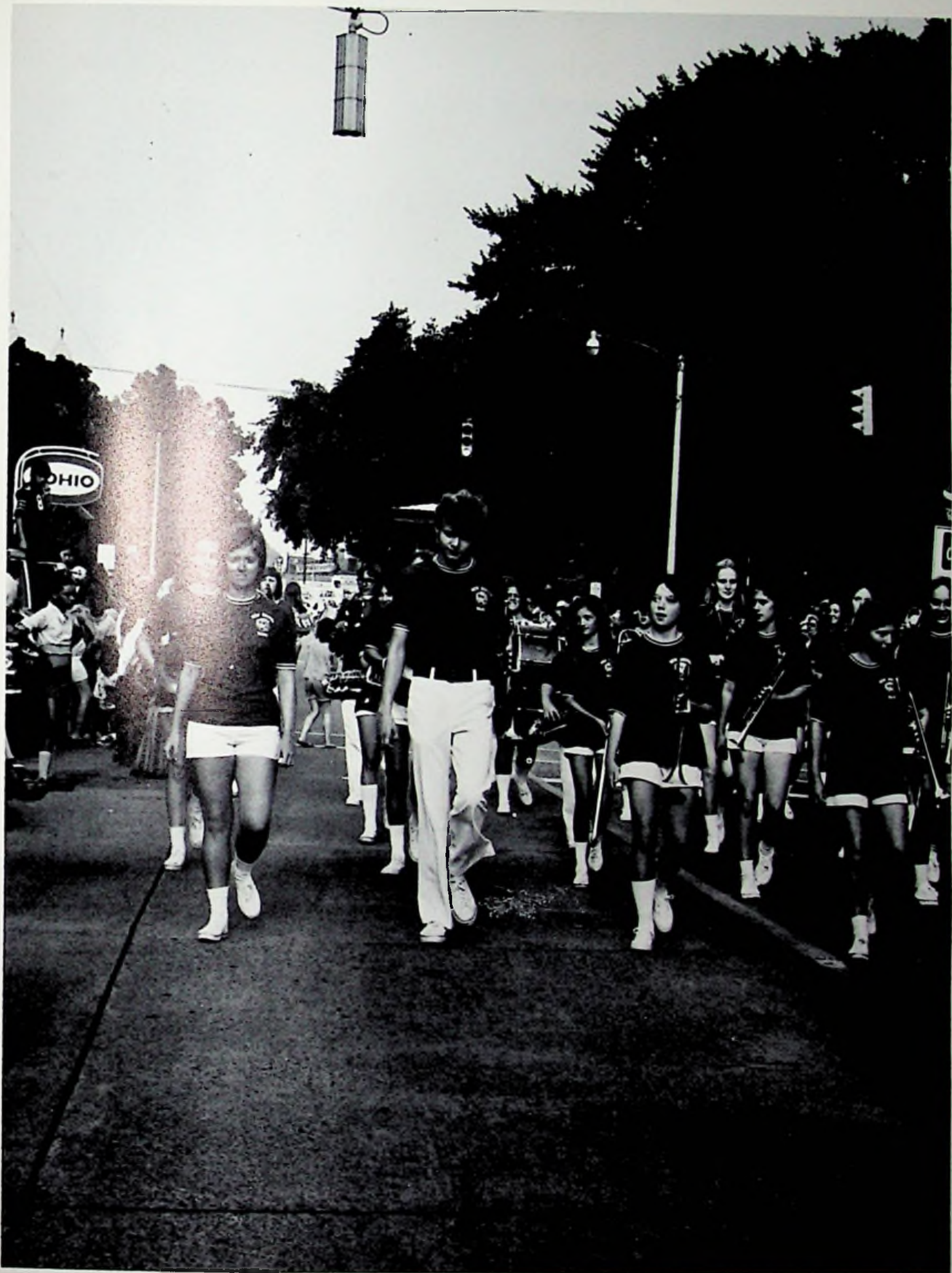
Homecoming '74

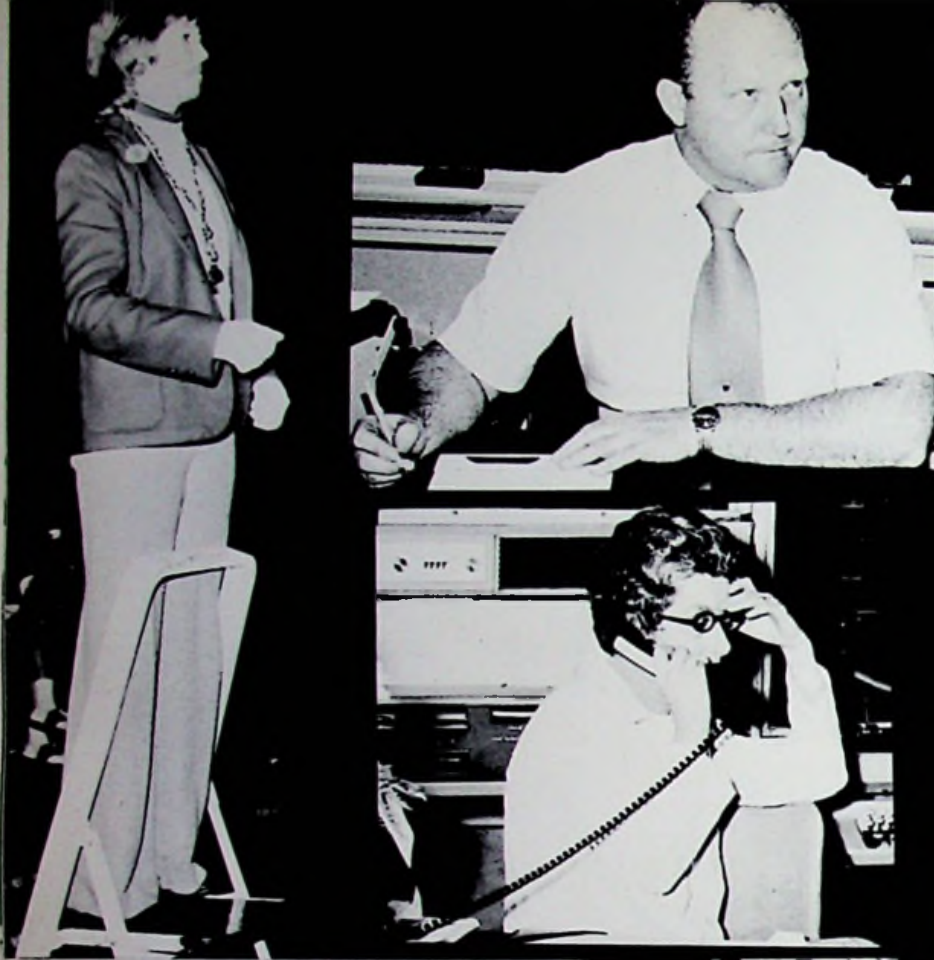

