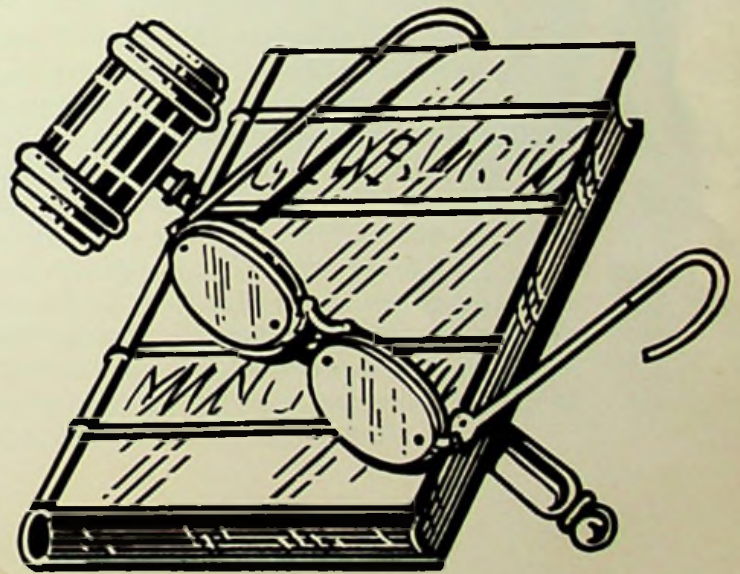


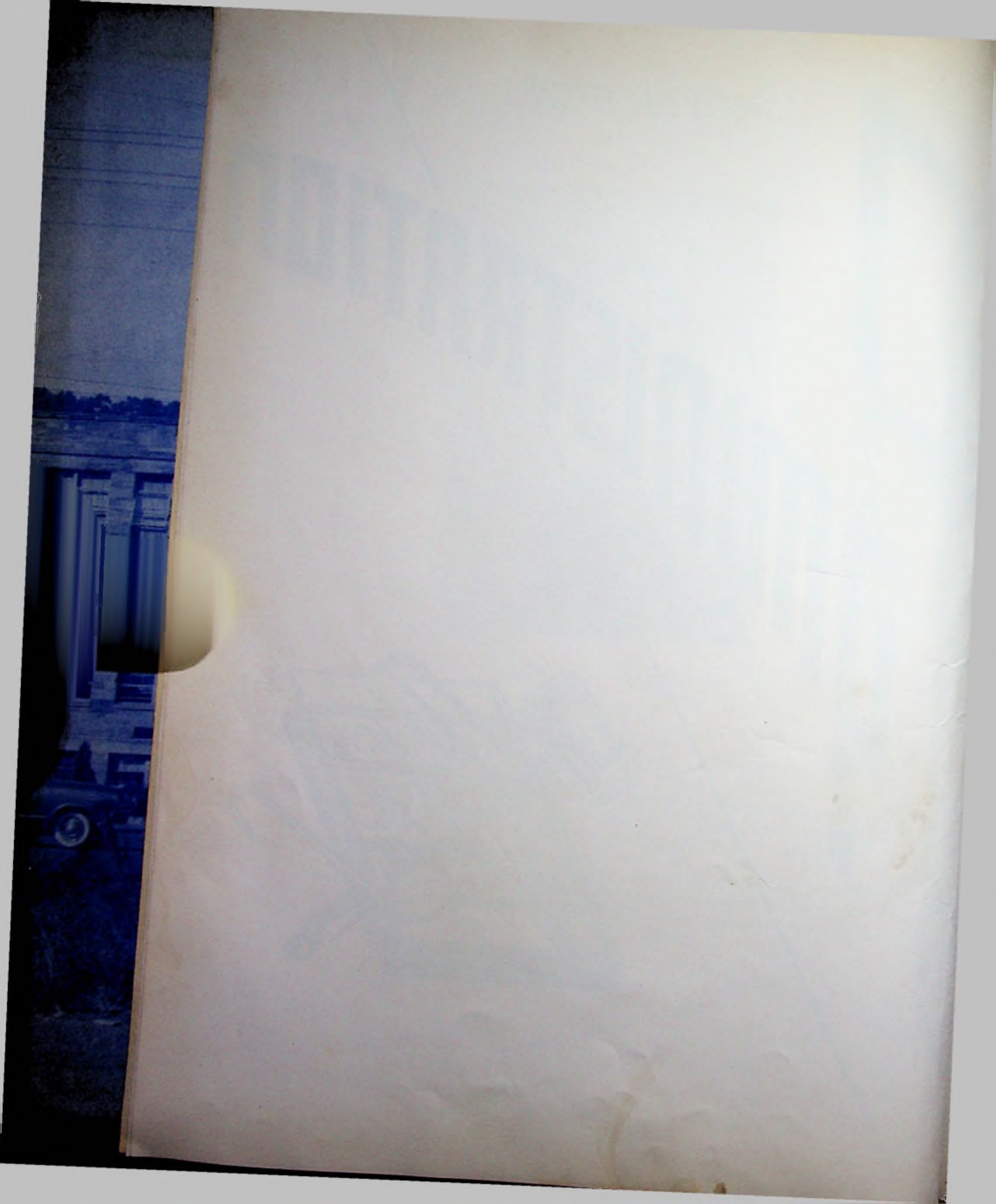
MR. B. G. HANEY
