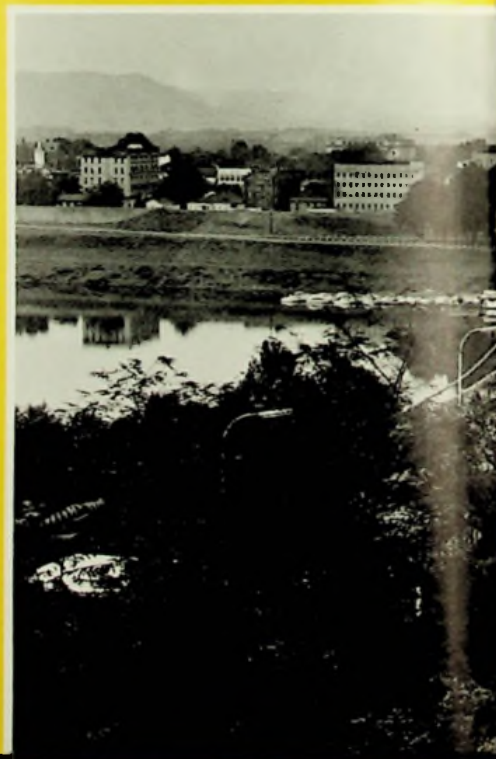
U.S. GRANT BRIDGE CLOSED FOR REPAIRS

ON JULY 7, 1978 AT 2 A.M. THE U.S. GRANT BRIDGE WAS CLOSED TO TRAFFIC BECAUSE INSPECTION REVEALED FRAYED WIRES IN THE SUSPENSION CABLES.

FURTHER INSPECTIONS REVEALED THE CABLES WERE DETERIORATING RAPIDLY. THE BRIDGE WAS CLOSED TO PEDESTRIANS AND EMERGENCY VEHICLES ON AUGUST 31, 1978. THE CLOSING OF THE BRIDGE ADVERSELY AFFECTED THE ECONOMY OF PORTSMOUTH. SEVERAL BUSINESSES WERE FORCED TO CLOSE. OVERALL, PORTSMOUTH MERCHANTS LOST AN ESTIMATED FOURTEEN PERCENT IN RETAIL SALES DURING THE CLOSING. IT THREATENED THE JOBS OF THOUSANDS OF NORTHERN KENTUCKIANS WHO WORKED IN OHIO. AND, IT PRESENTED A LIFE AND DEATH SITUATION TO BOTH STATES.

EFFORTS WERE MADE IMMEDIATELY FOR OBTAINING AN AUTO FERRY SERVICE BETWEEN PORTSMOUTH AND SOUTH SHORE. TWO WEEKS AFTER THE FIRST MEETING ABOUT FERRY SERVICE, THE STATE CONTROLLING BOARD ANNOUNCED THE ALLOCATION OF \$250,000 TO PORTSMOUTH FOR DOCKING AND FERRY FACILITIES AND CONNECTING SERVICES BETWEEN THE BRIDGE AND EXISTING BUS LINES. DURING THE FIRST WEEK IN SEPTEMBER, DOUG MCGINNIS AND ROY MCGOVNEY'S FERRY PRINCESS, INC. BEGAN OPERATING TWO FORTY PASSENGER FERRIES. ON ITS FIRST DAY THE NEW FERRY COMPANY TRANSPORTED MORE THAN 500 PERSONS. LESS THAN THREE WEEKS LATER, PORTSMOUTH ENTERED INTO A CONTRACT WITH KEYSTONE-RICHMOND COMPANY OF VIRGINIA BEACH, VIRGINIA TO OPERATE AN AUTO FERRY SERVICE. PASSENGER FERRY SERVICE WAS SOON CONTRACTED TO GATEWAY CLIPPER, INC. OF PITTSBURGH, PENNSYLVANIA. ON ITS FIRST DAY THE ENCLOSED AND HEATED GATEWAY CLIPPER TRANSPORTED 400 PASSENGERS ON ITS FIRST TRIP ACROSS THE RIVER.

