We are looking forward to many more winning seasons with this team. This will be the team to watch in future years.

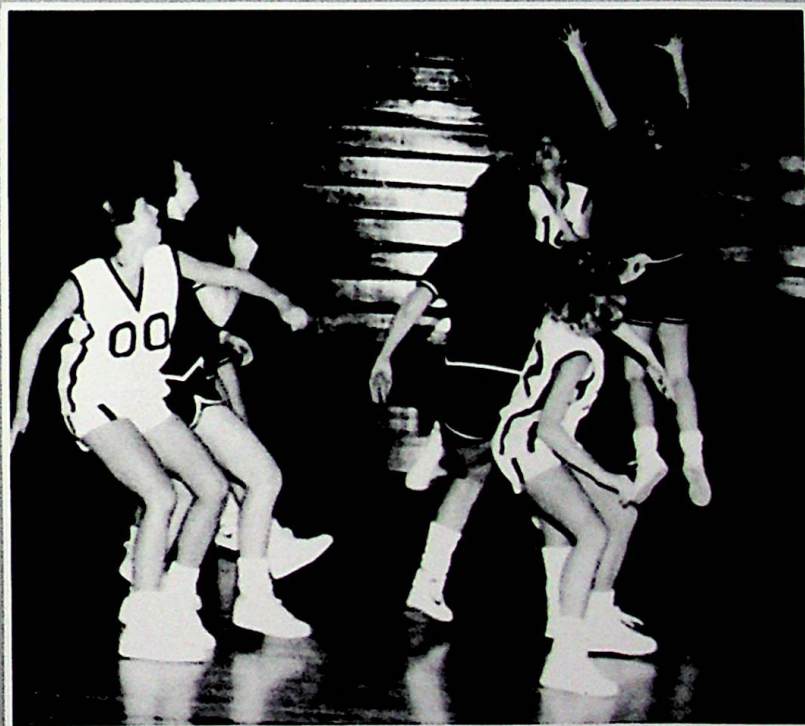
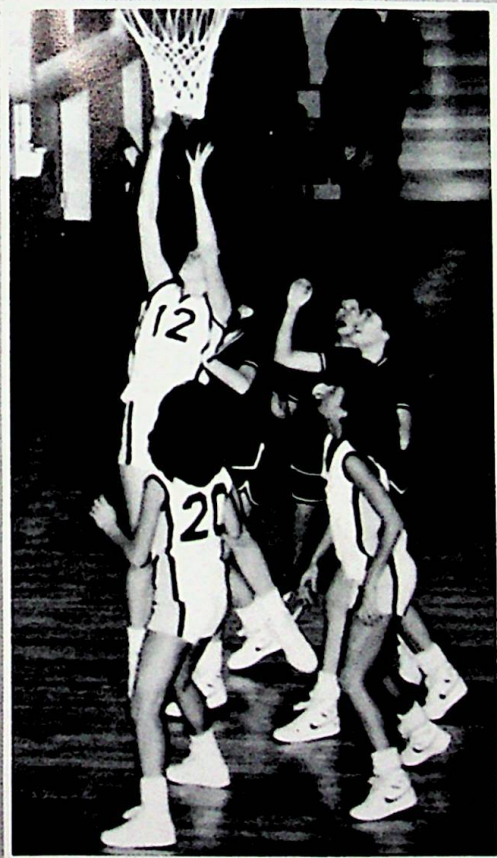
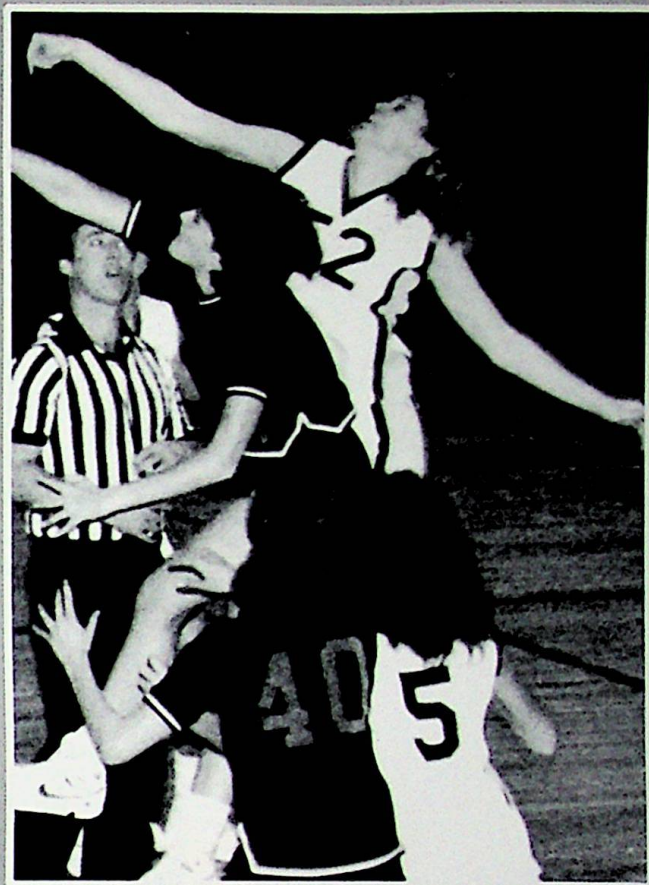
