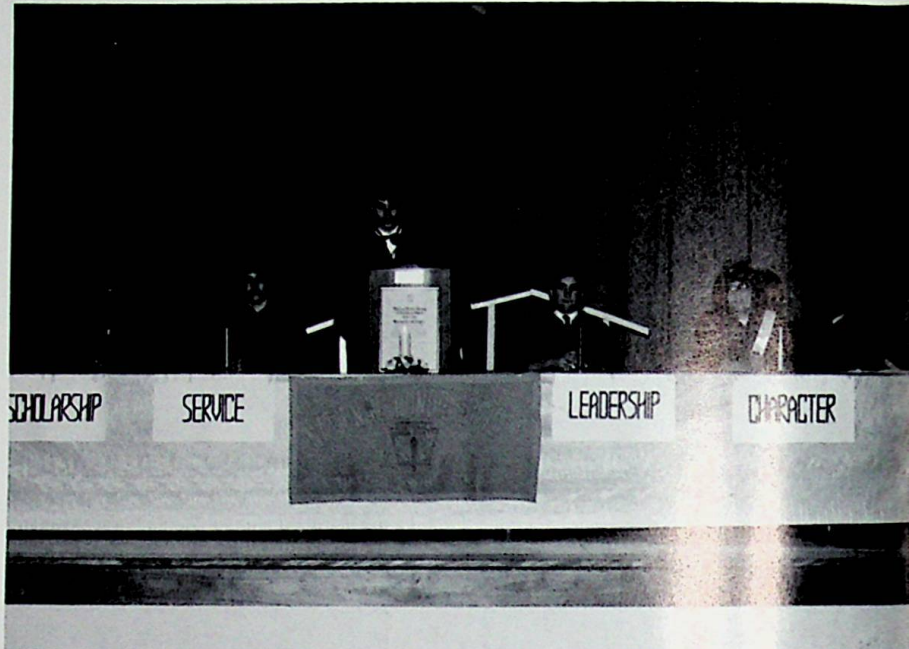




# HONOR SOCIETY

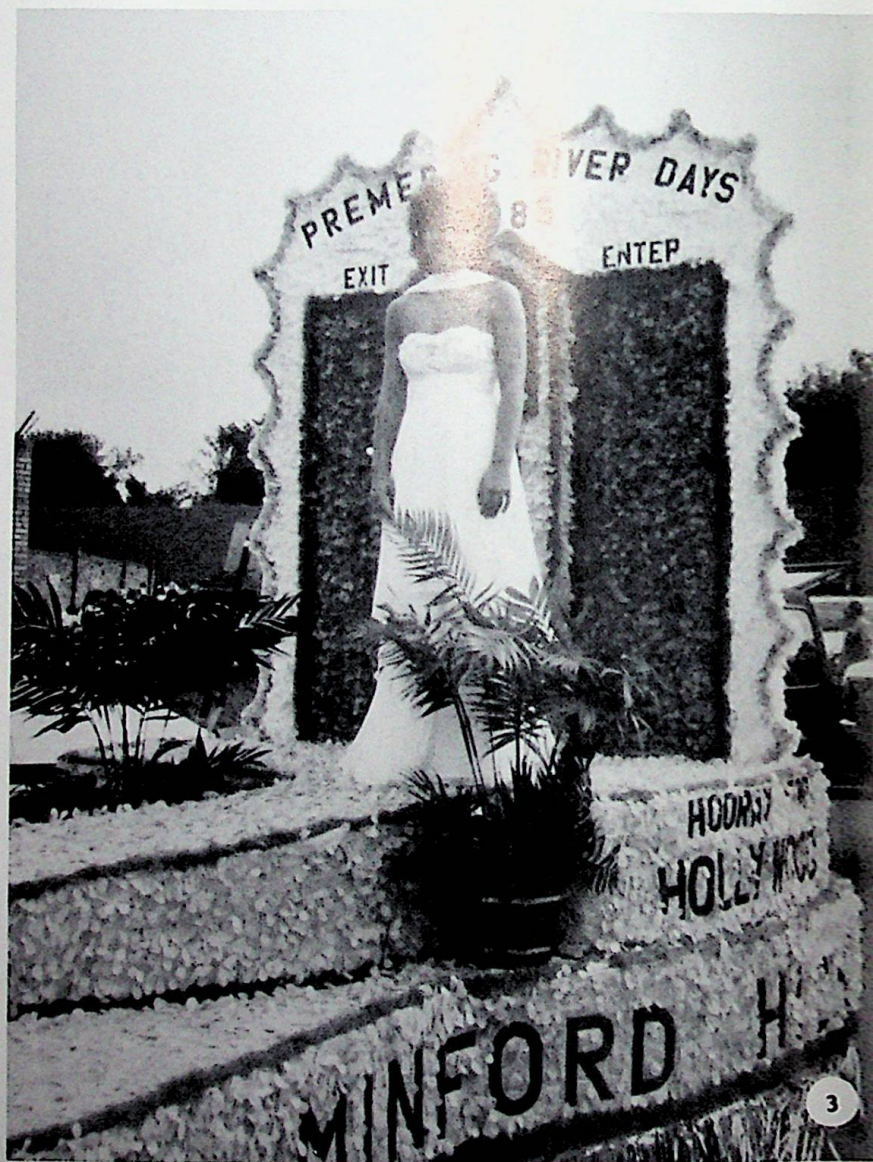
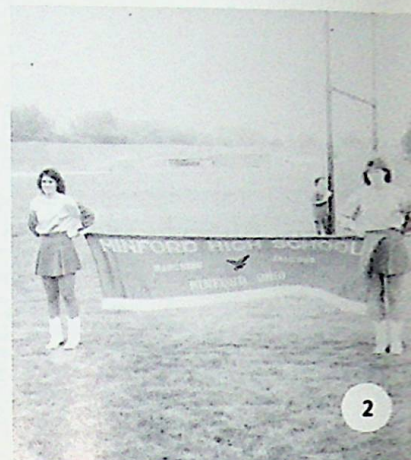
