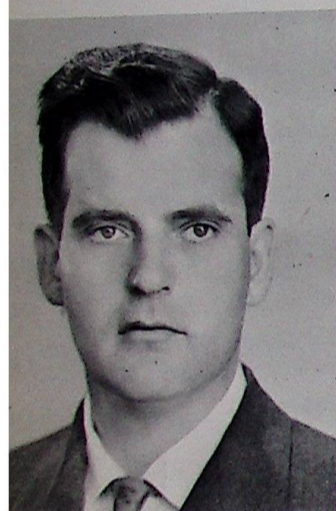
IN MEMORIAM
