AT THE MOVIE PROJECTOR

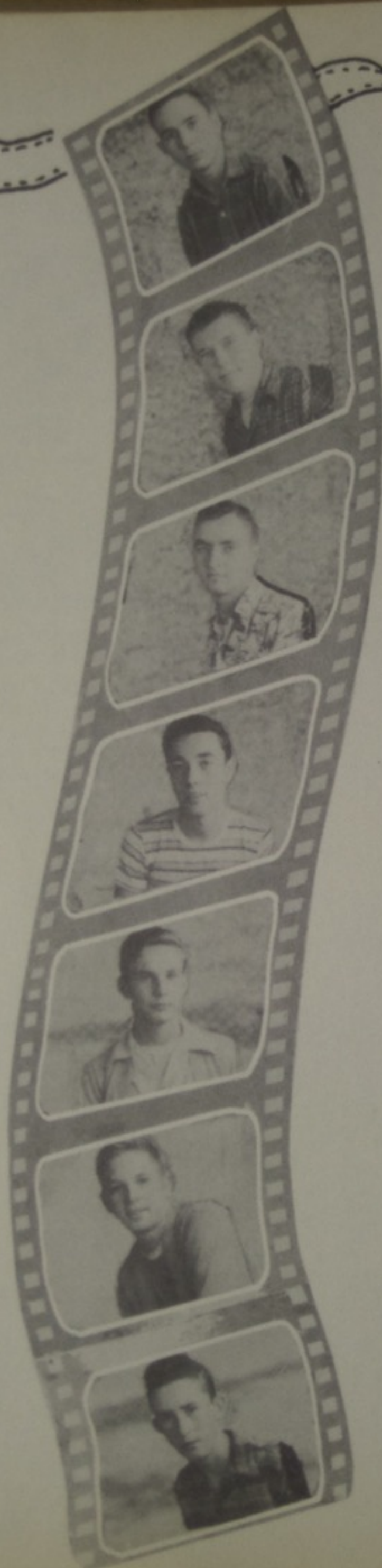
The recent report from our State