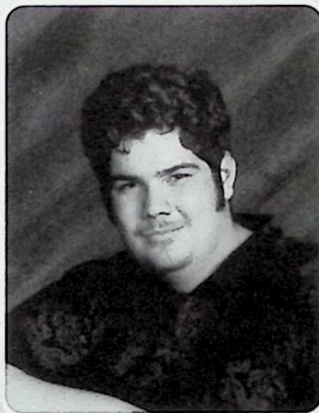
Melissa Blackburn

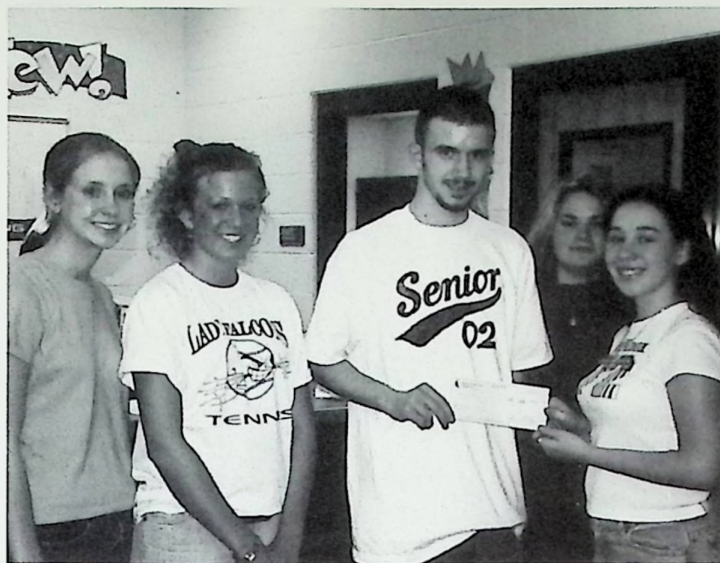

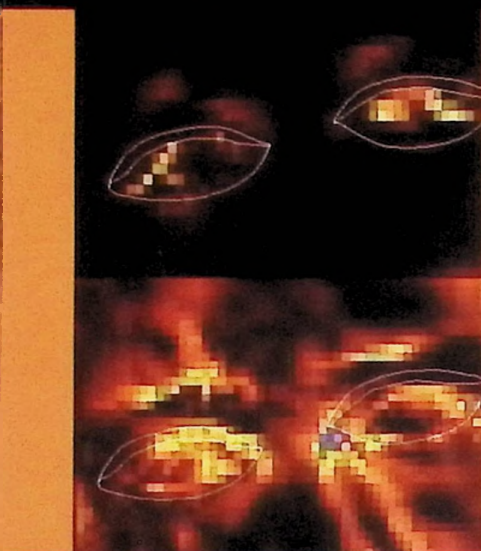

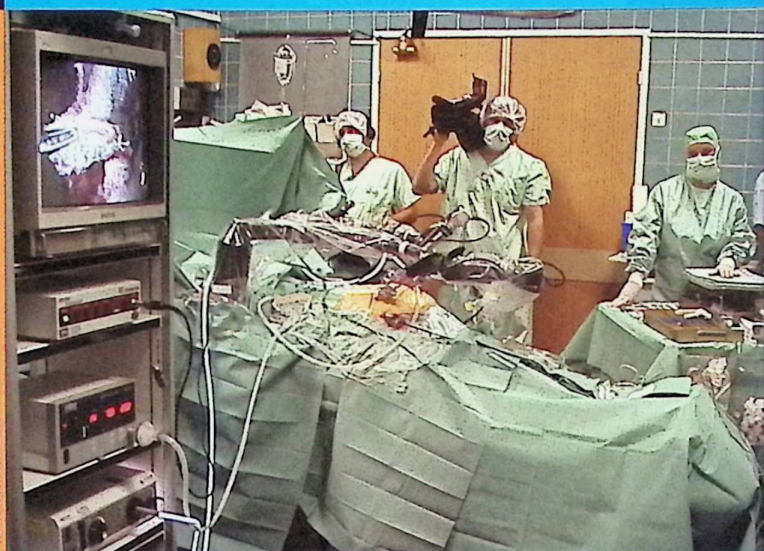

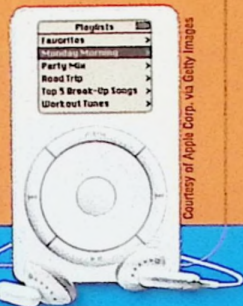

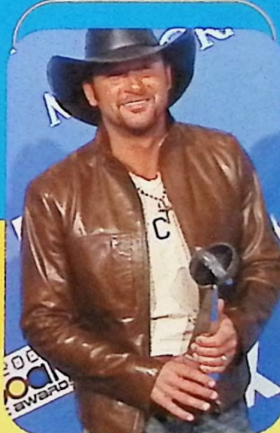

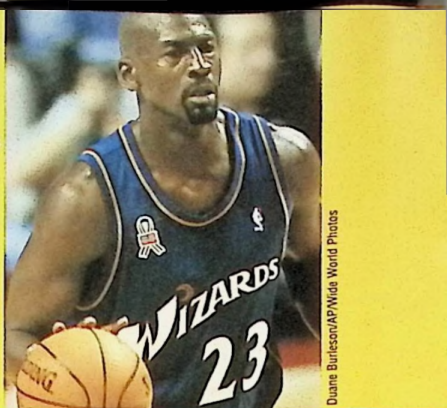

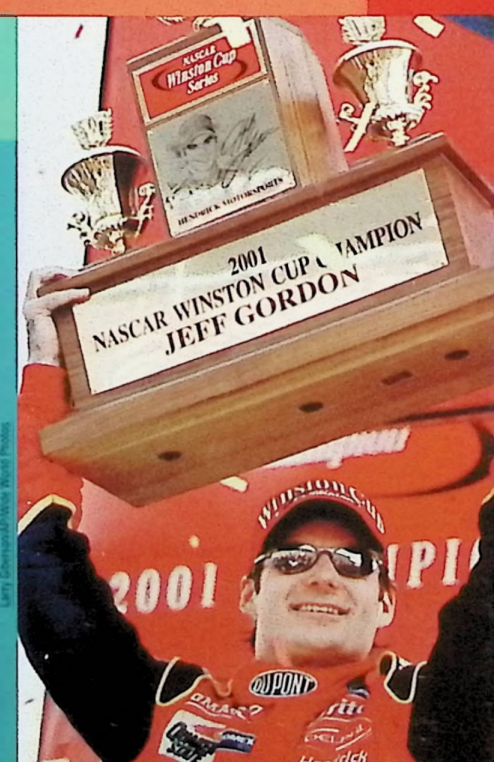