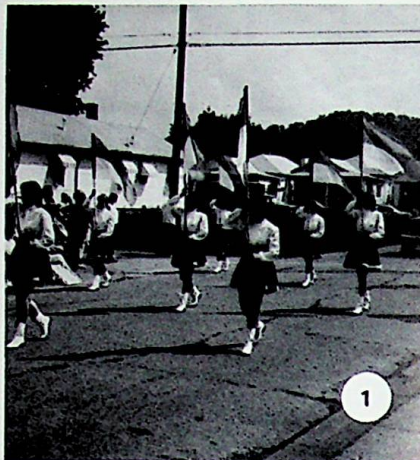
# "HOORAY FOR HOLLYWOOD"

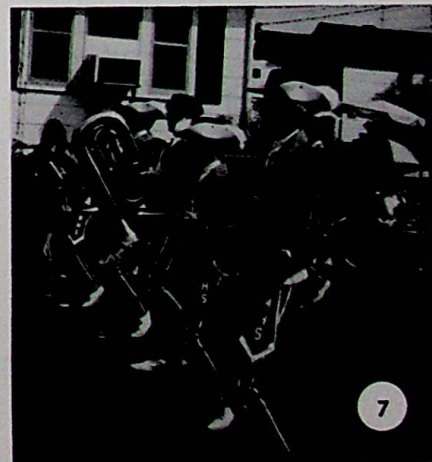
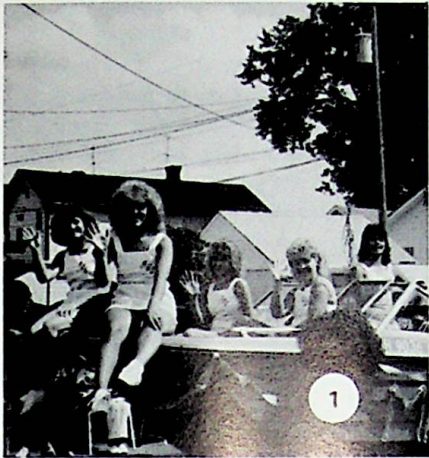