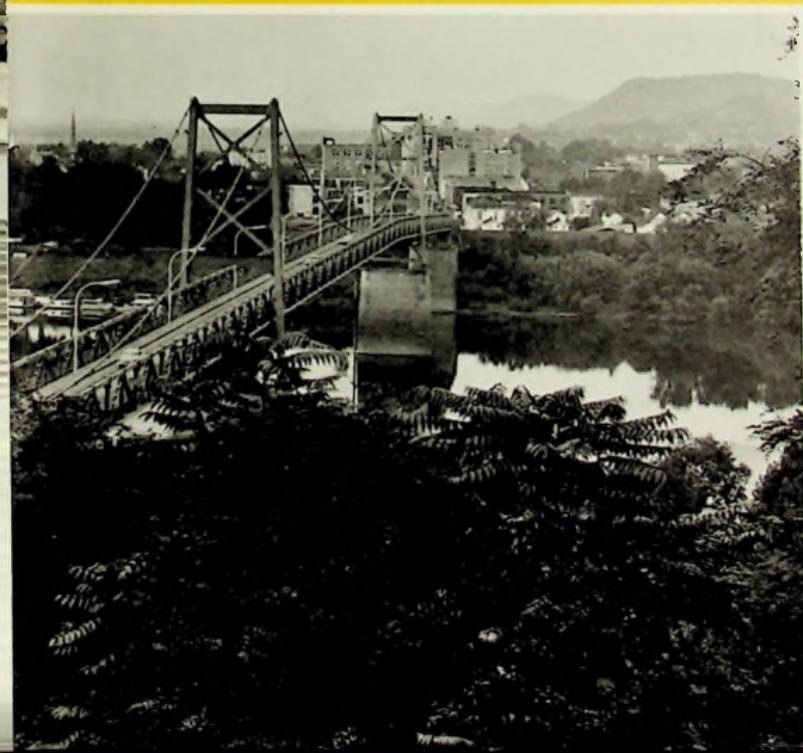
ON FEBRUARY 10, 1979, THE CITY SENT OUT A CALL TO ROY MCGOVNEY REQUESTING THAT HE BEGIN A FULL-SCALE AUTO-FERRY OPERATION WITHIN 48 HOURS. ON FEBRUARY 12, 1979, ROY MCGOVNEY AND DOUG MCGINNIS CONTRACTED WITH THE CITY TO RUN TWO FREE FERRIES — ONE SIX CAR AND ONE FIFTEEN CAR. FREE SERVICE WAS PROVIDED FOR EMERGENCY VEHICLES. SIXTY-THREE EMERGENCY VEHICLES CROSSED THE RIVER WITHOUT CHARGE DURING THE WEEK OF DECEMBER 18, 1979. EACH CROSSING TOOK ONLY THREE MINUTES.

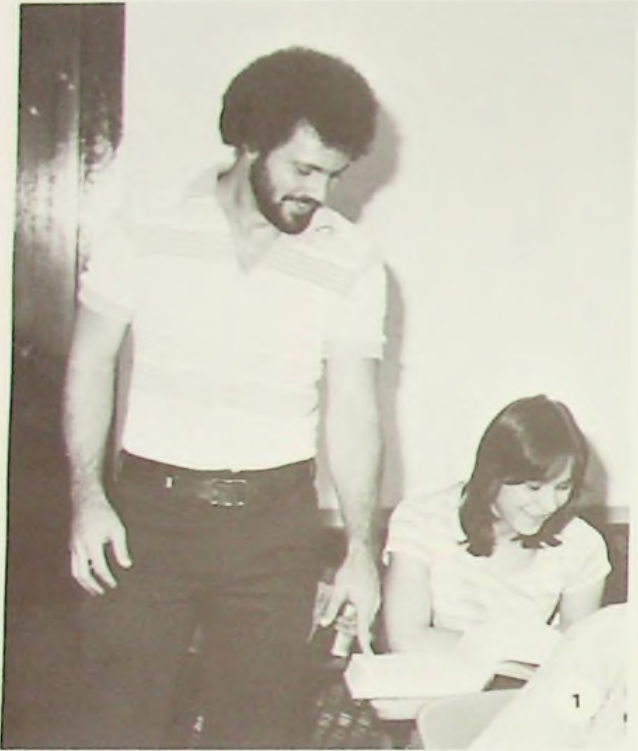

It took the P.H.S. offense nine plays to score, with Jim Richardson going the final yard at the 7:54 mark. The try for extra point failed, but we held a 6-0 lead. Eric Flannery took advantage of a Redmen's fumble and gave the Trojans possession with 41 yards to play. Kirk McMahon passed to Craig Wright for the extra points, and it was 14-0. 
In the area's biggest High School Football Rivalry, the Trojans came out on the short end dropping the big one to the 'Burg 27-6.

History was made ten weeks ago at Portsmouth High School. After twenty-three years as the teaching professor, Mrs. Zane Perry began teaching in another way to the masses in the new Dean of Girls.

Teaching had been a major part of Mrs. Perry's life. She graduated as valedictorian of her class at McNeill High School. Her undergraduate work and teaching were in History and Political Science. She worked at Berea, Mrs. Perry went on to earn her Master's in History at Eastern Kentucky University, in Richmond, Kentucky. She also completed 28 hours of graduate and continuing education.

Mrs. Perry taught for eight years at McNeill, and then moved on to teach for fifteen years in the Portsmouth City School System.

"I never wanted Dean of Girls," Mrs. Ferguson admits. "There were too many frustrations. This is the job I've always wanted, I would have been here sooner, but it takes time to find replacements for every one."

