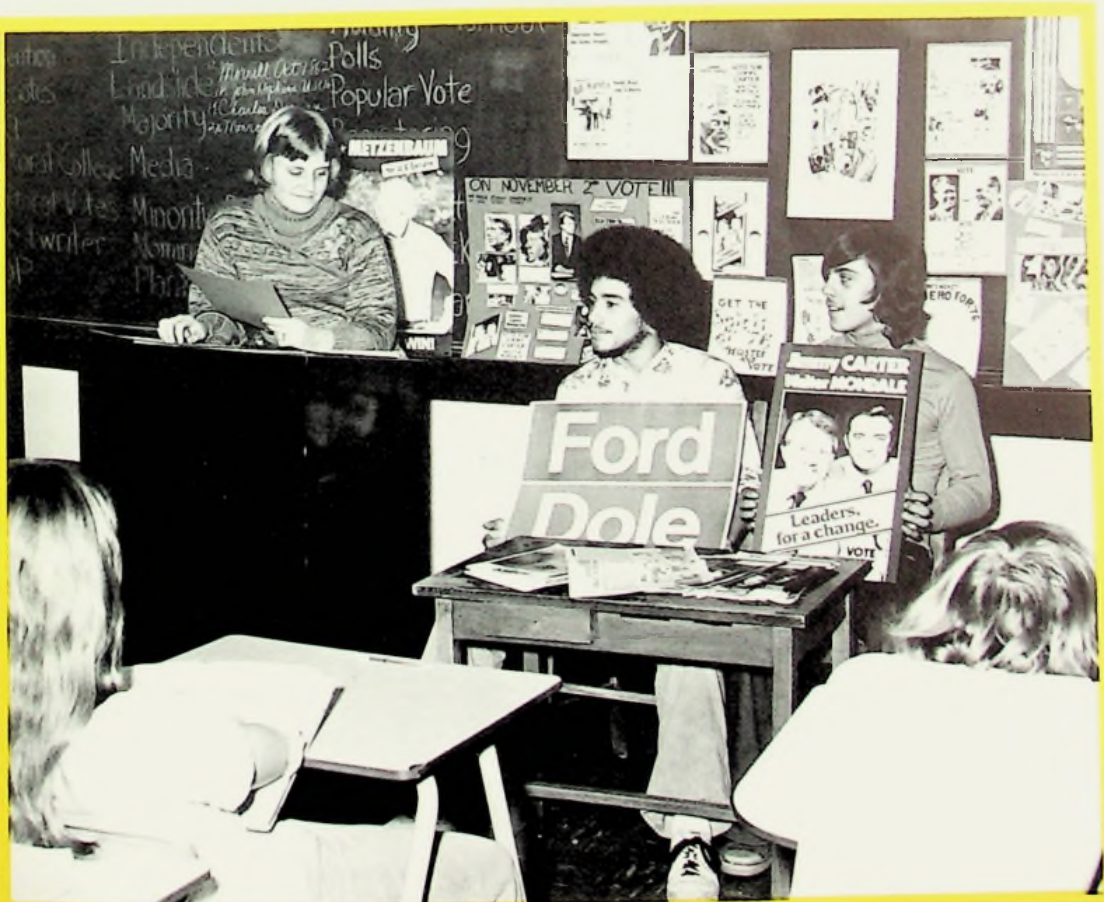

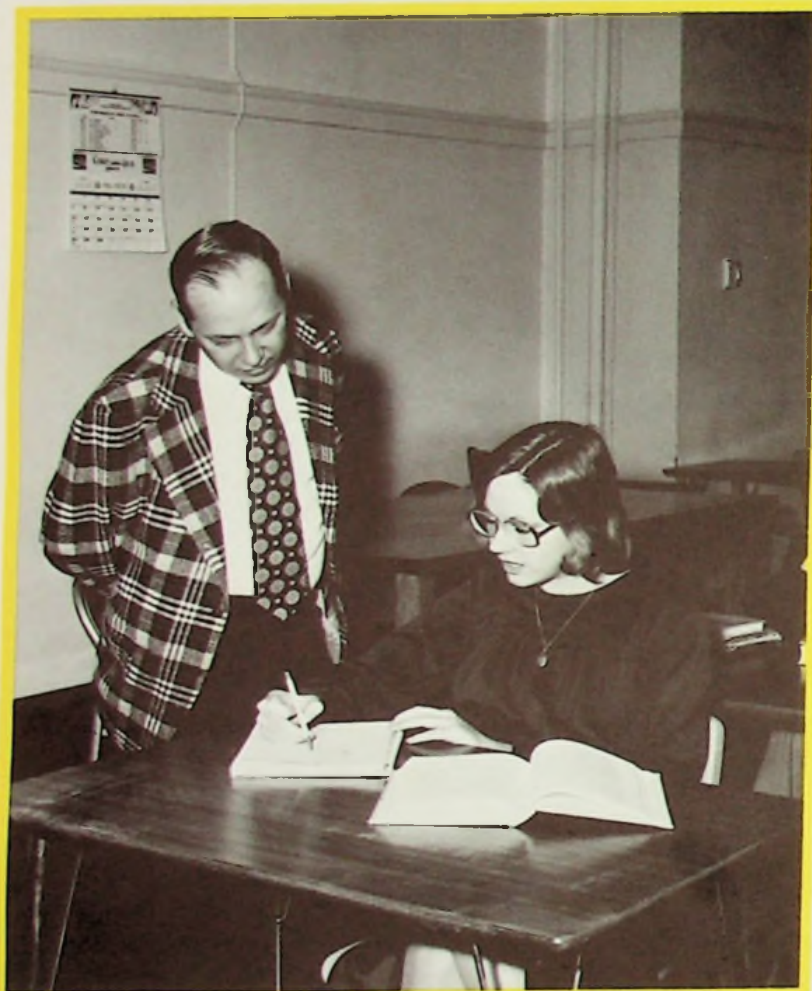

Steve Parker rushed 8 times for 30 yds. and N. Burrows rushed 8 times for 64 yds.

Comments by Coach Dave Lantz after the game were, "Our mistakes made them look better than they were but they were a solid football team. We're not going to hang up the season. We're capable of coming back."

This was a rough loss for the Trojans but much was learned through the mistakes made on the field.

Trojan Mistakes Give Tigers Win September 17, 1976

There was a lot of good football played at Spartan Municipal Stadium friday night, but not by the PHS Trojans. As they were defeated by the Ironton Tigers 22-14.

Mistakes cost PHS dearly during a scoreless 1st quarter, with the Tigers scoring 1st in the second quarter. A Norm Burrows pass and a Jeff Lisath reception tied the score 6-6. At the beginning of 2nd period action the Tigers took the lead with Mike Brown making the touchdown. PHS was to score one more time, but to no avail as the Trojans were defeated 22-14.

Trojans Lose Heartbreaker To Boyd County—29-28 September 24, 1976

"They didn't outplay us they just out scored us." This was the reaction of the Portsmouth fans as PHS fell to defeat in the hands of the Boyd County Lions.

Tom Boden started the scoring with an 85 yd. punt return. This was a first in Trojan history, with 6:50 left in the quarter, the Lions tied the score. The play was exciting but a little sloppy during the 2nd quarter. Portsmouth scored the next 3 times and led 28-7 but the Lions did not give up hope. The Trojans faltered in the 4th quarter which led to a 22pt. rally by Boyd County, defeating the Trojans 29-28.

The Trojans opened the scoring early in the first quarter as Steve Parker plunged in from four yards out. Scott Burrows ran for the extra points. Bob Journey scored in the second quarter on a nine yard run playing his first game after undergoing surgery. Scott Burrows again got the extra points.

