As I stopped by Juan's to buy some tickets, he told me that Mary Kindinger just opened a zoo called Kindinger's Animal House.


I decided to stop and see Mary. She told me that former classmate Mary Stevens had just written a book, "How To Be Successful."

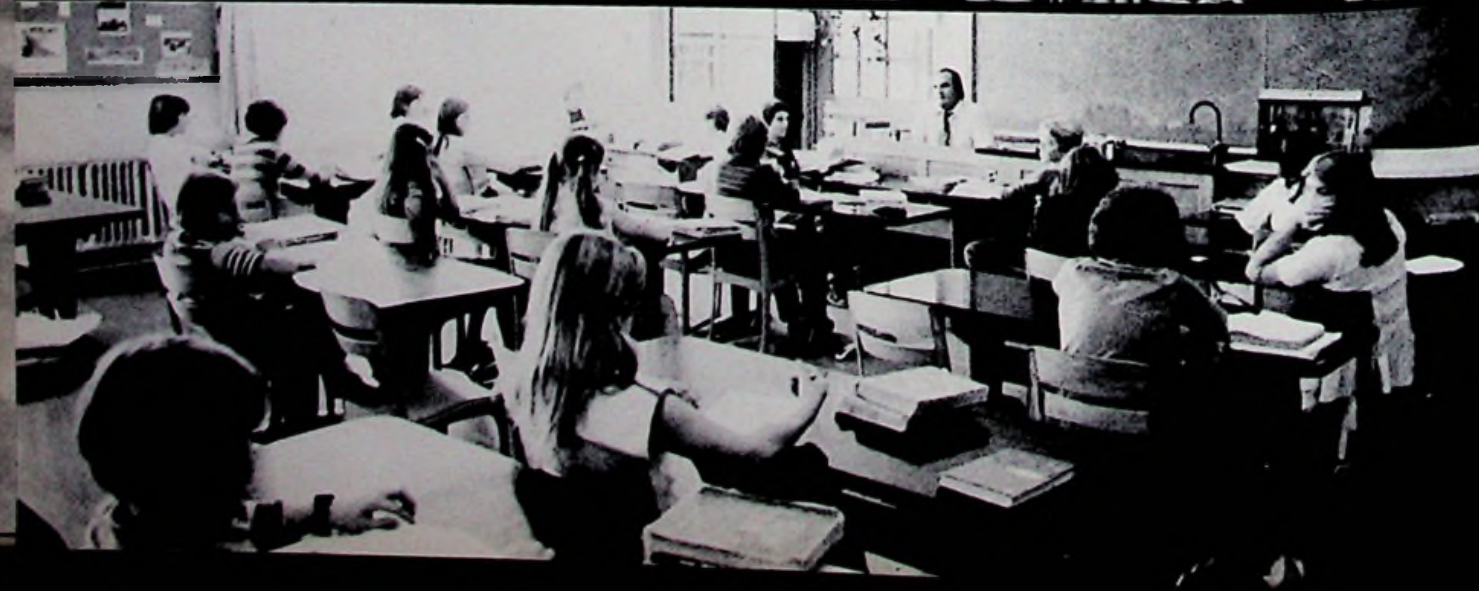
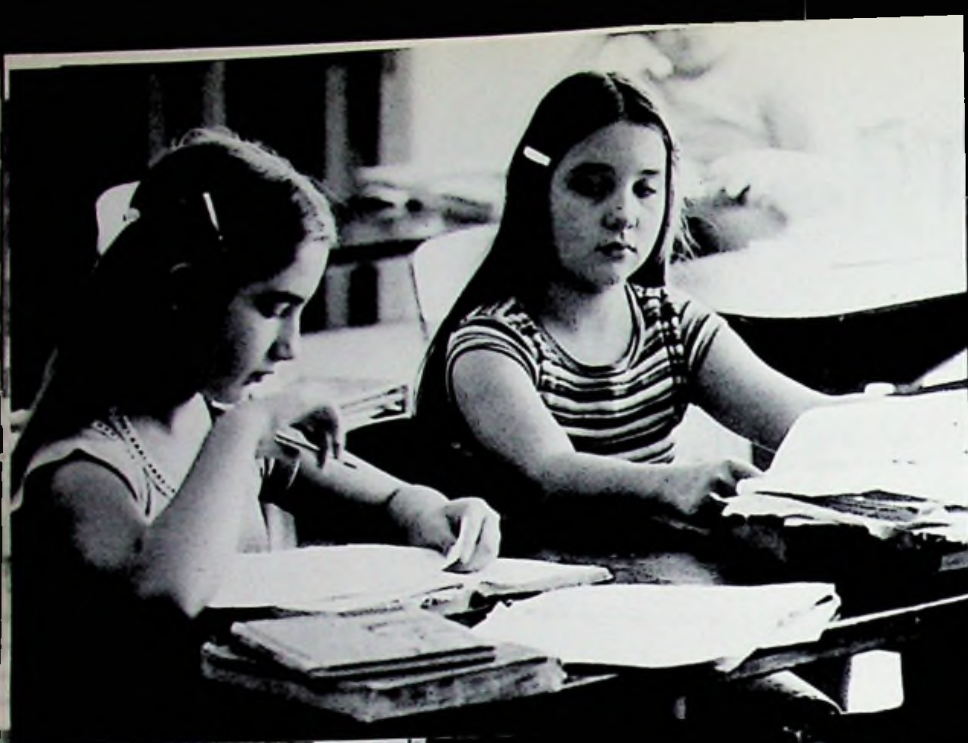
Becky told me that Karen Dunn had gone into business for herself as a dress designer. The place was called KARENS.