Inspector, Mr. L. L. Louthian, saying he rates our Visual Education Department Superior makes us proud of this phase of our education at Valley.

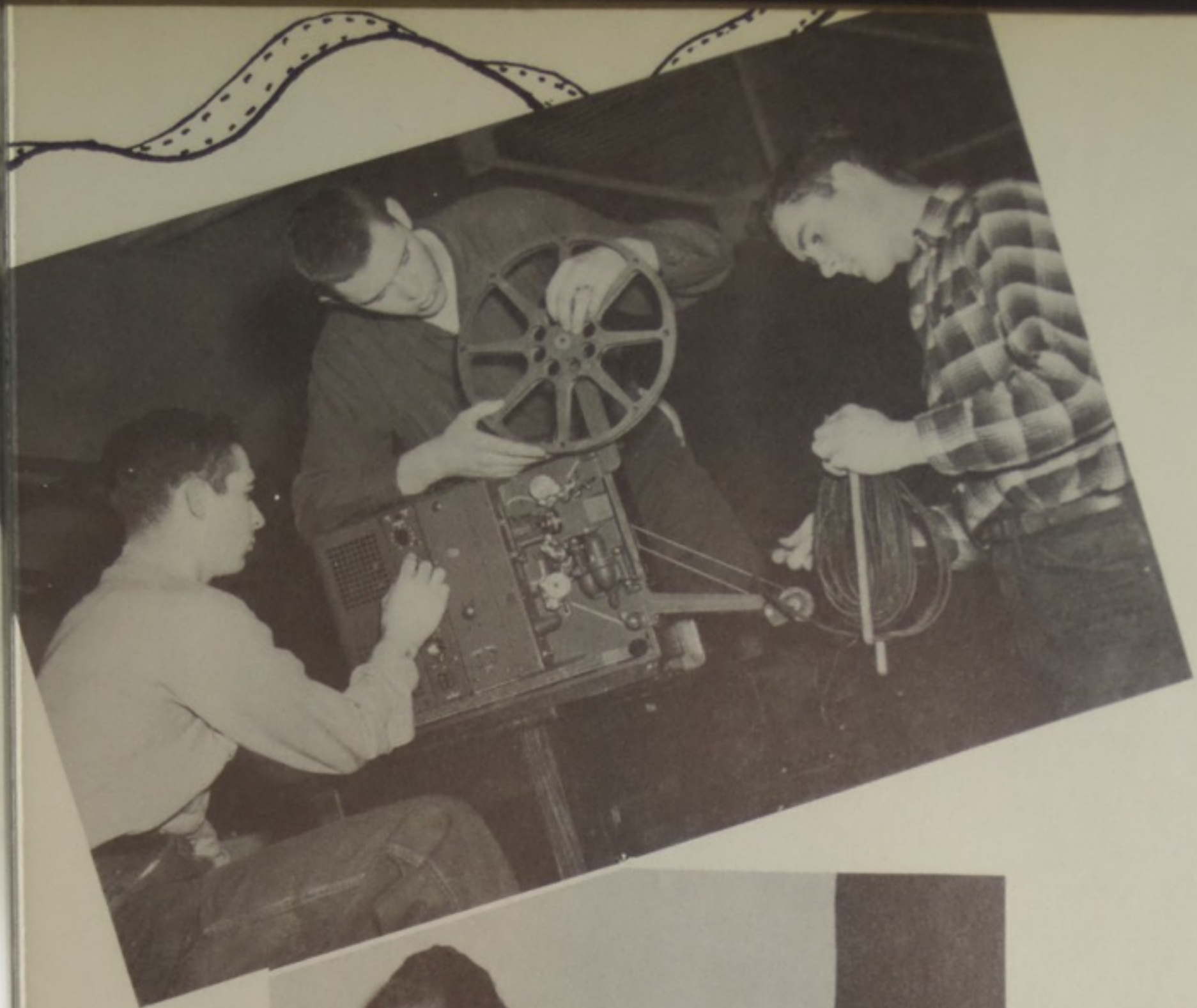