The Trojans picked up 14 first downs and rushed for 206 yards. Scott Burrows picked up 78 yards on 14 carries. Steve Parker picked up 13 carries for 73 yards. Norm Burrows hit 3 for 8 passes for 45 yards. The Trojans defense was led by middle guard Mike Malone and line backer Randy Skaggs who both got praise from the coach for their efforts.

The Trojans owned the field Friday night, October 8th, as they defeated Huntington East 33-15.

Tom Boden lead the scoring with 3 touchdowns. Quarterback Norm Burrows was second with 2. The Trojans were really hot as Steve Parker carried the ball 15 times for 101 yards. Scott Burrows carried the ball 10 times for 52 yards. Coach Lantz commented "I was pleased with the victory, but not with the way we played."

Trojan's Lose To Huntington High 21-12

October 15, 1976

The Pony Express of Huntington High defeated the Trojan's at Fairfield Stadium in Huntington, West Virginia, on October 15.

The Trojans scored first with the aid of Norm Burrows pass to Steve Parker good for 57 yards down to the Huntington 10 yard line. Two plays later Norm Burrows scored on a 1 yard plunge. A costly penalty gave the Pony Express the ball in the closing minutes of the second quarter. With the ball on the 5 yard line, the Pony Express took the lead 7-6. The Trojans got their final score late in the fourth quarter on a quarterback sneak from the one yard line by Norm Burrows.

Trojans Tame Tomcats

October 22, 1976

The Trojans got back on the winning track Friday night October 22, by defeating the Ashland Tomcats.

The Trojans were off to a slow start, but with the help of Norm Burrows and Randy Parsley they were able to move the ball to the Tomcats 20 yard line, Scott Burrows ran the ball in to lead the Tomcats 6-0. A Tomcat fumble and a Norm Burrows recovery gave the Trojans a 12-0 lead. Tim Lewis kicked the extra point making the score 13-0. What followed was a complete Trojan takeover as they dazzled the crowd with superb running, kicking, and passing, thus, giving the Trojans a 35-6 victory.

8th Game P.H.S. at Russell October 29, 1976

Portsmouth Turns Back Russell, Ky. "Red Devils" 20-6

The Trojan's scored first when Norm Burrows scored from 10 yards outcapping a 56 yard drive. He also ran the points after making the score 8-0. Steve Parker scored in the 2nd quarter on a 3 yard touchdown making the score 14-0 in favor of the Trojans.

The Trojans saw a 102 yard interception return by Greg Rawlings called back for a clipping call near the end of the 1st half. The Trojans scored in the 4th quarter on a Norm Burrows Quarterback sneak from 6 yards out making the final score 37-16 in favor of the Lancaster Golden Gales.

