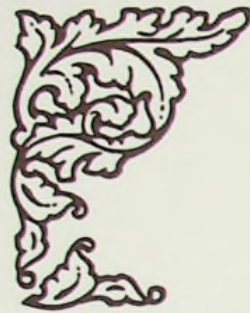

1st and 2nd place winners qualified for state competition to be held April 13, 14 and Columbus. Those who qualified for state exams were:

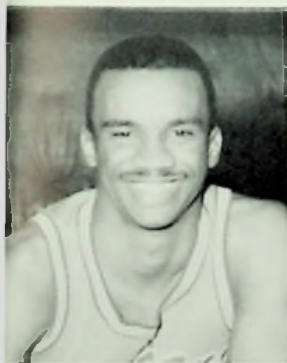

LOS VIAJEROS MEXICANOS

Jerry and Roberta Newberry spent their Easter vacation differently this year. The Newberrys and ten high school students vacationed in Mexico. Senora Newberry, Spanish teacher at East and Portsmouth High Schools, said that the students were very excited about the trip. Making the journey were: Front Row John Clayton, Chuck Harcha, Beau Lawyer, Jim Westerfield; Middle Row Jennifer Hatcher, Carol Clayton, Deborah Alexander, Mona Varhola (Notre Dame), Claire Fried, Roberta Sweet Newberry; Back Row Jerry Newberry, and Doug Shugert. Nine of the ten students were from Portsmouth High School.

The group went South of the Border "por las vacaciones de la Semana Santa (for Holy Week Vacation). Four years ago Mrs. Newberry took 14 students to Mexico. Every time she sees one of the former students, they always mention their memorable trip to Mexico; it will always be a big part of their lives. It's excellent for students to have the opportunity to converse with a native speaker. Those on the

excursion had to adjust to the air since Mexico is 8000 feet above sea level. The travelers got the opportunity to bargain in the open air markets, visit a discotheque, take in a bull fight, and see what Mexico is really like — "a country of contrast".

Students who went on the trip paid their own way, having saved since last October when they first began planning for their Mexican adventure. Once in Mexico, PHS students were joined by eight students from Connecticut. Their itinerary included the following: departure from Portsmouth at 4:30 p.m., flight to Mexico City and 3 days visiting the pyramids, Ballet Folklorico, the Museum of Anthropology, sightseeing; flight to Guadalajara for 2 days; flight to Puerto Vallarta for rest and relaxation in the sun, including swimming and fishing; and finally, the return flight on April 20.

FOREIGN EXCHANGE STUDENTS

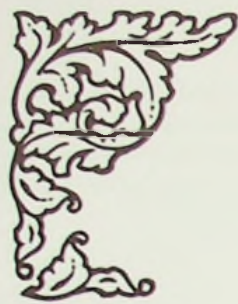
Ama Mingus and Rhonda Canter, morning and afternoon presidents of FHA presented gifts to Nun Kolsrichai, exchange student from Thailand, and Rutger Jobse, exchange student from Holland. Both students spoke to club members about their homelands. Mrs. Ann Sommers, FHA sponsor at PHS, arranged for the presentations.

Nun and Rutger stayed with local families. The Rotary sponsored Nun, while the Youth For Understanding Organization of NY sponsored Rutger. Both PHS and our foreign exchange students benefited from information sharing. Nun and Rutger told PHS students about life in their own countries — school, transportation, family structure, religion, government, foods, customs and similarities and differences in general between the US, Thailand and Holland.

Nun shared experiences familiar to him. Nun's school has about 5000 students, with some 60 students per class. Students in Thailand do not change classes. Much empha-

sis is placed upon education there, as in America. Due to a shortage in colleges in Thailand, students who wish to attend a university must take very difficult exams; only one student is selected from each type of exam given. The competition is great. English is taught only in larger city schools.

Rutger felt that US schools were more strict than in Holland. They have no substitute teachers there; if the teacher is ill, there's no class that day. Rutger's school has about 1100 students. Classes change from room to room as they do at PHS. Rutger wants to be a food nutritionist, a job which requires 7 years of higher educational training. In neither Holland nor Thailand are there extensive high school sports programs as in the US; Nun and Rutger enjoy Trojan and college sports here. Both exchange students agreed that they liked Portsmouth and that it was a nice and friendly place.



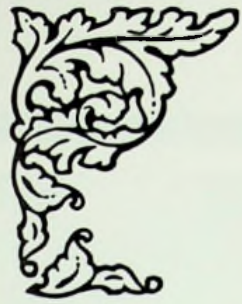