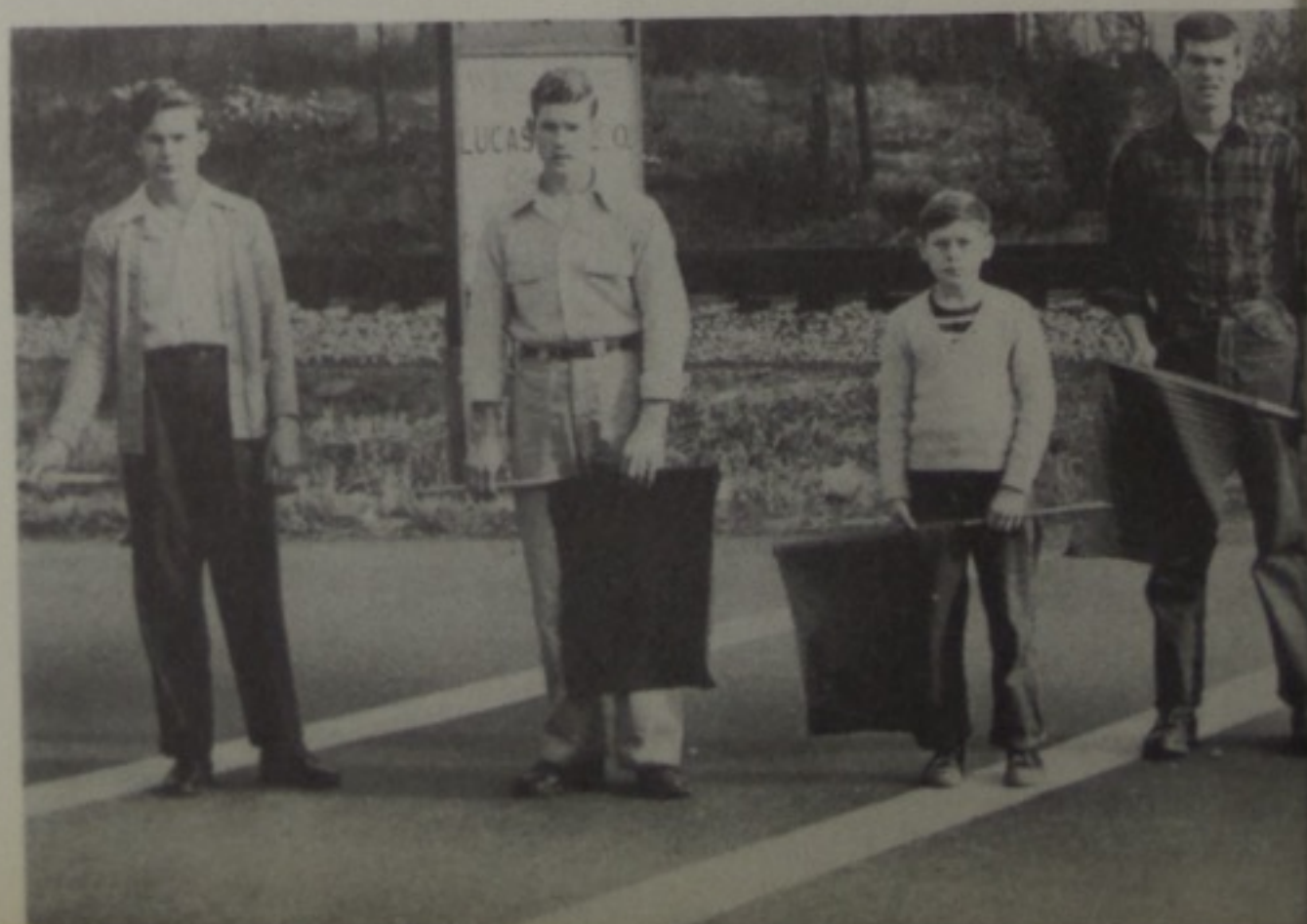

County Superintendent

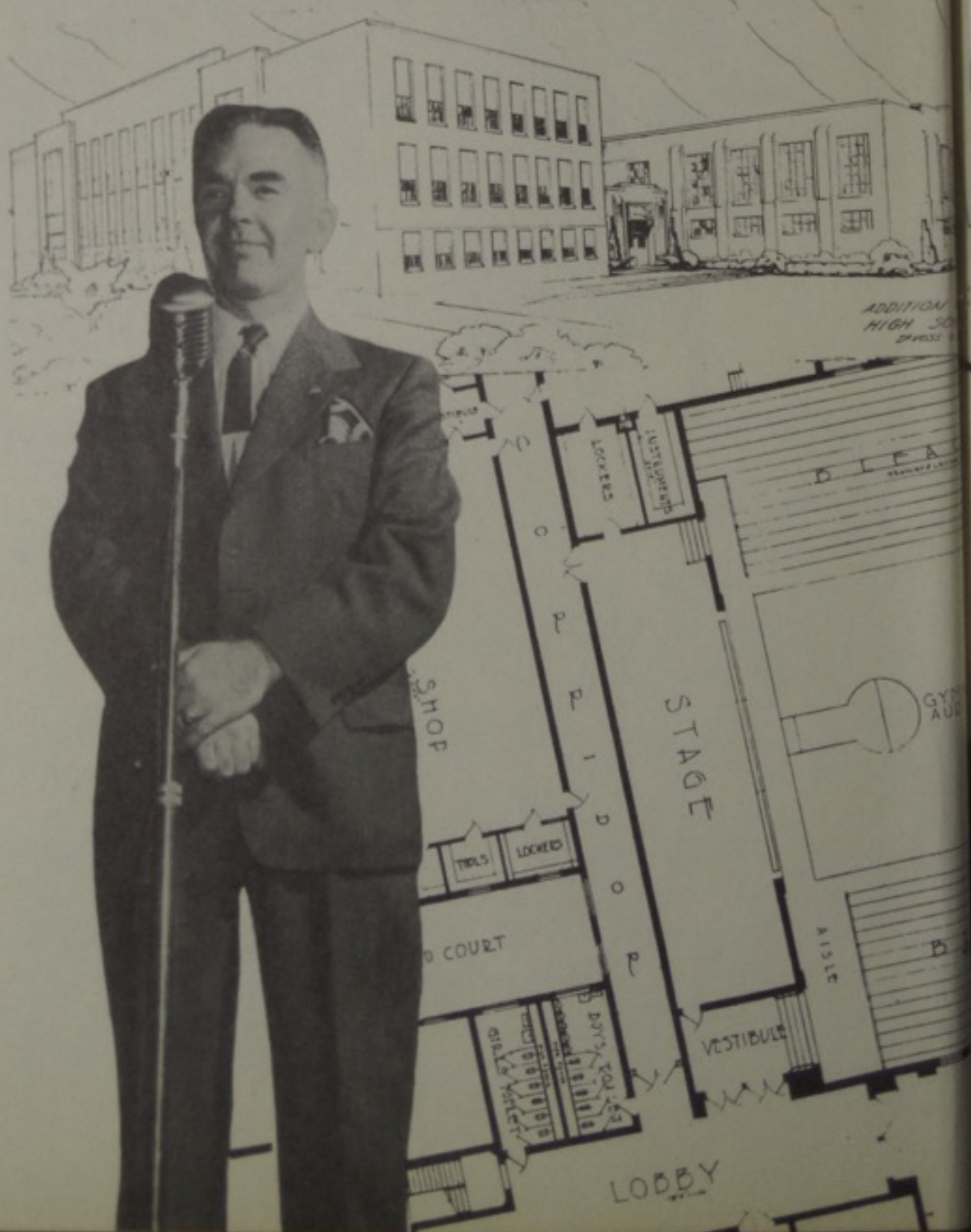

