Tournament Play

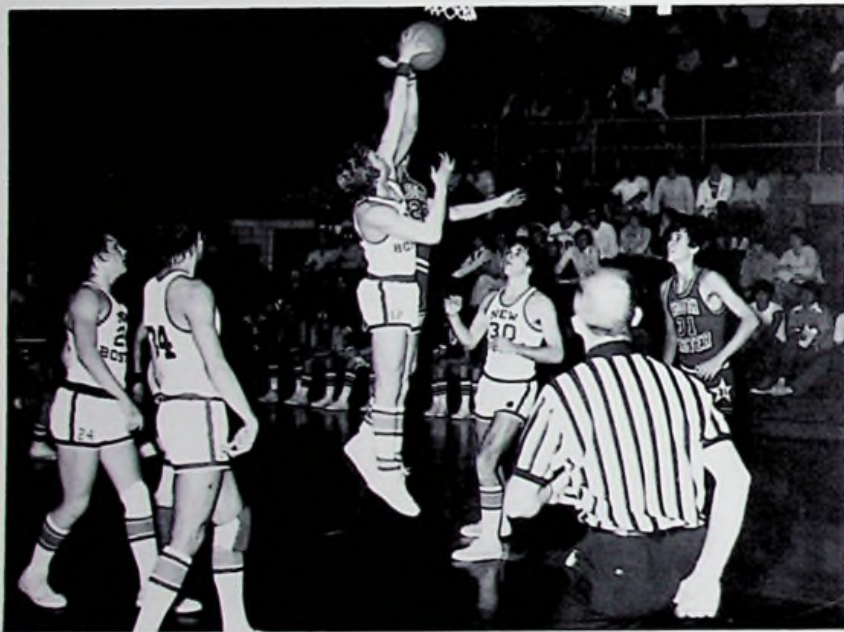
