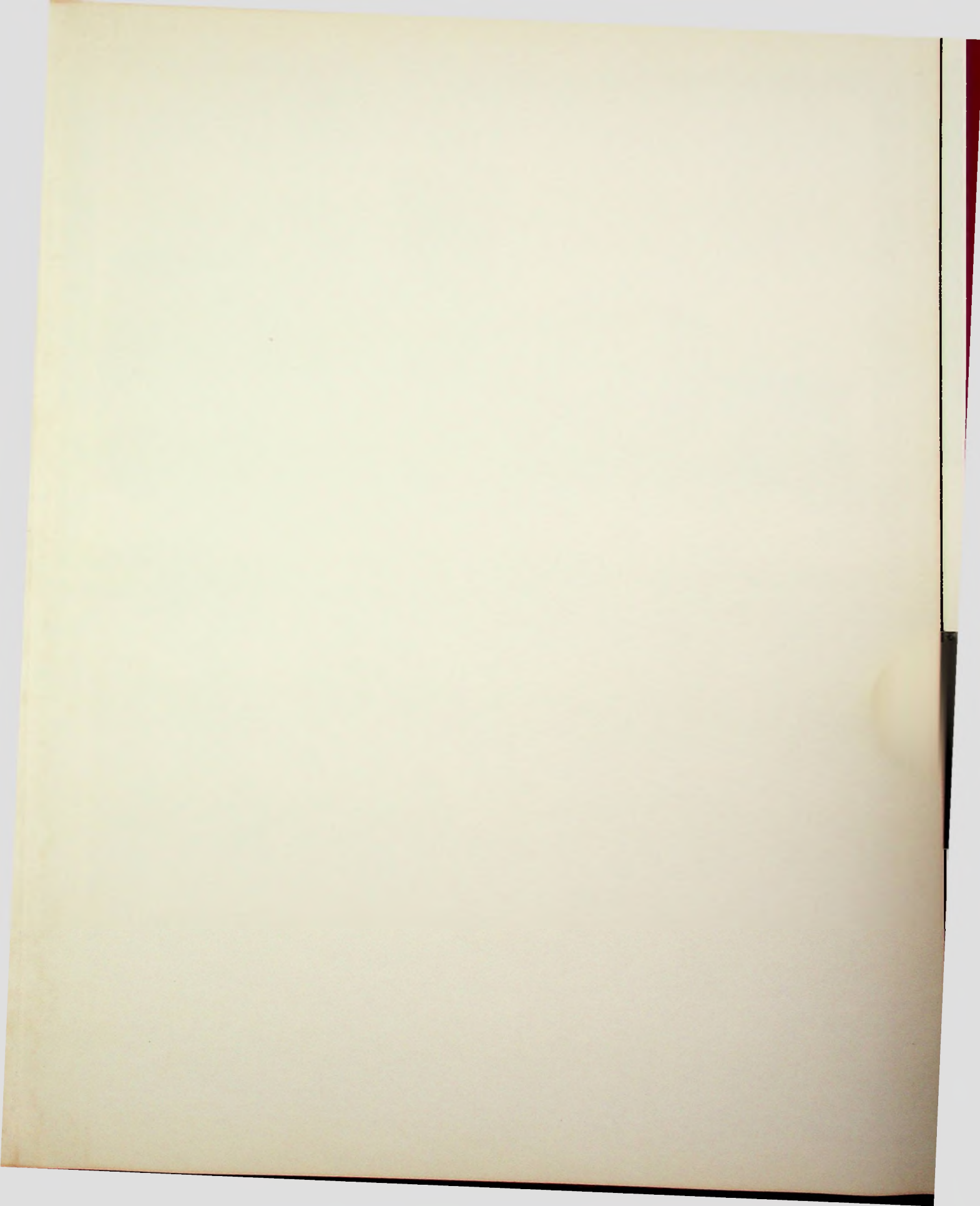

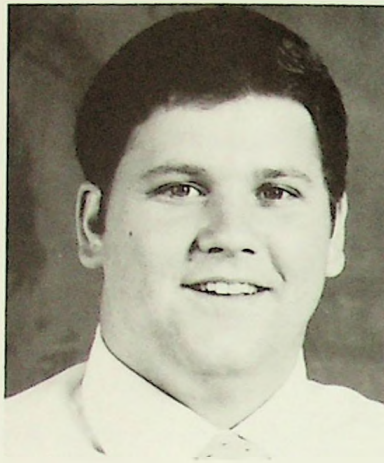

.We believe in the visible, personal, and premillennial return of Jesus Christ.

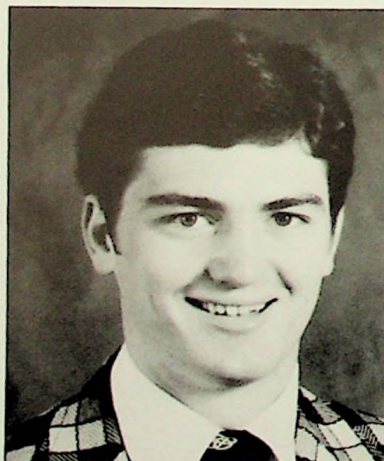
.We believe in the everlasting conscious blessedness of the saved and the everlasting conscious punishment of the lost.

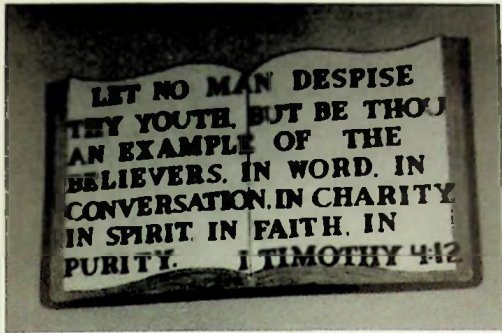


MICHIGAN TRIP

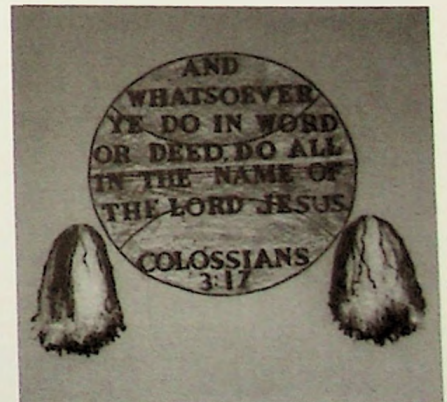
