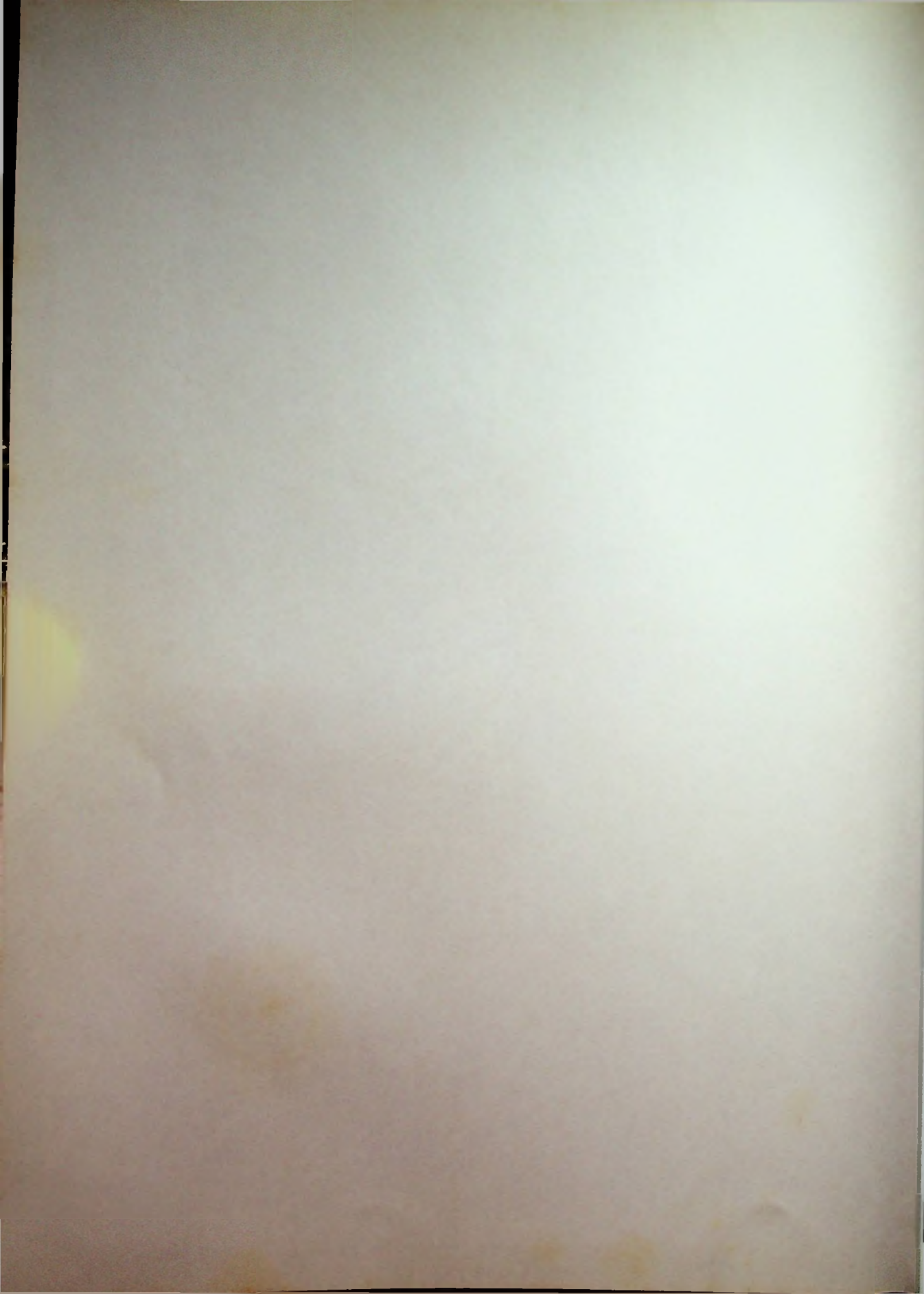

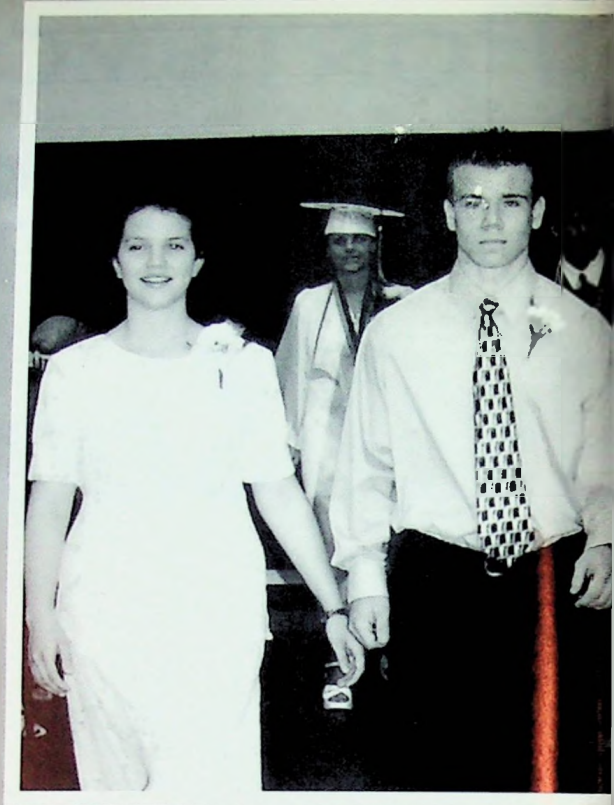

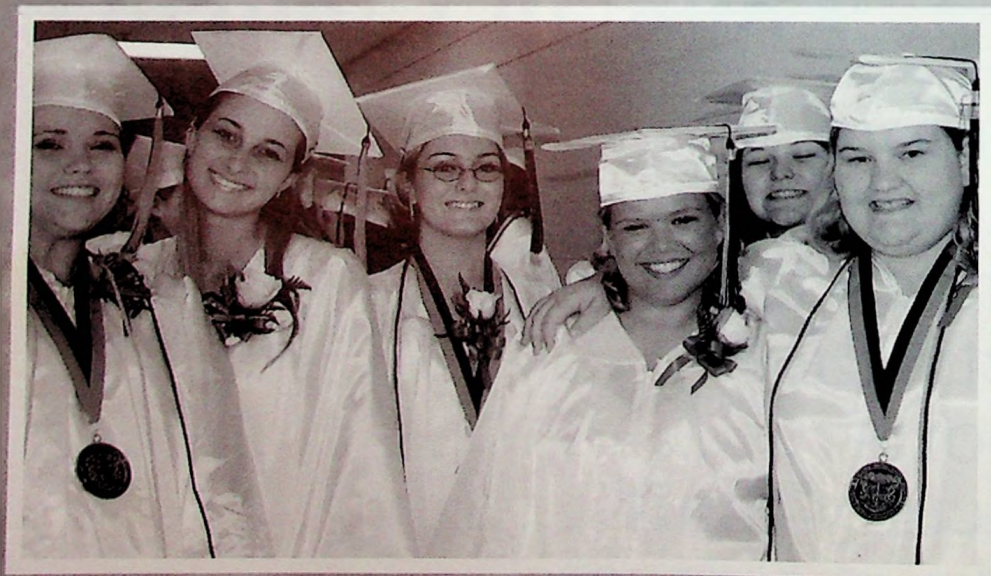

