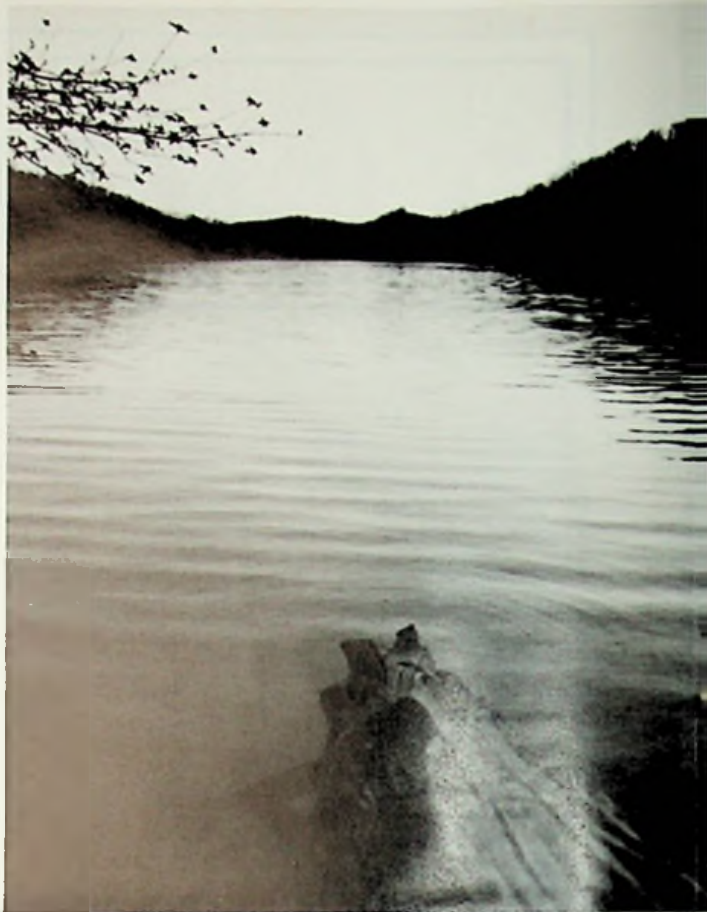

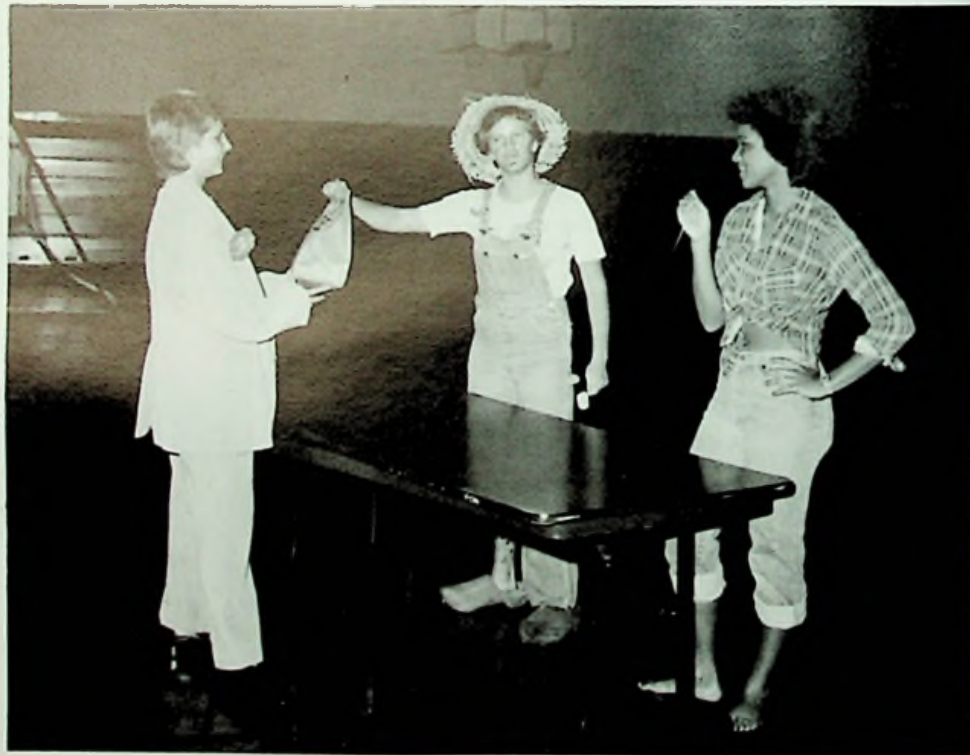