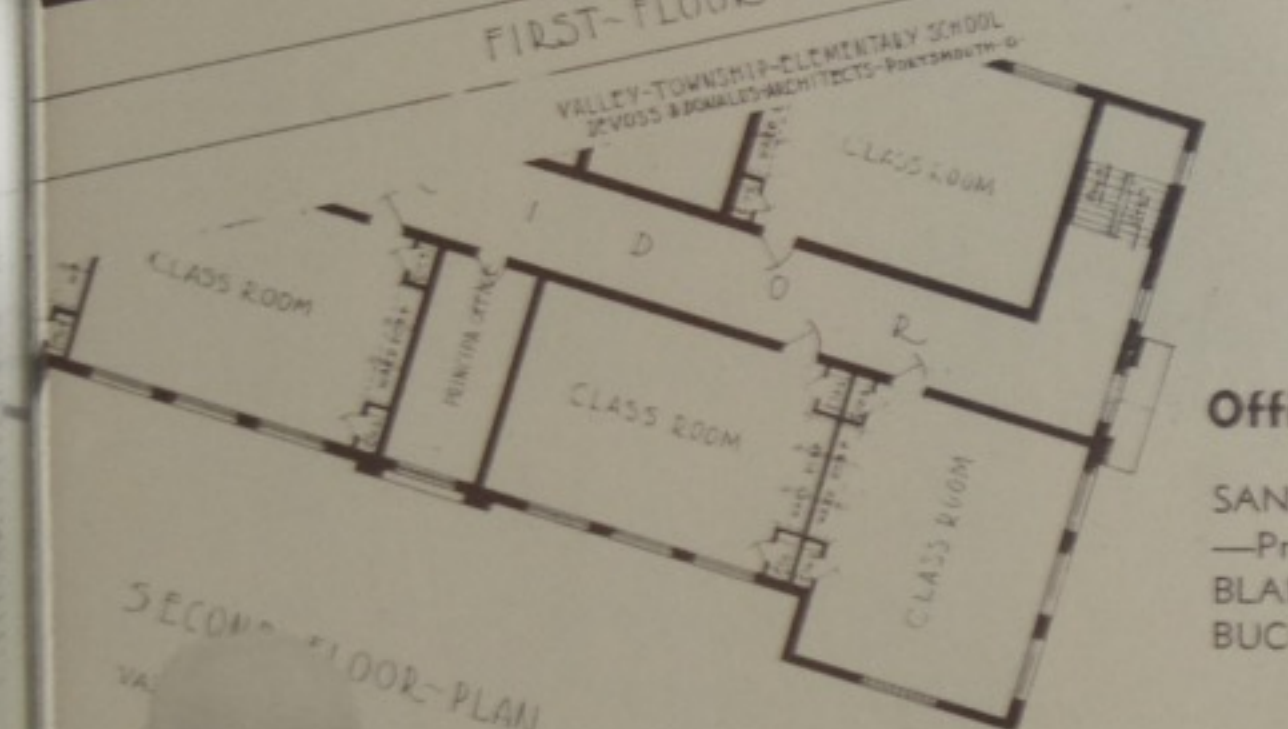
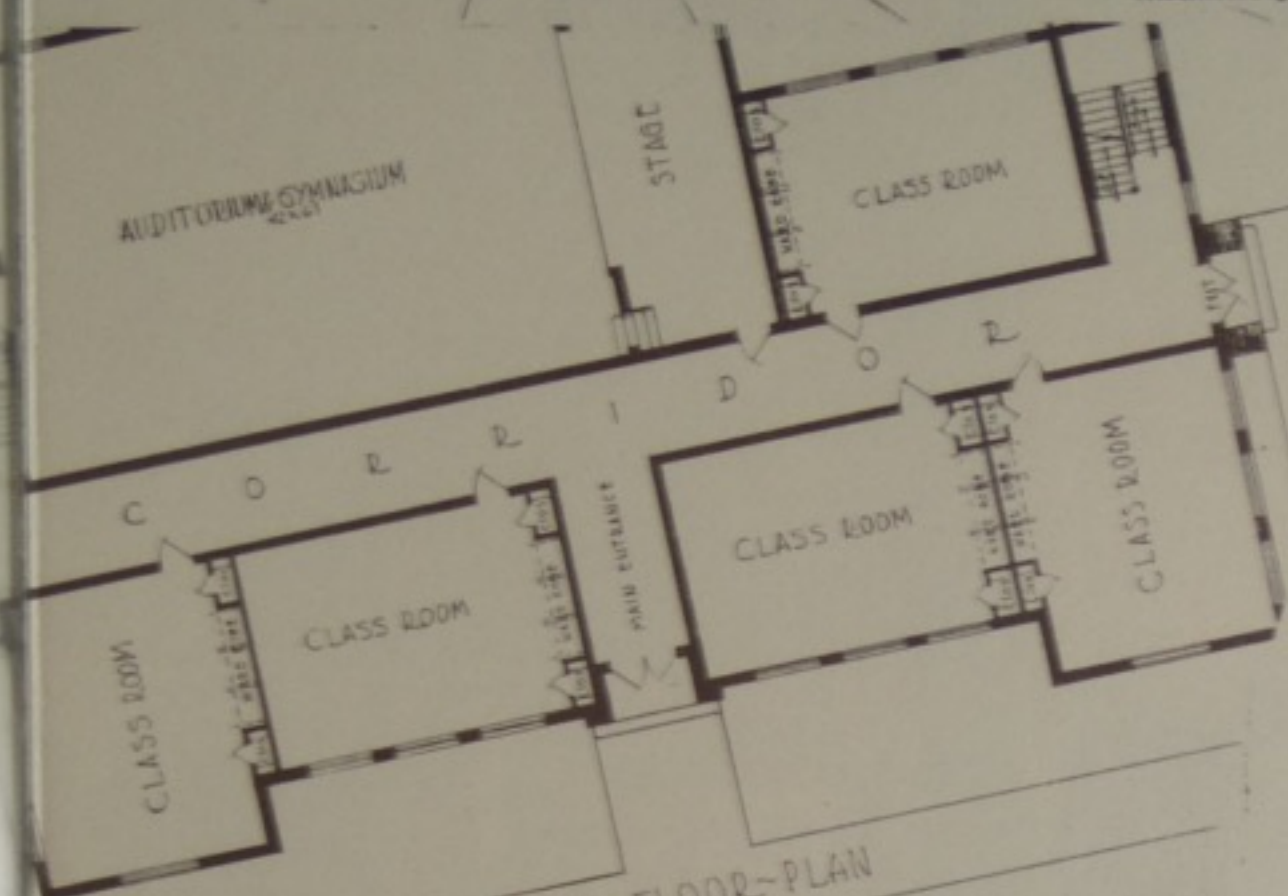
