April 7 1896 -

Sold 9. Ruthless

25' peach trees

and 45' apple trees

to different ones

Tues Apr. 2

A cool chilly day.

I rode all day and delivered the barrels.

Had a coal fire and did not get back till after dark. All tired and hungry.

Wed. Apr. 3.

Froze a little last night.

I hauled the rest of the apple trees back and set part of them out. Carl Smith 60 been.

Sold Smith 80  
each one

The them got ready for town

Sat Apr. 6.  
A busy day  
Smith and I  
went down to  
the hill.

They were in  
the camp room  
and cashed out  
I got pay for  
my curvately  
crops in all bits.  
I plowed the  
garden and  
helped ma  
make garden

Sun. Apr. 7.  
Raining morning.  
The wind has  
rained and is  
blowing hard.  
Hattie Bill has  
went up her to  
waiter of things.  
Smith & Genie went  
down to Georgia  
I saw little bull  
all here with  
Hilly.

I rode up to the  
Switch after the  
meat.  
Stopped at Aunt  
Hannah's while

Mon. Apr. 8.  
A damp morning  
but made a  
nicer day.  
I set out 13 boxes  
and a lot of  
sage berries  
Went to  
Blatt's & Bell  
Lovers.

label. 66. Turned  
70 more and him.
