Miss Curry was assisted this year by 12 students. She found their help to be indispensible as 5 of the Seniors each have 4 years experience with the equipment.





We arrived back in New Boston late Sunday evening and tiredly made our way home to rest up for school on Monday. We are eagerly awaiting next year's trip.










The Homecoming game was played against the Clay Panthers. It was truly a memorable evening, as both the Varsity and Reserve teams were victorious.