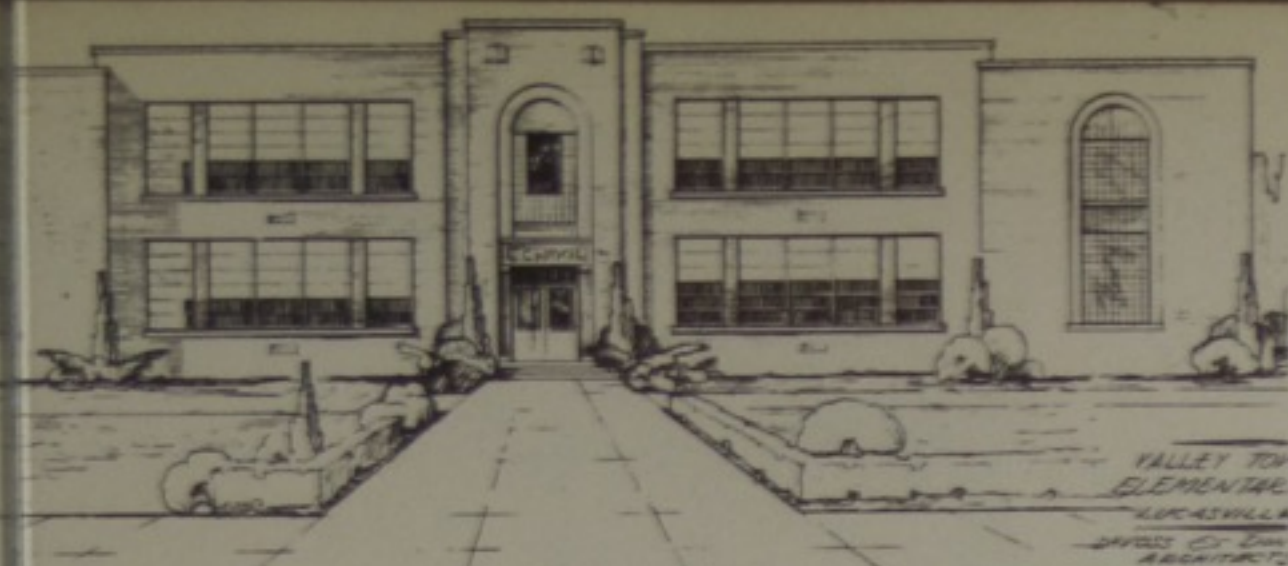


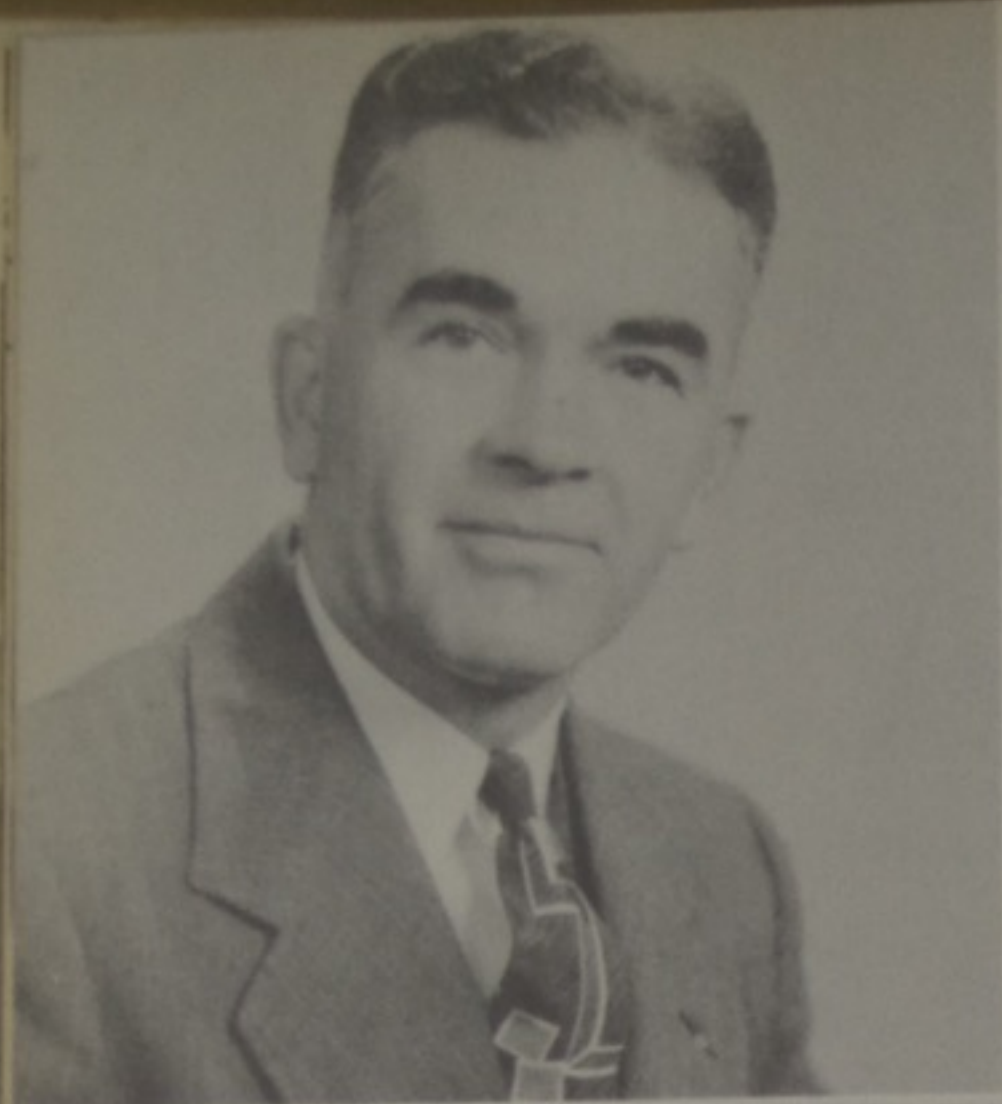
VALLEY LOCAL BOARD OF EDUCATION
