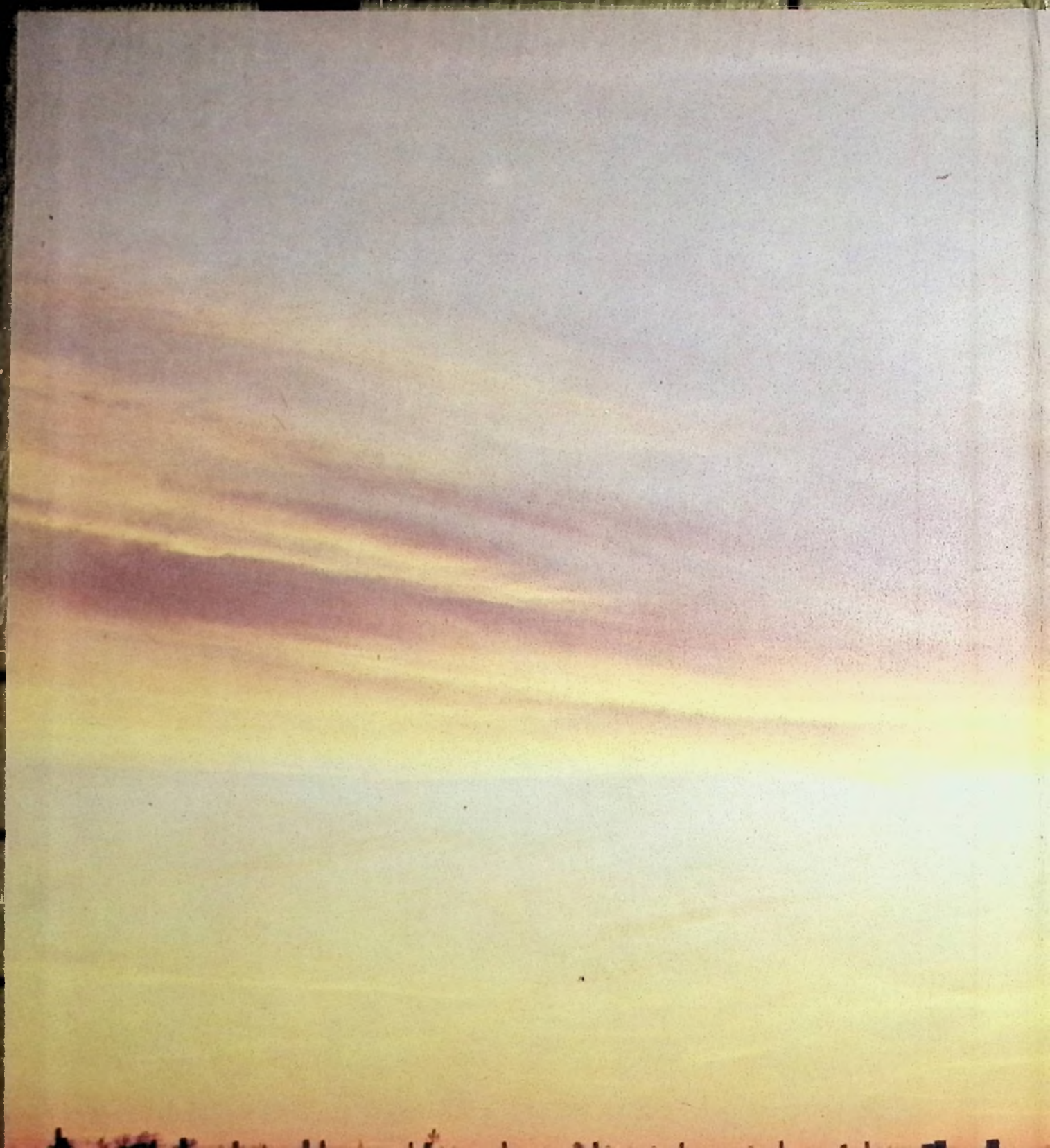
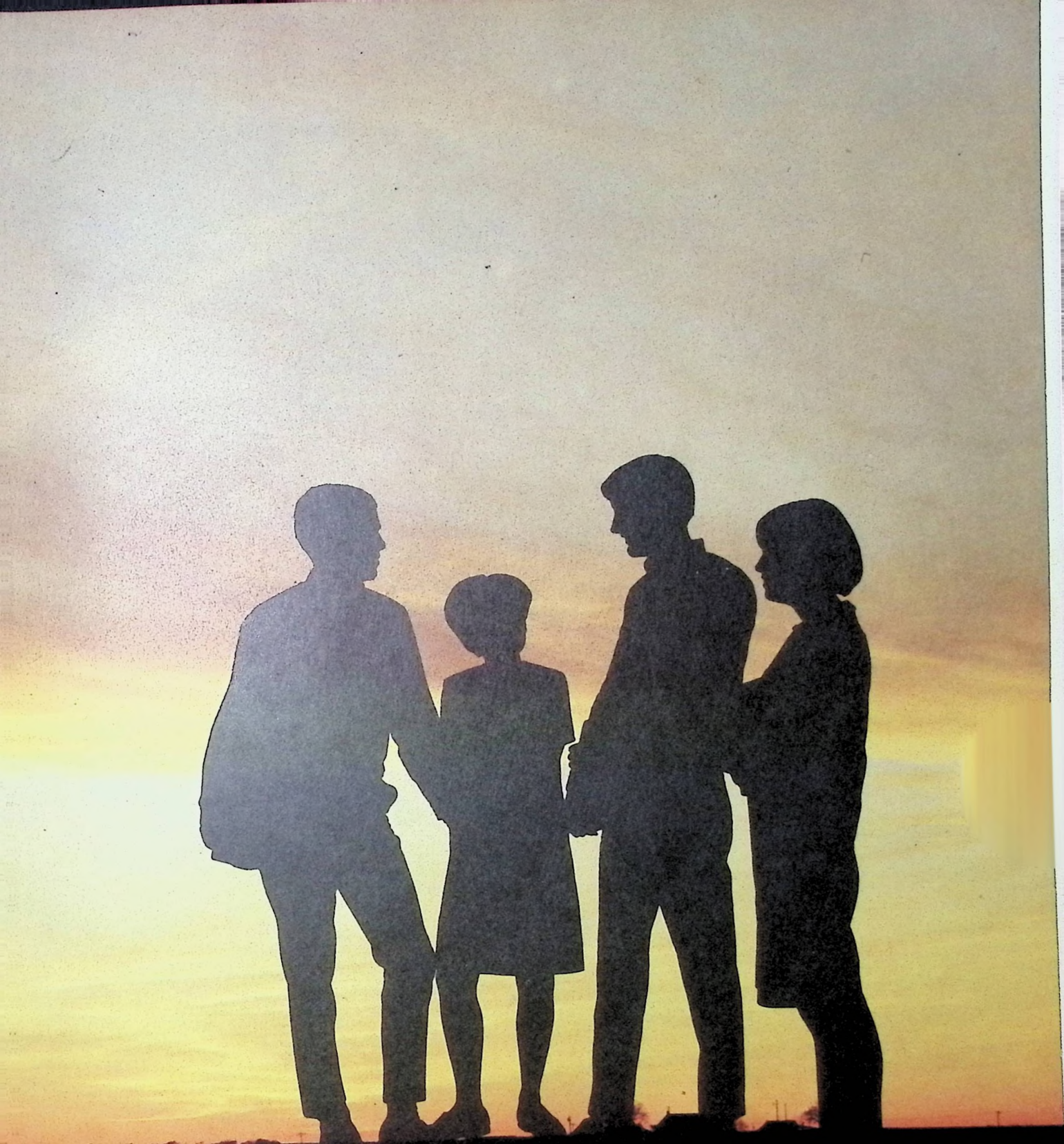

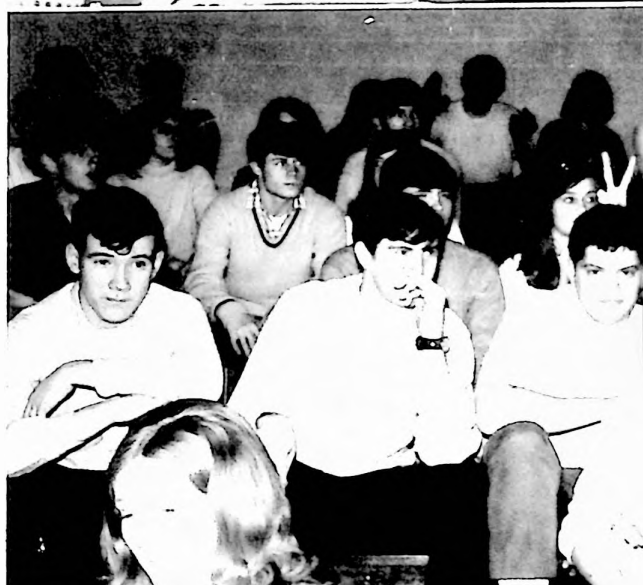

The primary purpose of the Scioto County Joint Vocational School is to help give definite purpose and meaning to education by relating it to occupational goals. While it will provide the knowledge and work skills necessary for employment, it will also be more inclusive than training for job skills; it will develop the abilities, attitudes, work habits, and appreciations which contribute to a satisfying and productive life.
