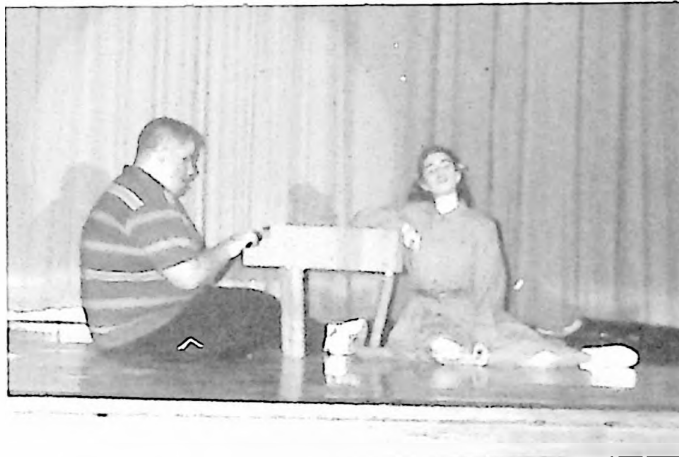
night three times a week, there was plenty of them.

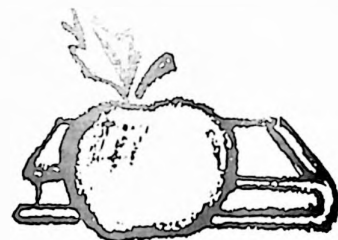
