The Cats dominated the Symmes Valley Viking with a 38-6 performance. Defense held the area's leading rusher to 23 yards. This was the turning point for the remainder of the season.

Game seven against the Notre Dame Titans was one of the most exciting games of the season. The Titans scored with 2:15 left in the game. After a successful on side kick Notre Dame moved the ball down the field. With little time left a desperate attempt was made to score on a pass that was intercepted on the 2 yard line to end the game. Green 14 and Notre Dame 14.

With a 2-5 record and a 2-1 league record the Cats continued the roll. The team pounded East with a 28-7 victory. Offense won this one with a total of 422 offensive yards with 345 of those on the ground.

With a shot at second place in the league the Cats now 3-1, hosted Oak Hill. This game was just too close. Oak Hill came out with a 1 point advantage to beat the Bobcats.

Green ended the season with a 3-7 record. Although the record books may not reflect it the team members were truly winners. What they came away with can never be displayed on a scoreboard.
