

Colophon

The printing of 225 copies of Smoke Signals was done by Taylor Publishing Company, 1550 West Mockingbird Lane, Dallas, TX 75235. Alan Swank of Athens, OH is the sales rep. The book was designed using Taylor Typevision and Pagevision Plus on an IBM PS30 computer.

The cover is a Jackson Pollack style paint technique done in yellow, purple, and black silkscreen over a white base cover material. The endsheets are standard stock. The pages are printed on


80 lb. gloss paper.


Captions are in 8 pt. Opus typeface. New features include combining the underclassmen in one section to facilitate locating students in alphabetical order. All group photos were moved to the ad section to allow more room for candids on the spreads, to make the group photos larger, to allow students to be identified by first and last names and to add interest to the ad section.


The average production cost of each book is \$55. The average book sale price was \$22. Names on the book were \$3 and a plastic cover was \$1. The budget for 1989 was \$11,500 including pulishing costs of \$9,441 and photography costs of \$800. Business advertising amounted to \$6,600, book sales \$4,400 and the patron fundraiser was \$645.


During 1988-89, one staff member was inducted in Quill and Scroll: Jason Bean. The 1988 book received a 2nd place rating in the Columbia Scholastic Press Assoc. The 1988 book received the Yearbook Yearbook Award from Taylor Publishing. This award recognizes that Valley Yearbook is among the top 150 yearbooks of the 8000 published by Taylor. Three spreads and the cover were published in the Yearbook Yearbook Theme section.


Staff members attended the Taylor Publishing workshop at OU in July 1988 and the UHSP Workshop at Marshall in April 1989. Staff members who complete the year receive 1/2 credit per year for the course Photography and Design with one credit applied toward graduation. Year-book staff meets for 2 hours 3 times per week outside of school time for 44 weeks. An excess of 4000 person hrs went into the production of this book.