Mrs. Ferguson prefers Guidance, for there she is able to work with a wide range of students with problems of various kinds placing them in a remarkable school, and a well-learned faculty on the most part. "Many people are definitely part of my life. I have two far lives, my family, and my family of students."

CHALLENGE With the open position, Mrs. Perry was someone's rock and a hard place. Should she leave her love of teaching, or take on this new challenge?

Her decision caused many reactions. "My family was happy, and happy knowing I was happy. Many of my colleagues didn't know if they should congratulate me, or offer their condolences." The initial student reaction was quite the opposite. Many students felt they were being shortchanged, and were losing one of the school's assets.

But when they saw how happy she was with her position, they had a change of heart. Ted Ellsworth and Becky Gressel presented a fund to buy her a table plan and an engraved pendant. In her sixth period academic American History class, Nancy Anderson and Tammy

Students threw their teacher a party. Soon, plants and tables were delivered to the newly quiet room.

Three men were interviewed to replace her. The best qualified was Mr. Robin Carr. An old graduate, Mr. Carr was formerly a student teacher.

Her new position has kept Mrs. Perry busy. "Each day I ask the Lord for guidance. I am happy with all I have done. I miss my students, but I keep busy to keep from dwelling on them." Her goals are to work in the areas of self-control, self-discipline, and self-attention. She plans to develop a program of additional cleanlines around the school, thus helping to increase school pride.

When recently asked, some students still felt they had been ripped off by the move, but many felt Mrs. Perry makes a very good administrator.

But Mrs. Perry had no doubts. "We are very fortunate to have a person with the qualities of Mrs. Perry to move into the Dean's position. I feel her influence will be very positive for P.H.S., and I feel we are privileged to have this opportunity to work closely together."

A happy future is planned by the Dean. "I will remain as long as my performance is acceptable. When I reach retirement, I will travel again. England has always sounded nice. I will read more, and hopefully write short stories for children. It's my goal to have such a book published."

For someone like Mrs. Perry, a future such as that could be attainable.

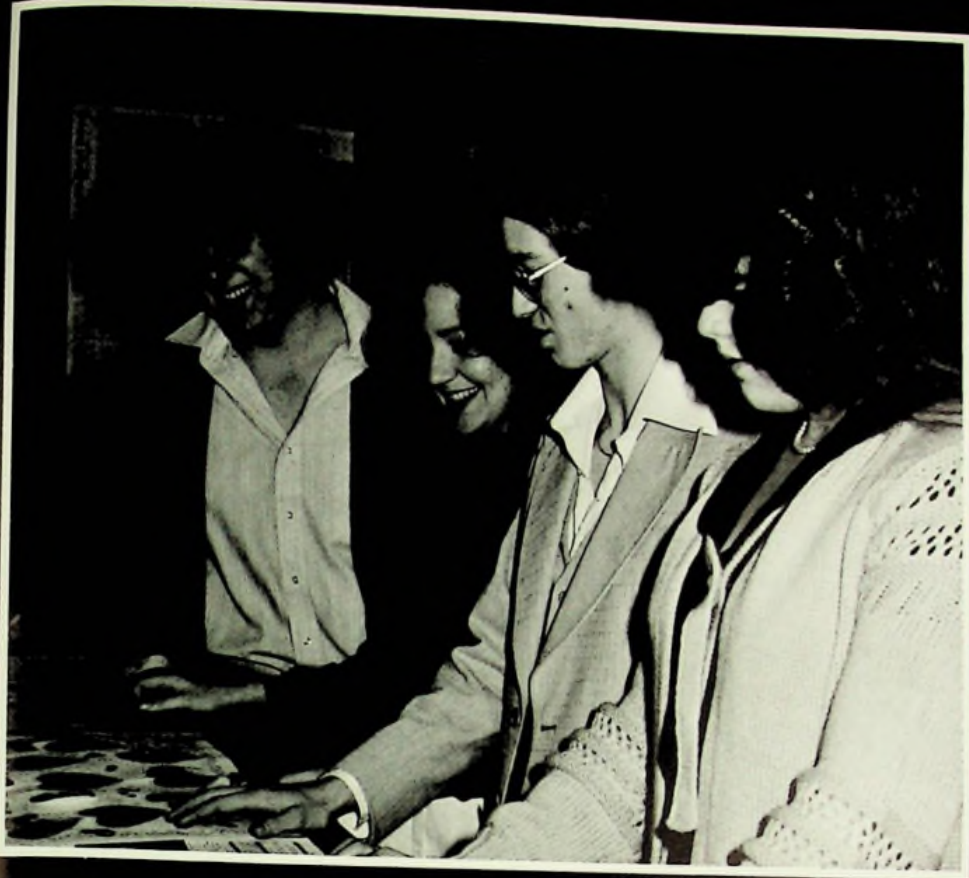