# TREND SETTERS

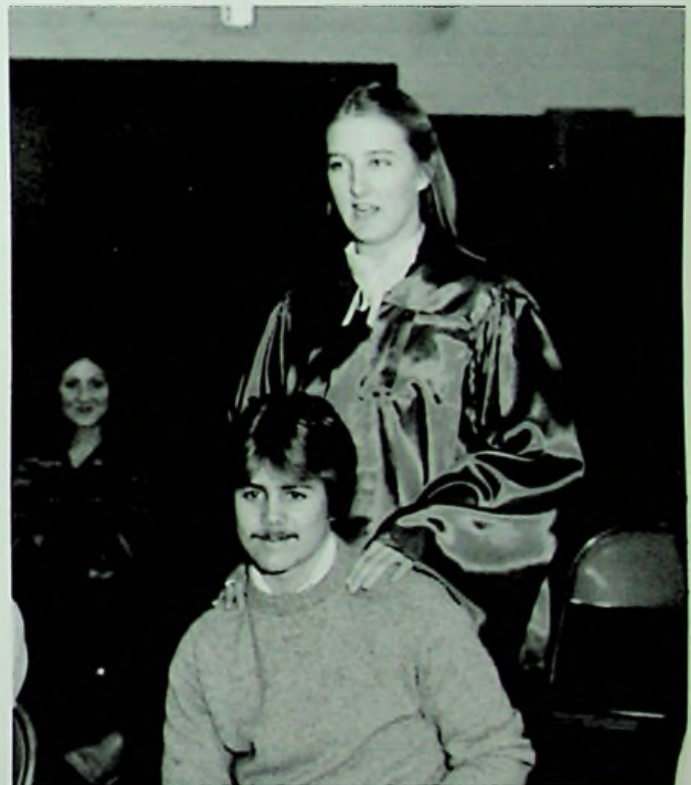

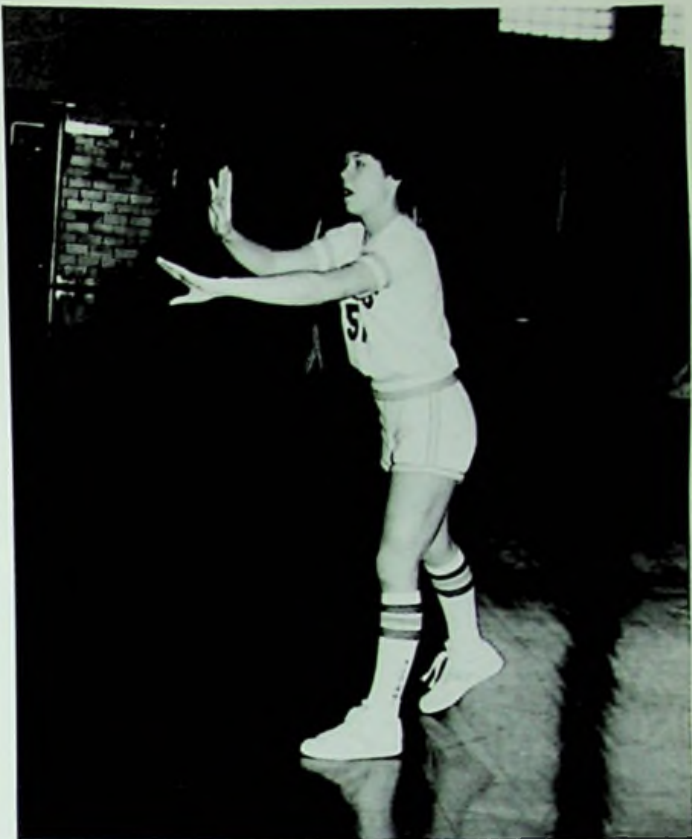
