Rules for Syllables

1. A syllable is a group of letters sounded together.
2. Each syllable must have at least one vowel in it: yes-ter-
3. More than one vowel may be in a syllable, but there is only one vowel sound: di-vide, bar-
4. A vowel can be a syllable all by itself: a-way, a-long, a-bove
5. Divide words into syllables between twin consonants: lit-tle, hap-py, fun-
6. Usually divide between a vowel and a consonant: even-ly, far-

Their involvement contributes to the spirit of the school and makes the spirit grow. We are the "Now People." Together we can make it happen!!



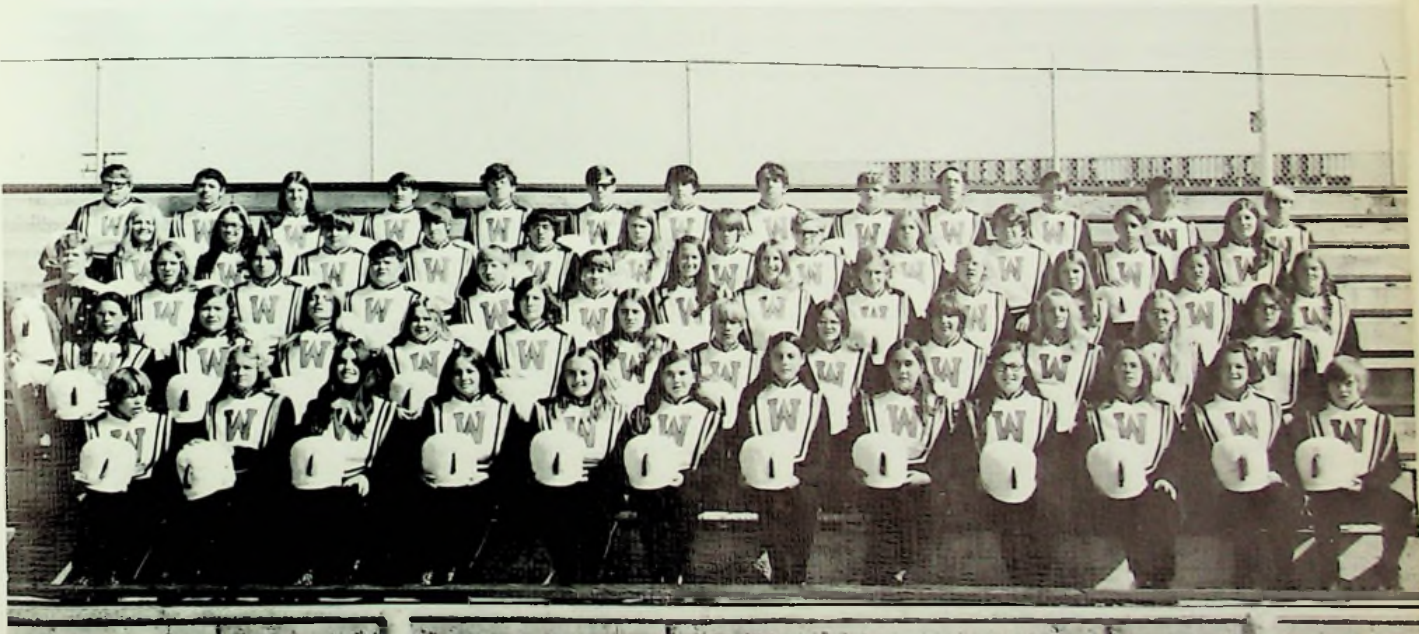

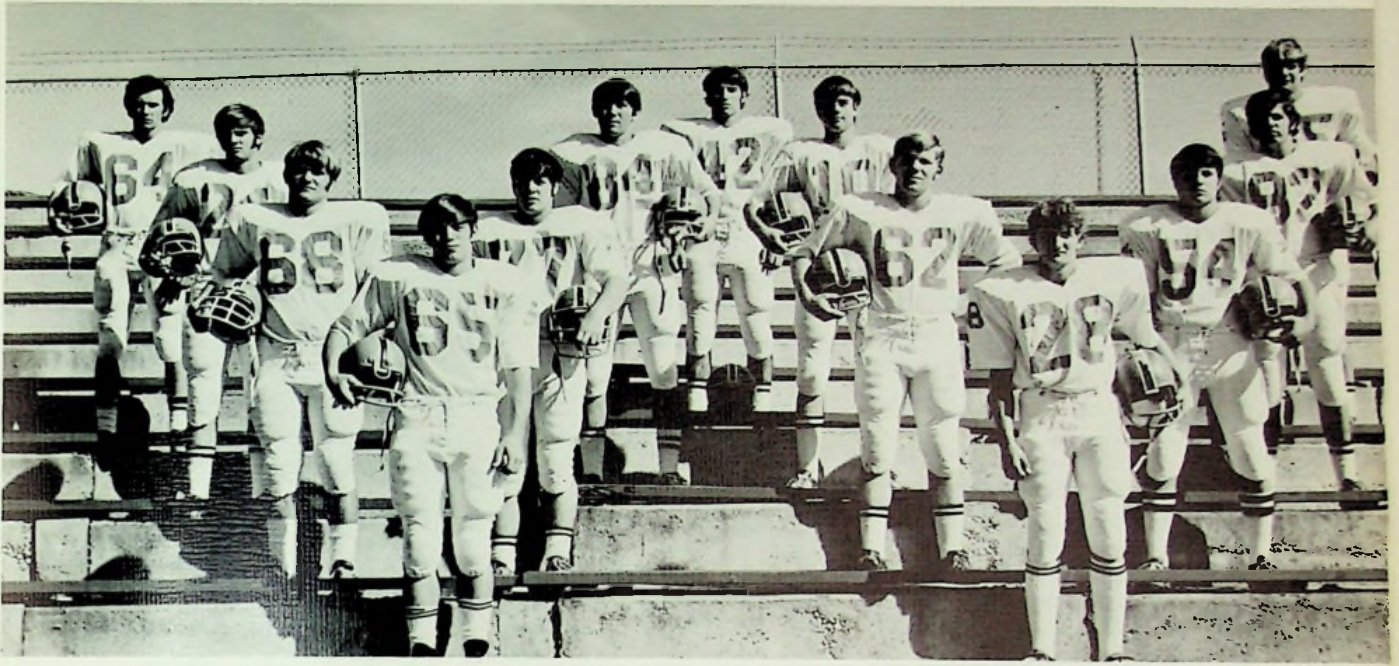

After our 85-55 victory over Northwest, the cheerleaders had an after-game dance featuring the "Better Half."

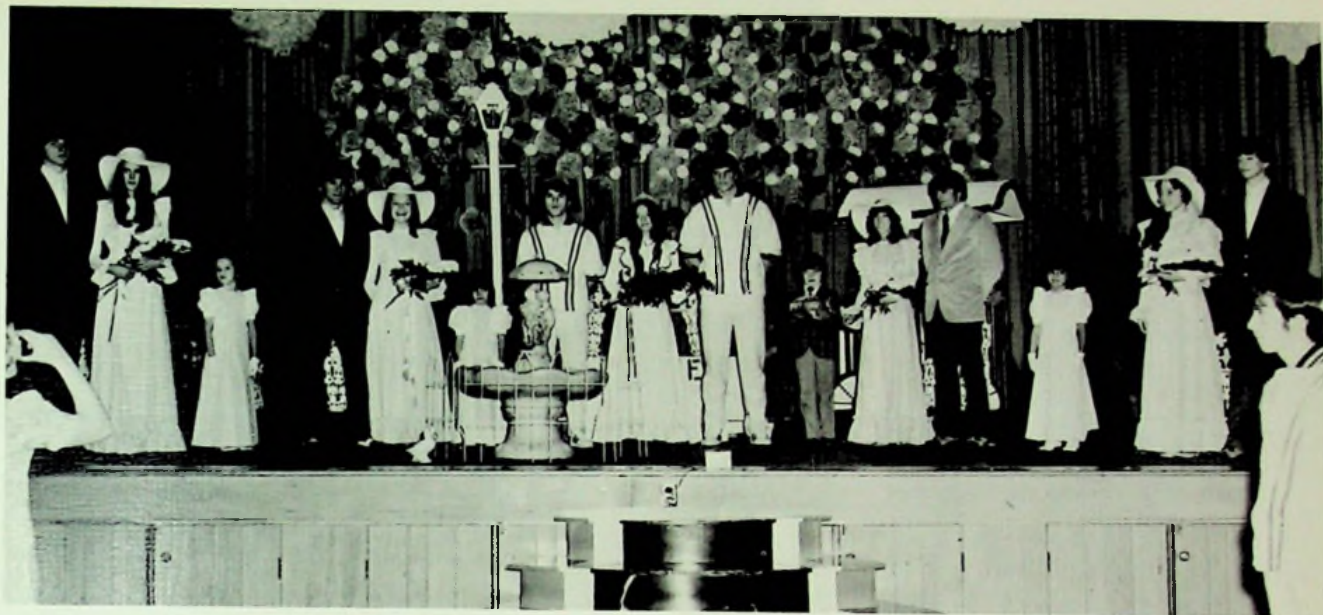

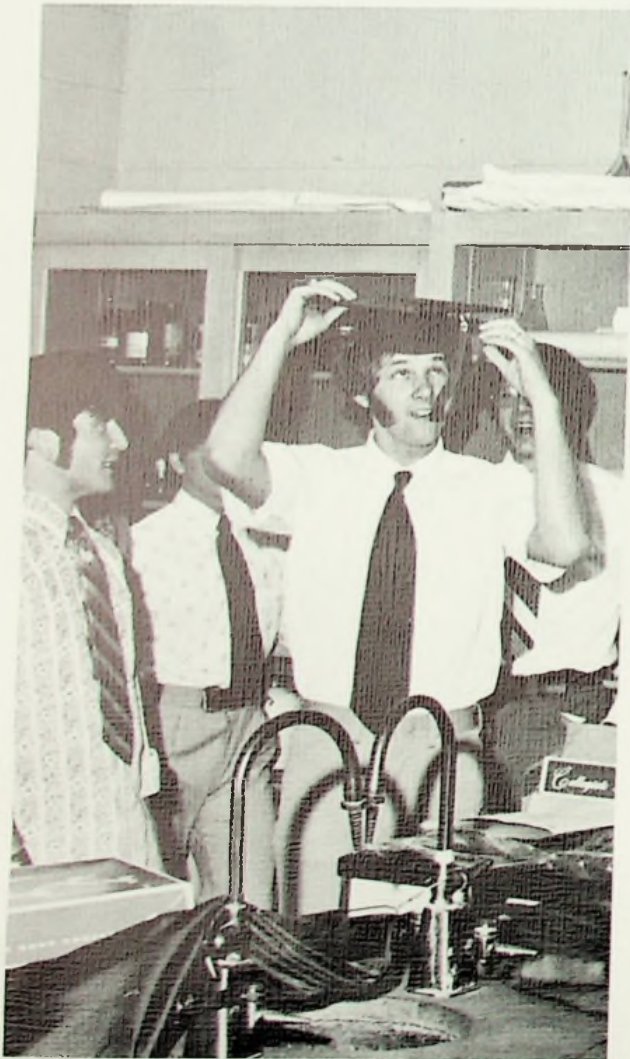


# FINALE '73