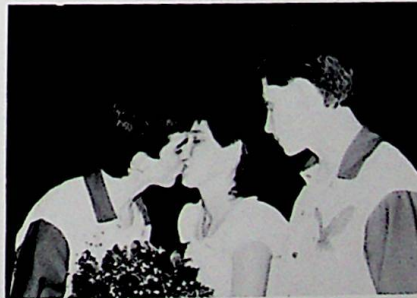

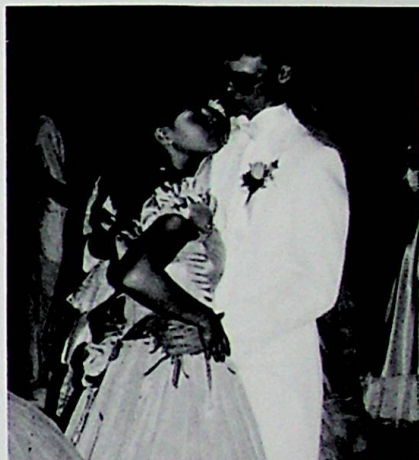
# "THIS COULD BE THE NIGHT"

# A CHAMPIONSHIP SEASON

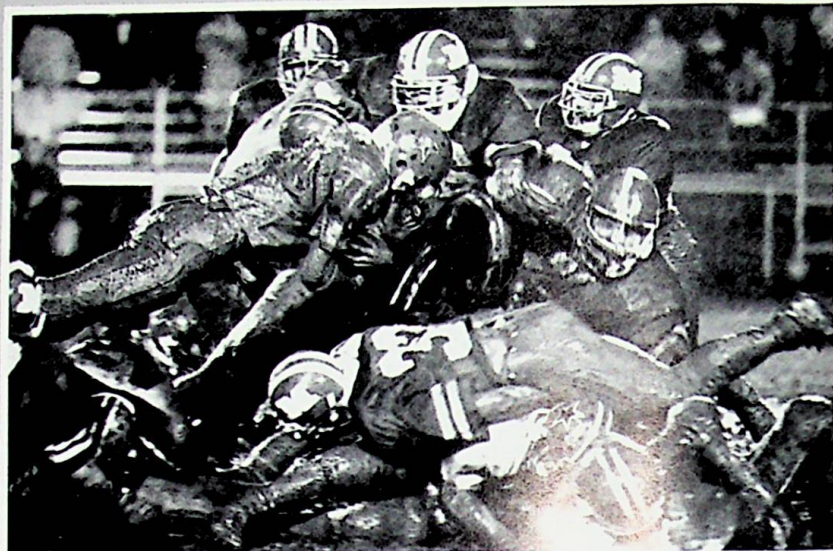

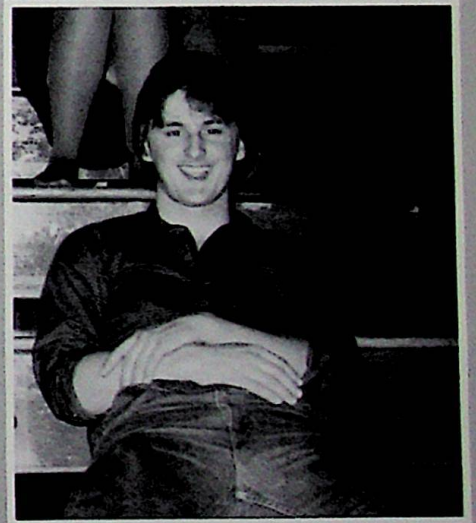


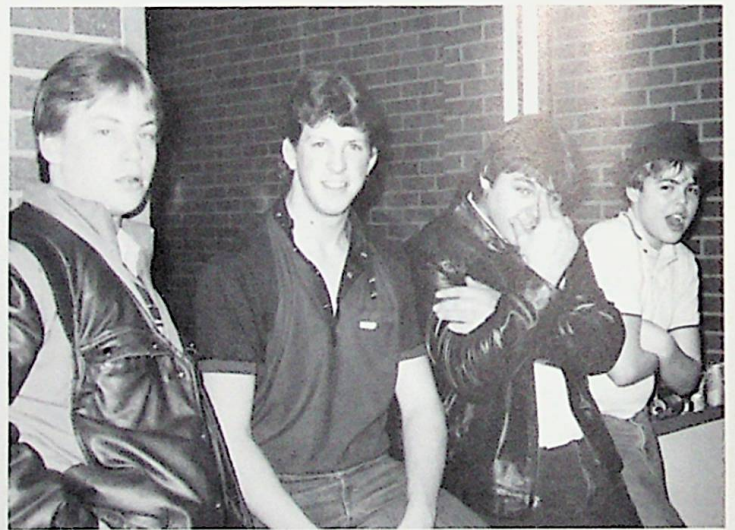
# TENNIS TEAM FINISHES 20-1
