

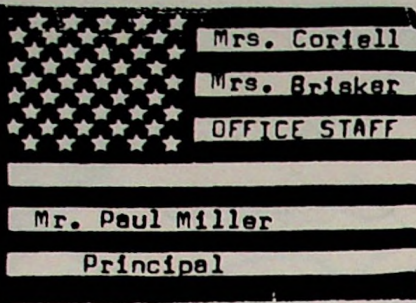

29. Closed our week with a rousing and emotional assembly and remarks by Paul Miller, Principal

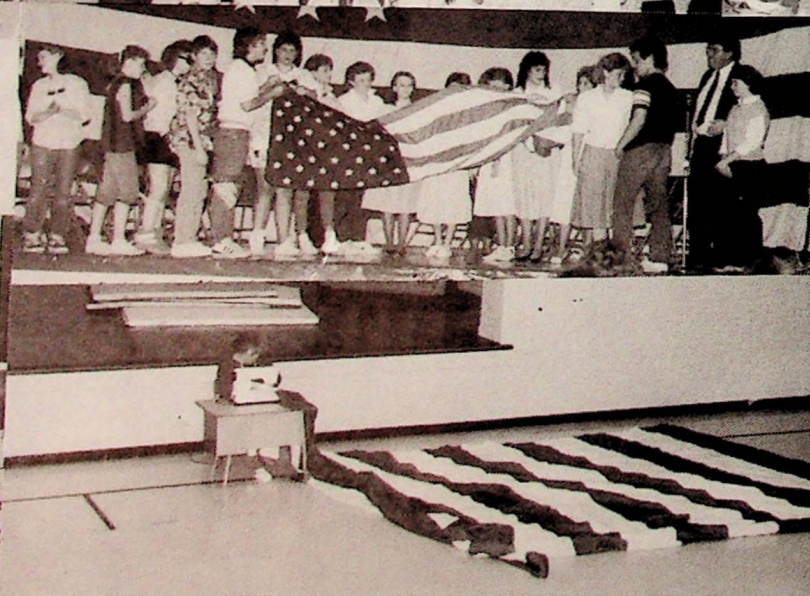