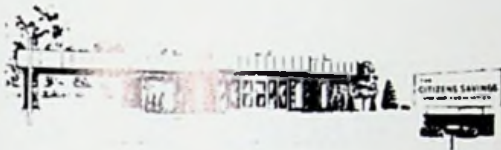

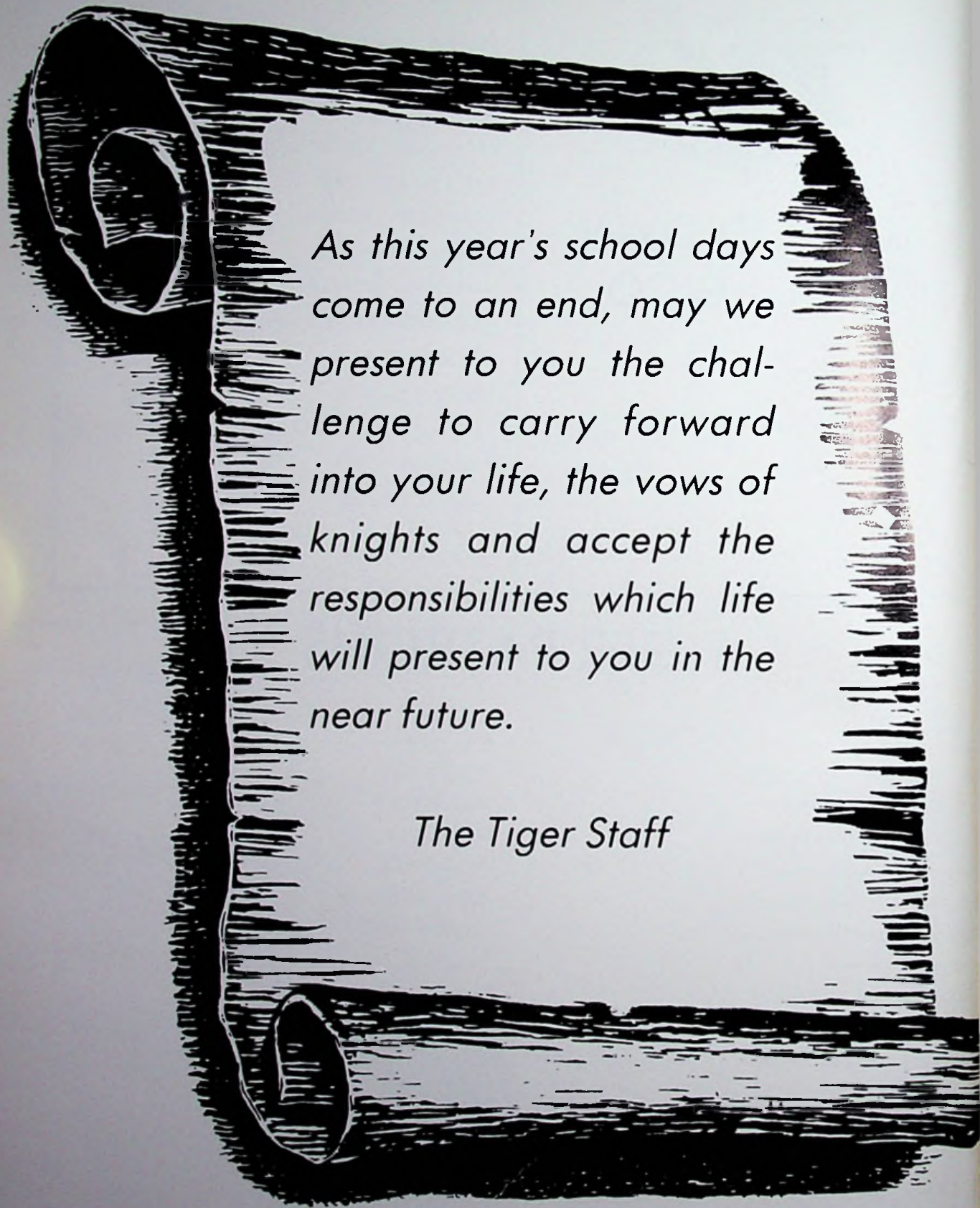