Wheelersburg Down Trojan's

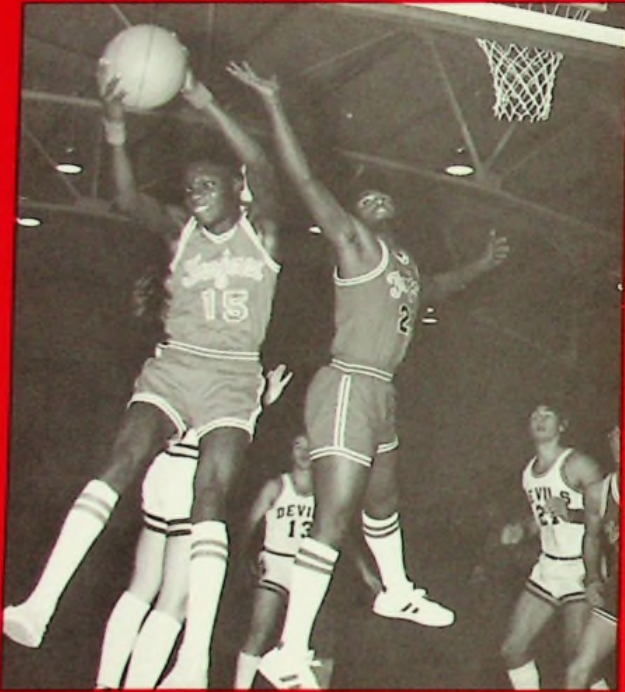

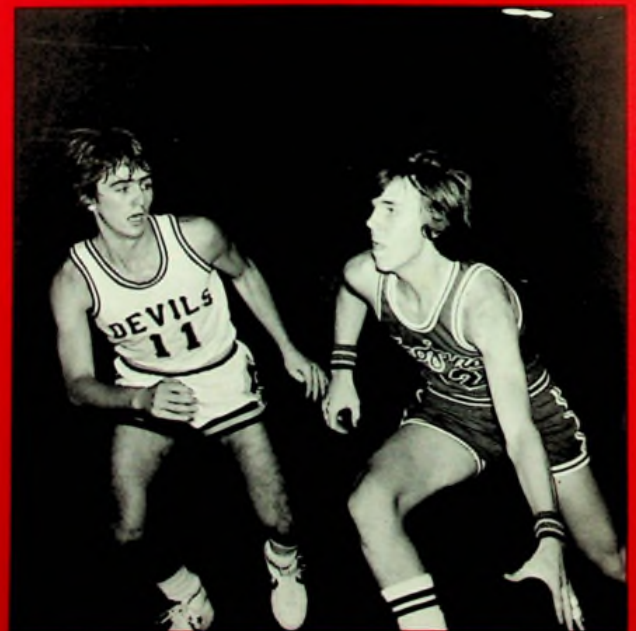

The leading scorer was Jeff Lisath with 29, and Craig Tubbs followed up with 17. Tom Boden added 12 to the win.

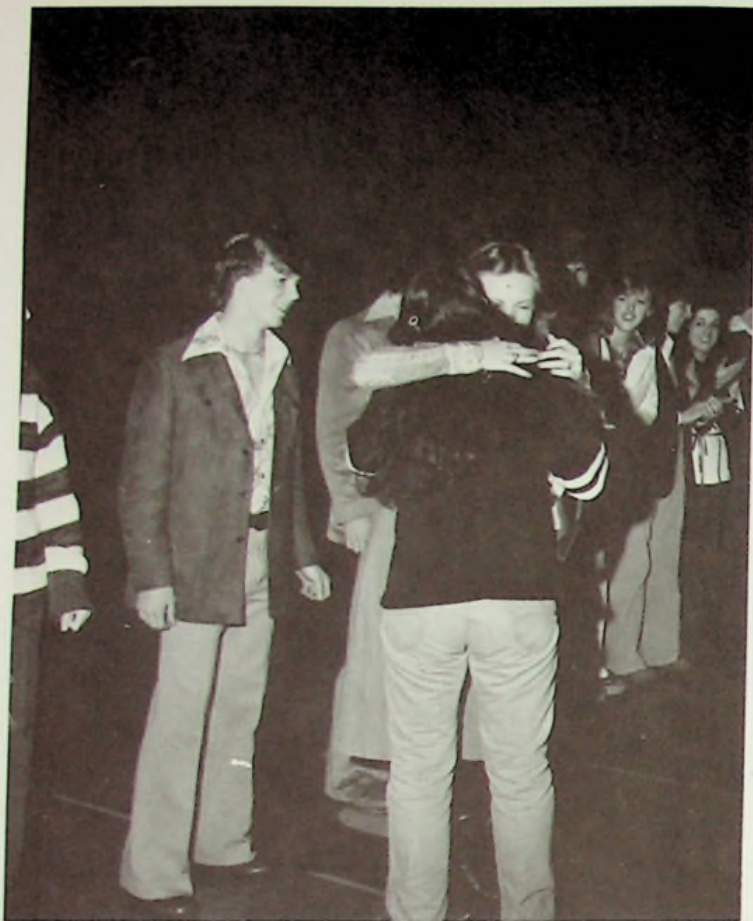
