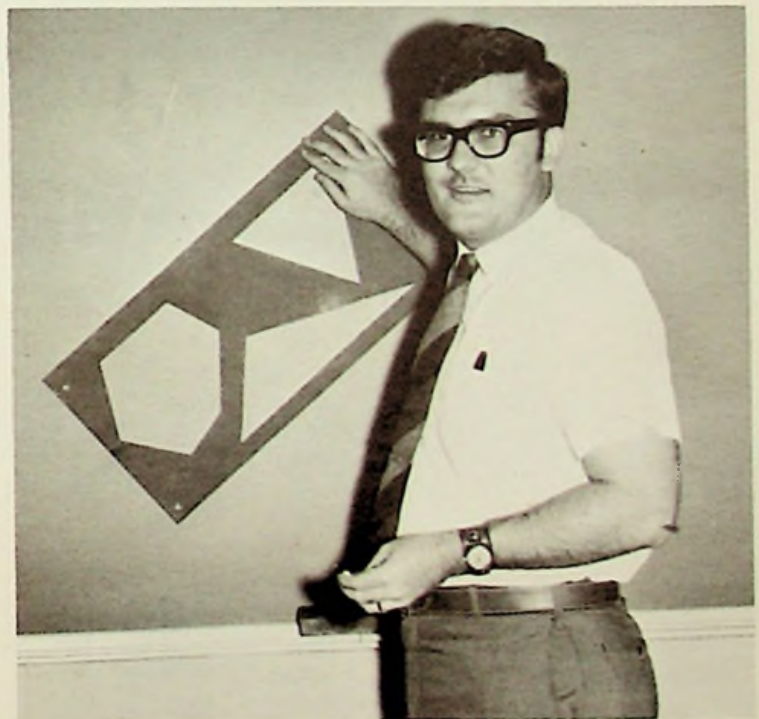
**PHYLLIS MADEIRA** English; B.S., Marshall U.; University of Mexico. In high school, civics was her favorite subject.
