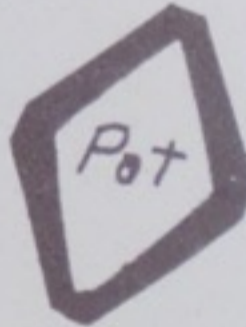
SENIOR CLASS HISTORY

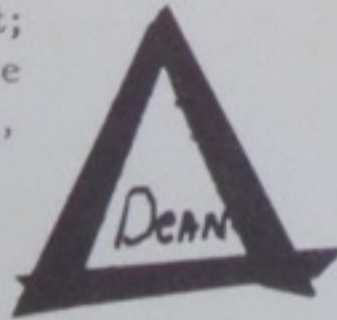
In our freshman year we elected the following class officers: Donald Rockwell, President; Betty O'Bryan, Vice President; Martha Conley, Sec. & Treasurer.
