Sue went from staring at swirls to stake-outs. Since leaving the FBI, Ms. Thomas, a published author, travels as a motivational speaker. Her life is currently the subject of a PAX-TV television program.



Ms. Thomas offered twenty dollars to any person who could read her lips, as the students attempted to mimic Ms. Thomas's silent world. No one was able to accomplish the task. The entire student body listened with reverence as she concluded her speech by singing *Silent Night*.

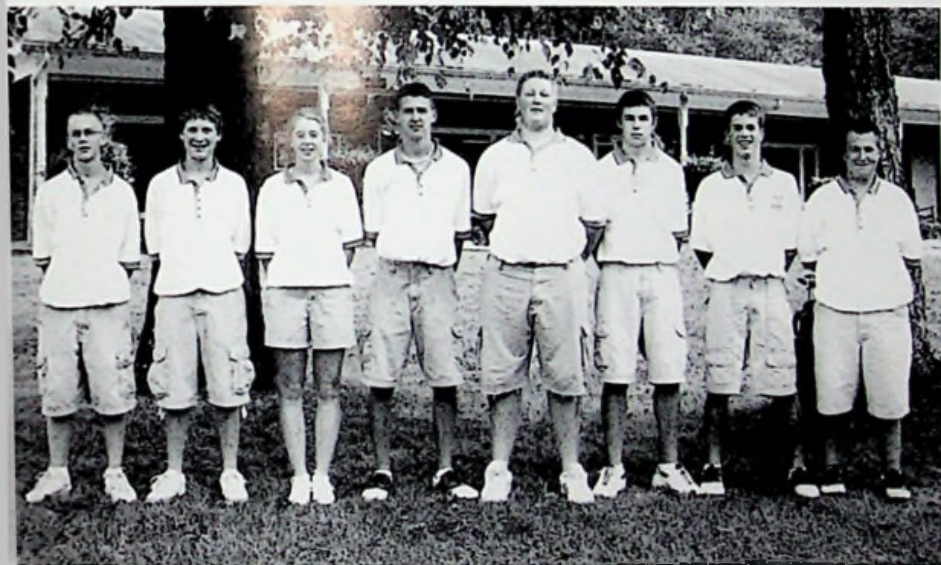