Debra Cooper and Aaron McCullough lead the seniors for one final walk as a Portsmouth West student.



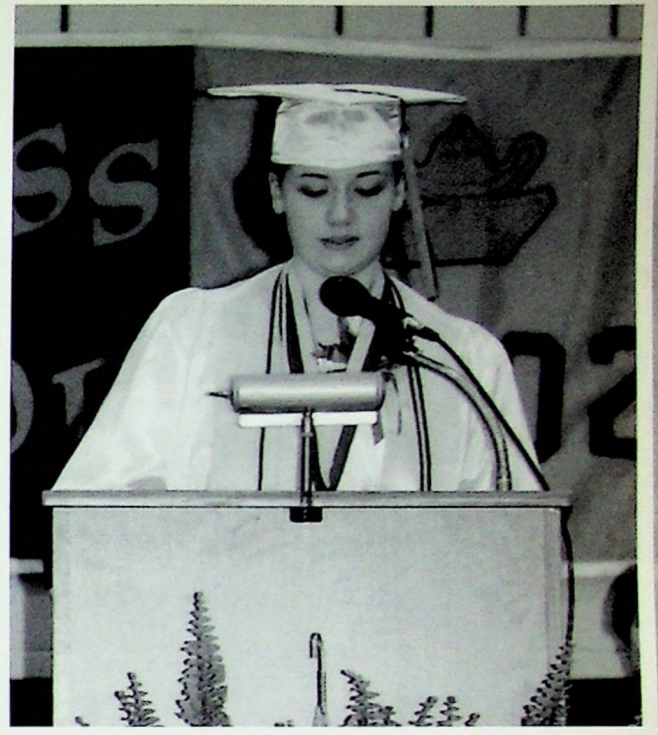
