## Bobcats Capture Crown On Salyers' Goal With Five Seconds In Game



Sophomore Ronnie Salyers made the most important field goal of his brief varsity basketball career Saturday night. It was a jump shot from the foul circle with five seconds left in the ball game and it won for Green High School the Scioto County Class A championship, 54-52, over South Webster.

Salyer's shot, which concluded a 24-point scoring spree for the forward, ended nearly three minutes of a 52-52 tie that had both clubs jockeying for the best possible. But neither connected and Webster gained possession of the ball as the game went into the final minute.

Guards Paul Smith and Larry Rose and forward Mel Hollback moved the ball outside 45 seconds until Hollback shoved a long one-hander that went in, circled the rim and came out.

Substitute Ronnie Dyer took the rebound for Green and Ray Leadingham moved the ball down court. He fed into the foul circle to Salyers, who dribbled once, then fired the shot that ended the game.

It marked the second time in three years Webster has lost the county championship in the closing seconds. Two years ago McDermott's Earl Thomas scored on a layup in a double-overtime period to beat the Jeeps in a title contest.

"We've got this far twice," said Webster Coach Ray Mullen. "and lost out the same way both times."

Green had an uphill struggle all the way before it won its first championship since 1943. First, the Bobcats were defeated by Webster in the tourney's opening round and had to come back up through the loser's bracket. Then they fell 13 points behind in the second quarter and had to rally to get back into the ball game.

Finally, however, it was the sharpshooting of Salyers and Leadingham that made the difference. Salyers was the game's top scorer with 24, his best performance of the tourney. And Leadingham hit defeated prior to Saturday.

Terry Jordan scored 12 for McDermott and Tommy Nolan led Clay with 11.

Ronnie Salyers was top scorer in the Scioto County tournament with 88 points in six games, but Terry Williams of McDermott posted the best average with 38 points in two games, or an average of 19 each contest.

Green and South Webster, naturally, had the top scorers because they played more games. Green played in six and Webster in five.

Following Salyers for the Bobcats were Bill Salyers with 73, Ray Leadingham 63, Orville Ison 51, Richard Blevins 33 and Ronnie Dyer 31.

Larry Rose scored 63 for Webster, one more than Paul Smith and two more than Mel Hollback.

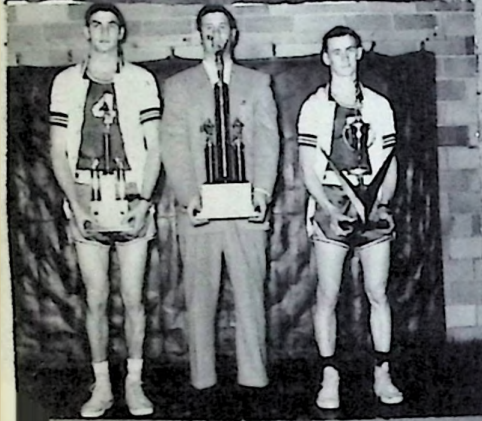
Bill LeMaster scored 32 in two games for Otway, Leon McGlone 49 in four games for Clay and Gene Enz scored 34 in three for Rarden.

Green received the permanent varsity tourney trophy, rotating tourney trophy and regular season league trophy. And each member of the squad was presented a belt buckle.

South Webster was presented the tourney runnerup award. The reserve tourney and reserve league trophies both were won by Clay. Don Burchett of Clay received the foul shooting award, his second.

McDermott won trophies for the junior high tourney championship and Western Division League title. Clay was rewarded for its Eastern Division title.

South Webster also received a trophy for the county baseball championship.

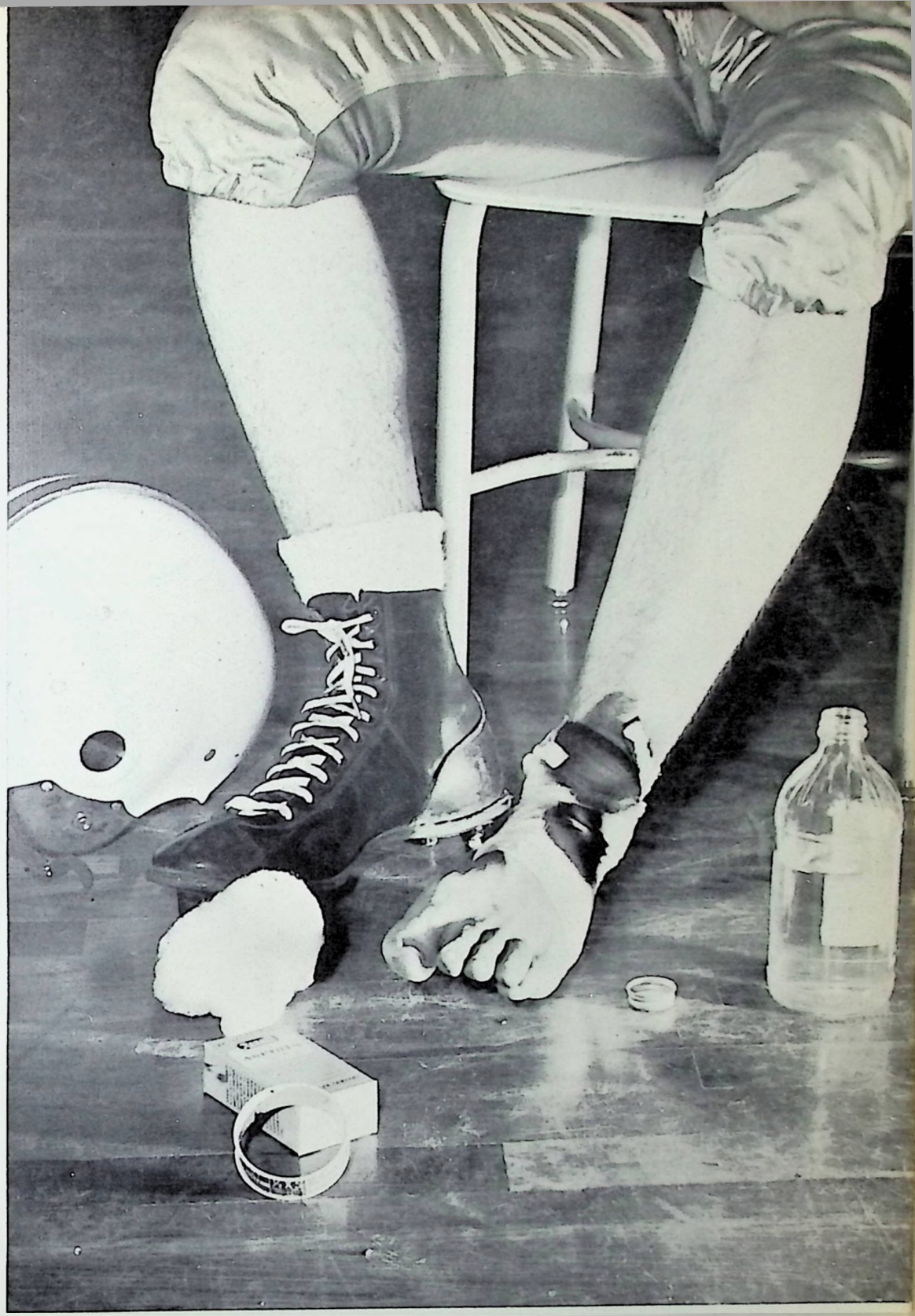
